Important Safety Instructions

Read all instructions before use and keep for future reference.

- 1. Naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should not be placed on or near the apparatus.
- 2. Do not expose the unit to dripping or splashing liquids or place objects filled with liquids, such as vases, to be placed on or near the unit.
- 3. The unit should not be exposed to direct sunlight, very high or low temperatures, moisture, vibrations or placed in dusty environment.
- 4. Do not use abrasives, benzene, thinners or other solvents to clean the surface of the unit. To clean, wipe with a mild nonabrasive detergent and a clean soft cloth.

- Transmits digital video and audio signals through a single HDMI cable
- Supports HDCP

Operation

- 1. Connect your HDTV, LCD monitor or digital projector to the "OUT/TV" HDMI socket on the back panel of the switch with an HDMI cable.
- 2. Connect your HD video and audio sources to the "IN 1" and "IN 2" HDMI sockets on the back panel of the switch with HDMI cables.
- 3. Switch on display and source equipment and press the buttons on the front panel to select the source you want displayed.
