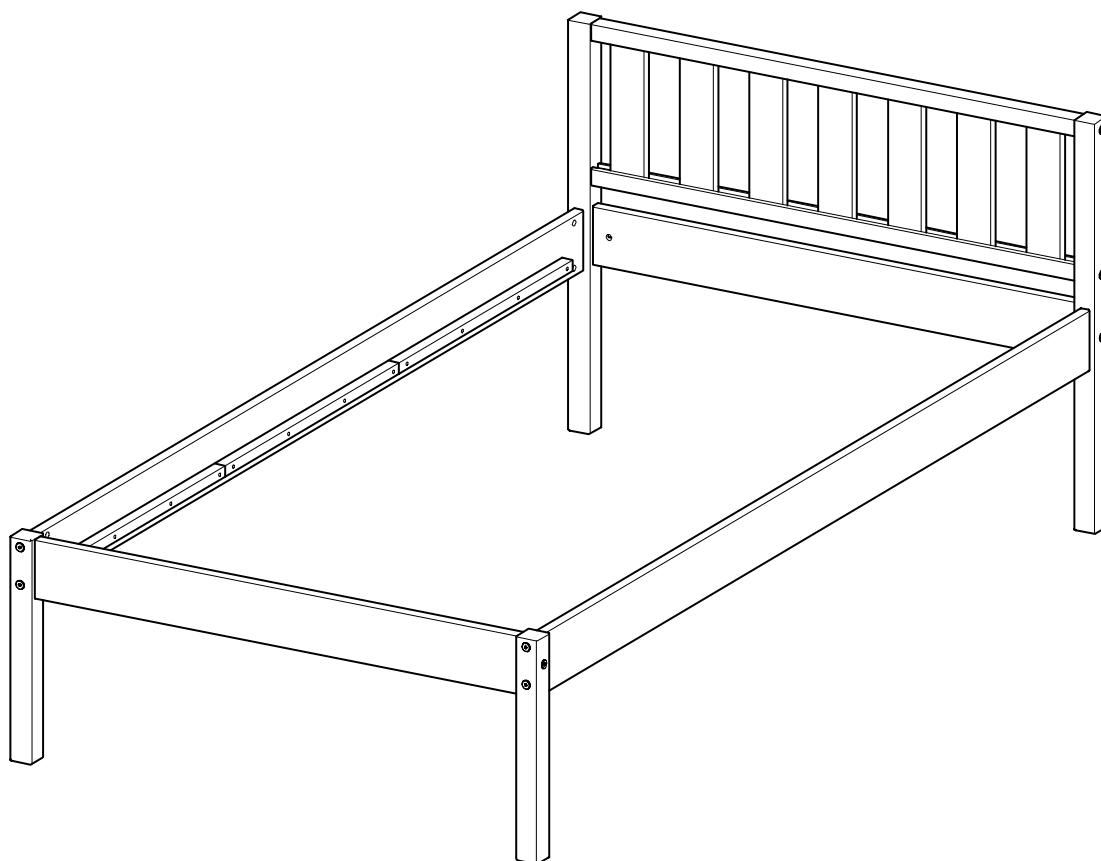

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.

- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

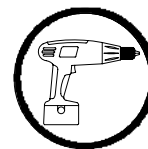
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.

- Improper use of electrical tools will crack the components.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.

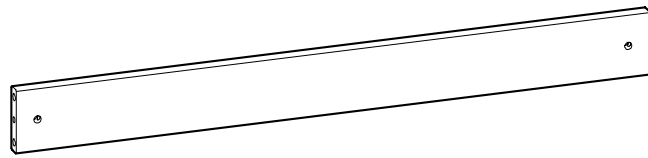
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.

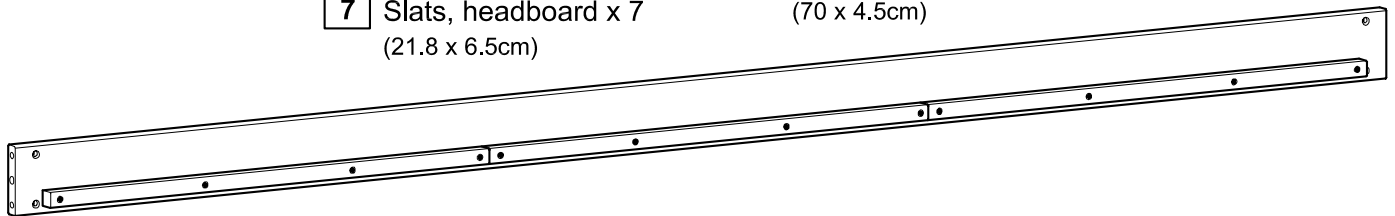








Components - Key Diagram










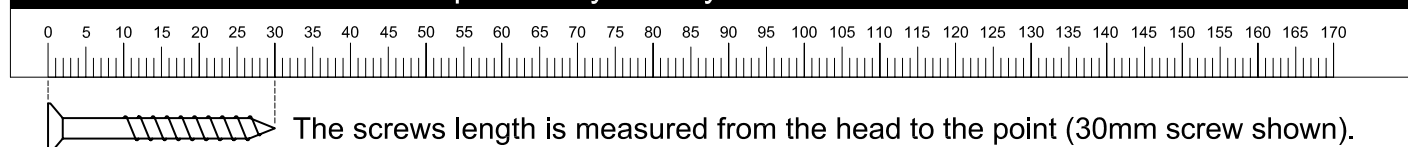
Note: The quantities below are correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws



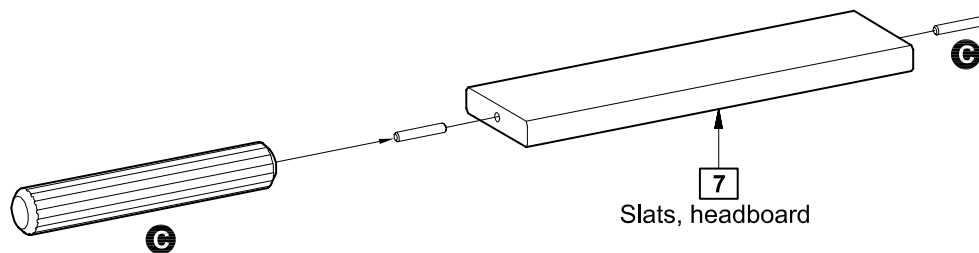
Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Inserting the dowels to the slats, headboard.

Insert the dowels **C** into the holes indicated on the slats, headboard **7**.

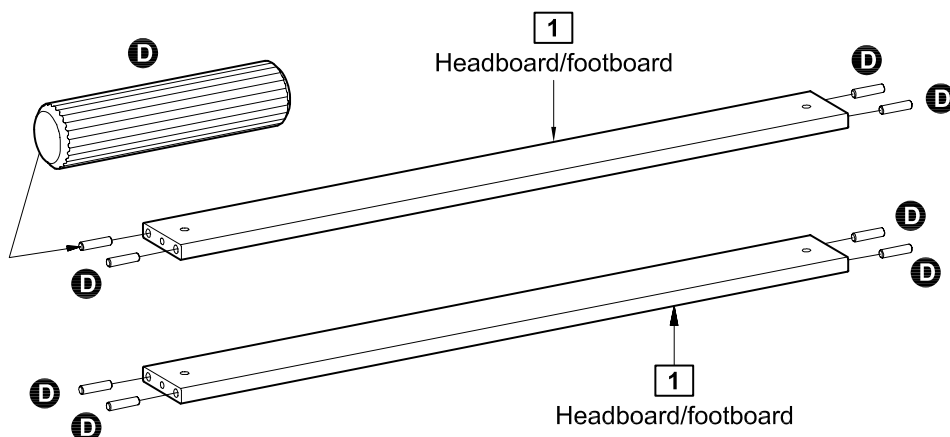
Repeat with remaining slats, headboard.



Step 2

Insert the dowels to the headboard/footboard.

Insert the dowels **D** into the holes indicated on the headboard/footboard **1**.

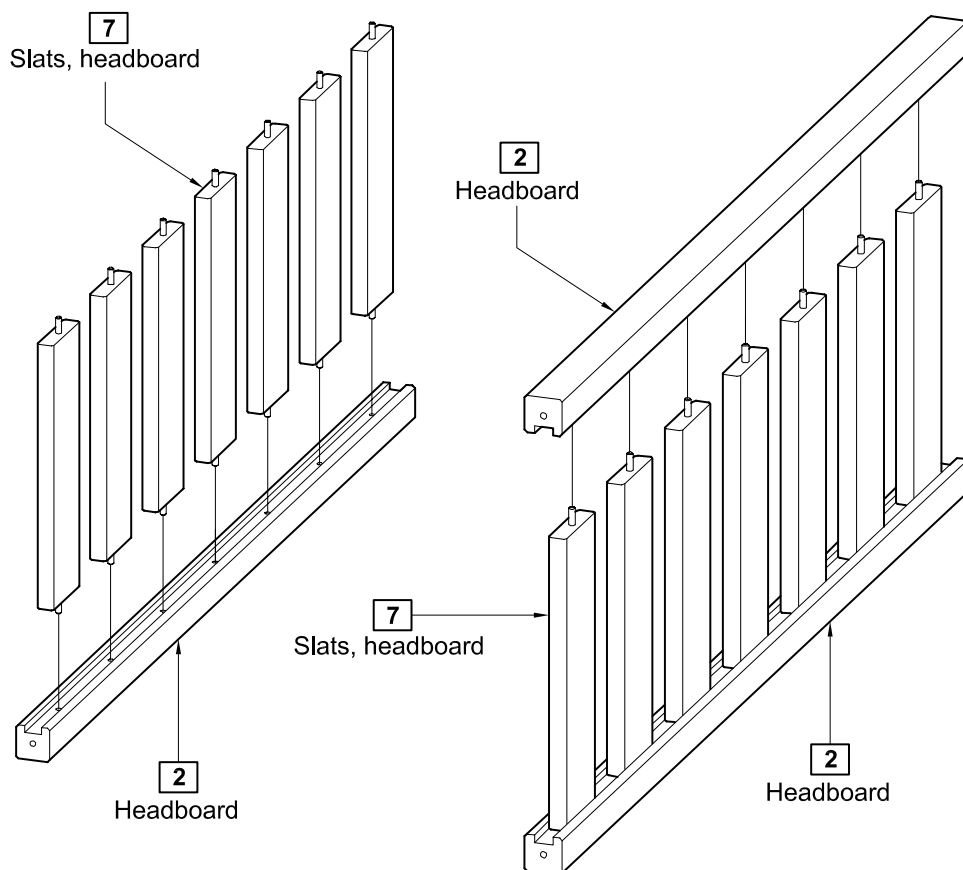


Step 3

Assembly the slats, headboard to the headboards.

Fit the slats, headboard **7** onto the headboards **2**.

Place dowels **C** into the holes indicated on the headboards **2**.

Step 4

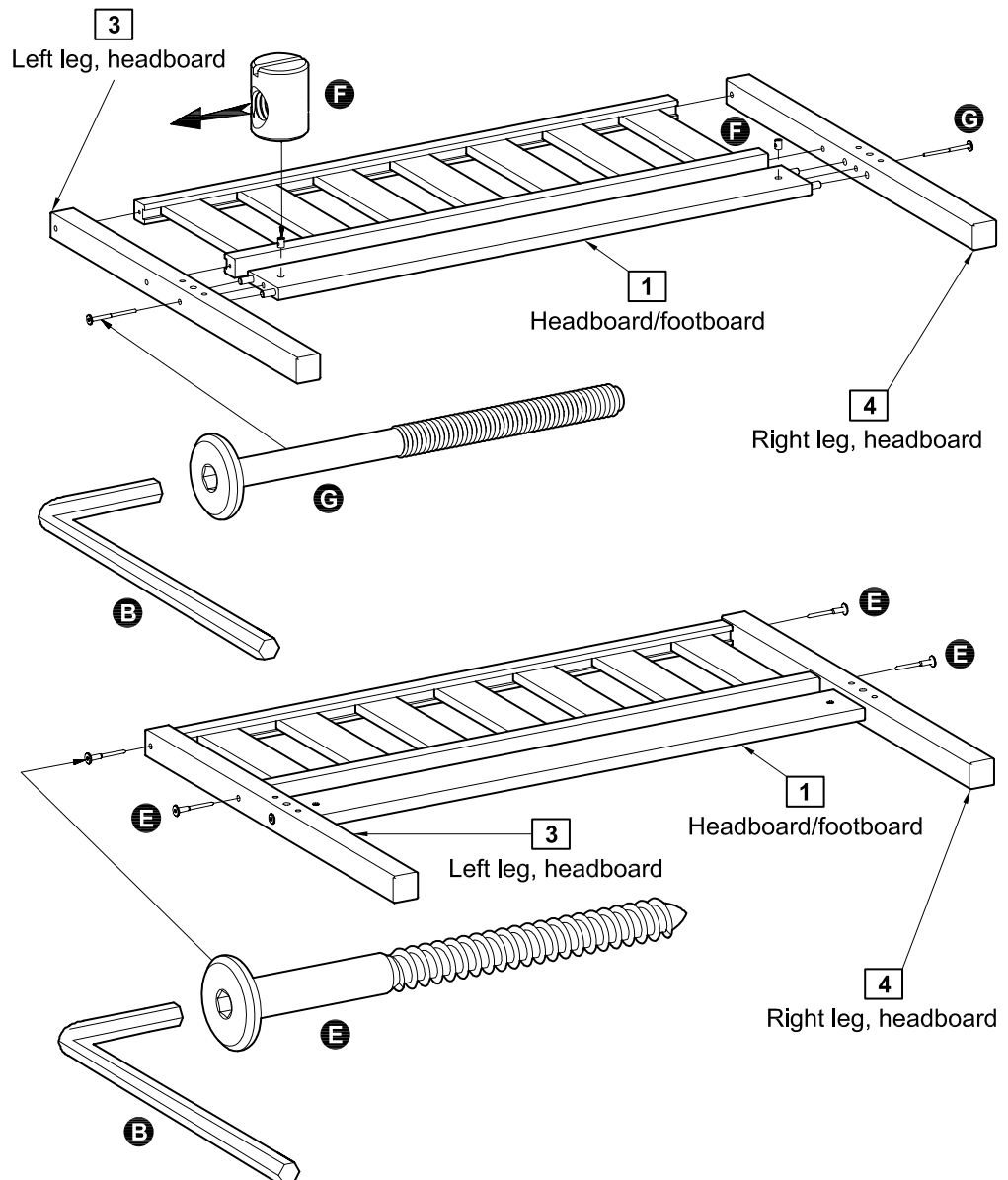
Mounting the legs, headboard to the headboard/footboard.

Place the nuts **F** onto the holes indicated on the headboard/foot board **1** and using screws **G** to fix the right leg, headboard **4** and the left leg, headboard **3** onto the headboard/footboard **1**, using allen key **B** to tighten it.

Note the holes of nuts pointing towards to the screws.

After fixing the slats, headboard **7** to the headboards **2**, mounting it onto the left leg, headboard **3** and the right leg, headboard **4** and using screws **E** and tighten using allen key **B**.

Do not tighten screws **G** and **E** until you have placed all of them.

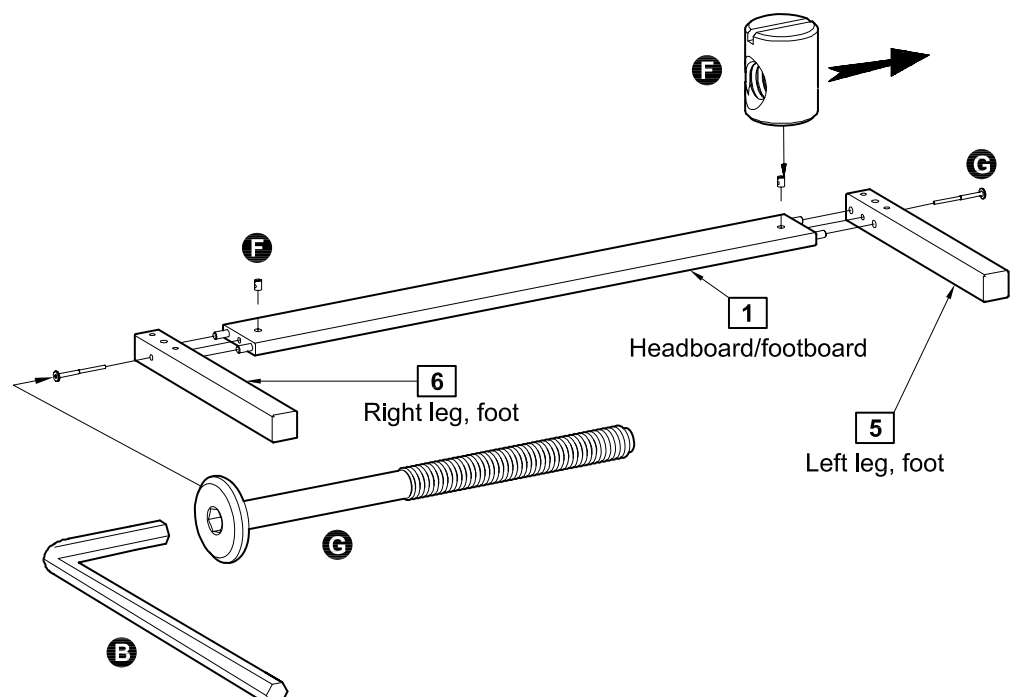


Step 5

Mounting the left leg, foot and the right leg, foot onto the headboard/footboard.

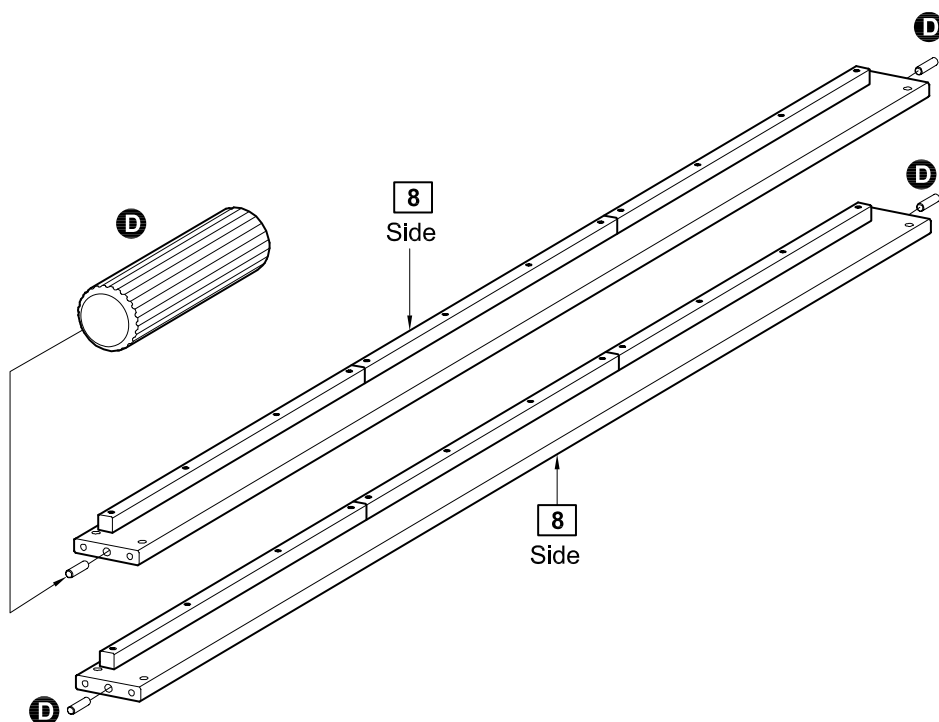
Place the nuts **F** onto the holes indicated on the headboard/footboard **1**, holes pointing towards to the screws.

Using screws **G** to fix the left leg, foot **5** and the right leg, foot **6** onto the headboard/footboard **1**.



Step 6

Insert the dowels **D** into the holes indicated on the sides **8**.

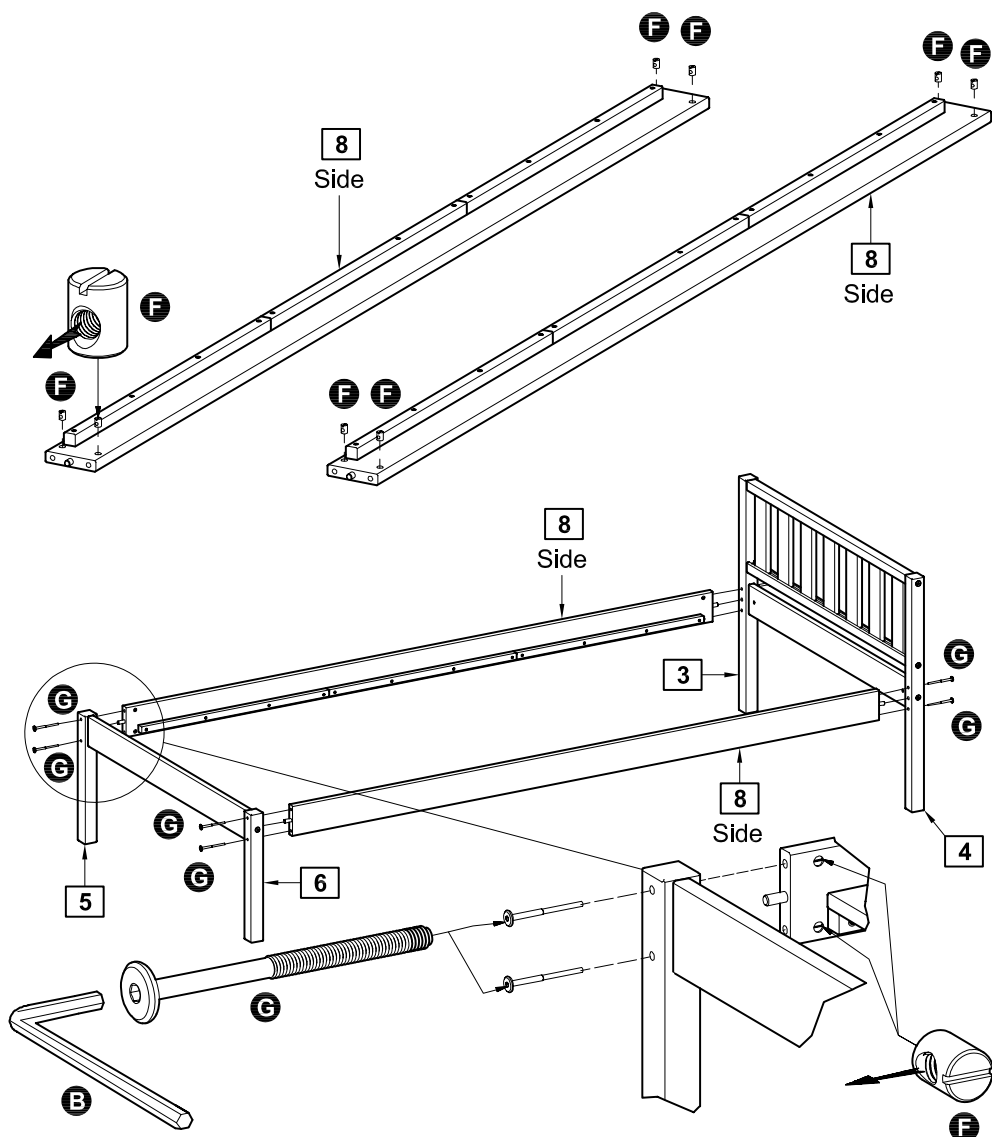


Step 7

Place the nuts **F** onto the holes indicated on the sides **8**.

Using screws **G** to fix the headboard and footboard to the sides **8**.

Again please note the holes of nuts pointing towards to the screws.

Step 8

Additional step to fix the slats.

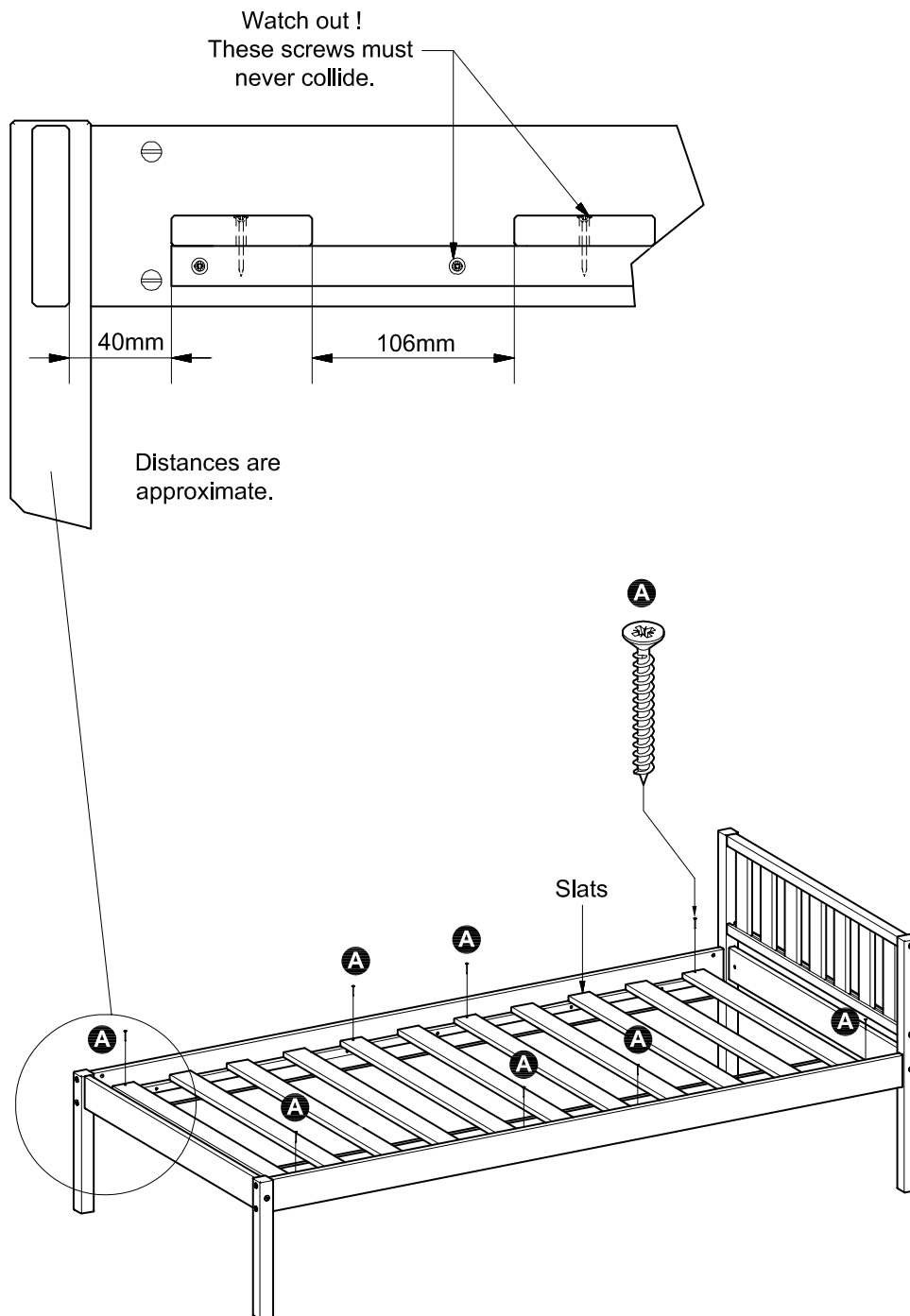
Note: The slats are supplied separately.

Spreading the slats evenly onto the bed frame.

Fix the slats to the slatholders using screws

Watch out! The screws attach the slatholders to the sides never collide to the screws that fix the slats to the slatholders.

Dear Customer.

Please note that the product you have purchased is a natural living timber.

Just like nature itself, wood varies in shape and colour. Knots, vein patterns, resin pockets and colour differences contribute to giving the piece of furniture its beauty and form - a natural part of solid wood.

Although the tree has been cut down and dried, it is still alive and therefore will react to high and low temperatures, light, humidity, drought and time.

In cold and dry periods, the wood contracts which may lead to small cracks in the piece of furniture. The reverse happens in warm and humid periods where the wood expands and this may result in slight unevenness.

The colour of the wood also changes with time, particularly if the furniture is placed in a light place. This is a natural process and part of owning a piece of furniture made of solid wood.

Any flexing that has occurred during transport will re-correct itself once this product is correctly assembled.

Tighten all joints of the furniture after six months.

Please keep these instructions in a safe place for future use.
