

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.

- Do not stand on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers **for inserting screws**,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.




1 Large top panel (70 x 34cm)



2 Small top panel (70 x 8.6cm)




3 Bottom panel (59 x 34.2cm)




4 Front panel (59 x 10.5cm)





7 Left side panel (39.6 x 70.5cm)















Note: The quantities below are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

A  30mm Dowel x 2	B  39mm Locking pin x 6	C  40mm Screw x 6
D  12mm Locking nut x 2	E  65mm Screw x 12	F  Screw cover x 16
G  Spring hinge x 1	H  14mm Screw x 4	I  15mm Locking nut x 4
J  18mm Screw x 8	K  Hinge x 2







Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws




Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Fitting dowels and locking pins

a: Insert Dowels **A** into the Bottom panel **3** and Back panel **5**.



b: Screw Locking pins **B** into the Small top panel **2** and Front panel **4**.

Note: Insert locking pins as far as shown.
Do not over tighten.



Step 2

Attaching bottom panel

a: Use Screws **C** to fix Back panel **5** onto the Bottom panel **3**.





b: Then carefully locate the Front panel **4** onto the unit.

Insert 2 Locking nuts **D** into the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts **D** clockwise to lock.


Step 3

Attaching side panels and bottom support

a: Use Screws **E** (65mm) and **C** (40mm) to fix Right side panel **6** onto the unit.


Use Screws **E** to fix Bottom support **8** onto the Right side panel **6**.

Use Screw covers **F** to cover the screw heads.



b: Position the Left side panel **7** onto the unit using Screw **E** (65mm) and **C** (40mm).

Use Screw covers **F** to cover the screw heads.




Step 4

Fitting hinges

Use Screws **H** to fix Spring hinge **G** onto the Left side panel **7**.





Step 5

Attaching top panels

a: Use Screws **J** to fix Hinges **K** onto the Large top panel **1**.


Step 5 - continued

b: Then carefully locate the Small top panel **2** onto the unit.

Insert 4 Locking nuts **1** into the unit.


Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts **1** clockwise to lock.

c: Use Screws **J** to fix Large top panel **1** onto the unit.



d: Use Screws **H** to fix the Spring hinge **G** onto the Large top panel **1**.




Step 6
