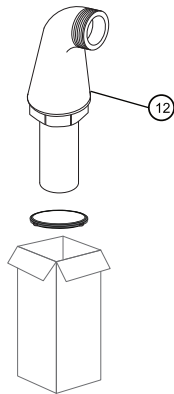
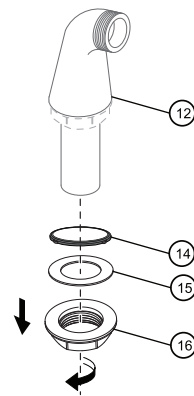


INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

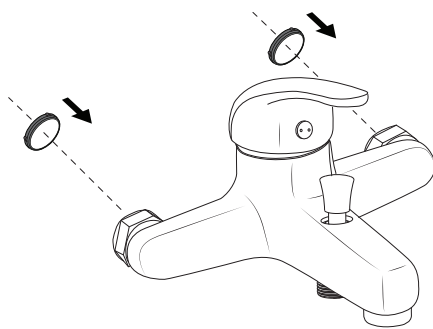
1 Take out the bath pillars. Do not mix the two different bath pillars up.



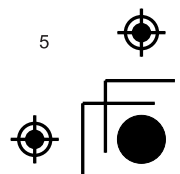
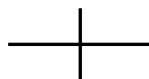
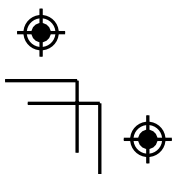
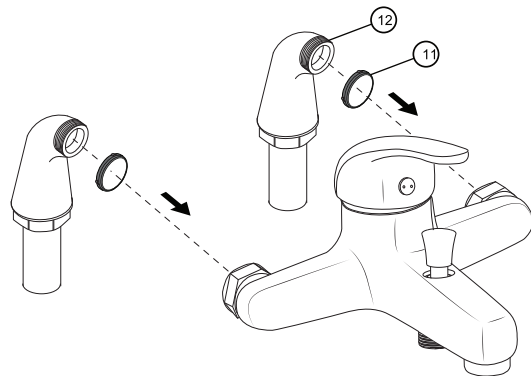
2 Remove the backnuts and washers from the bath pillars.

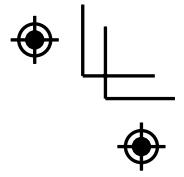
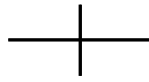
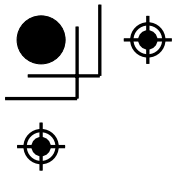


3 Fit the washers to the connector.



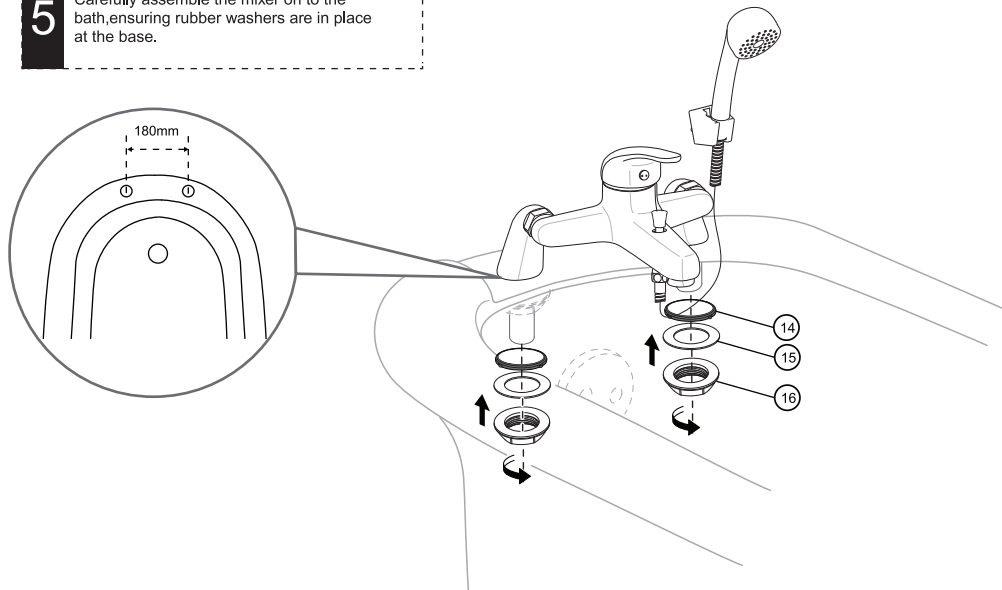
4 Tighten the bath pillars to the connectors, ensuring the bath legs are in the right place, HOT&COLD.



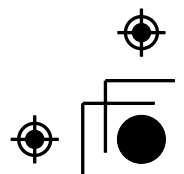
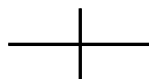
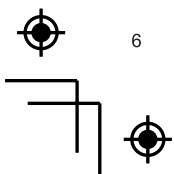
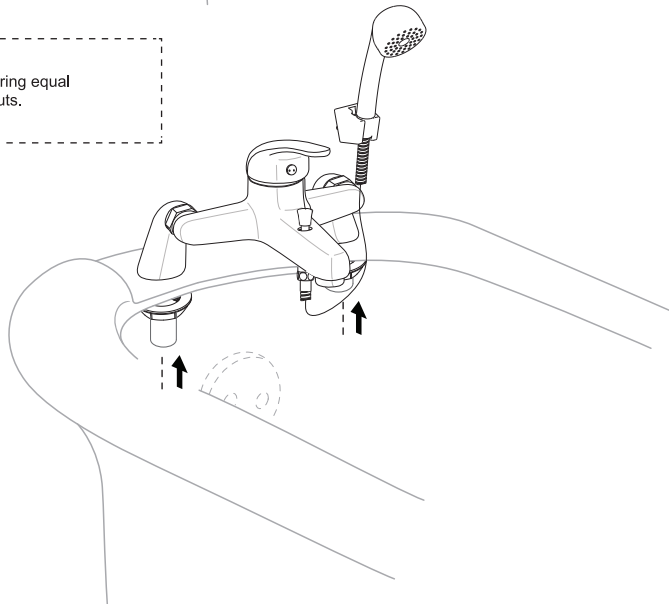


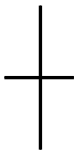
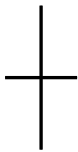
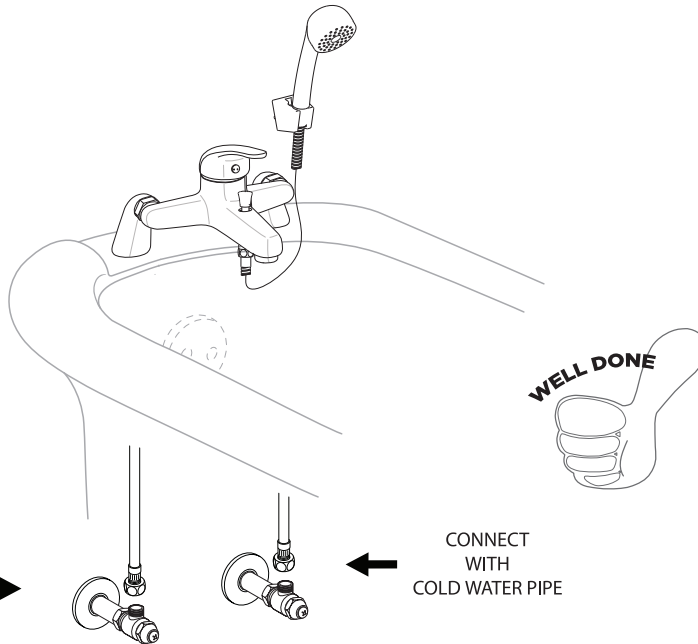
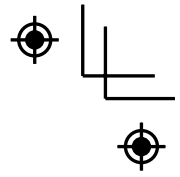
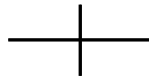
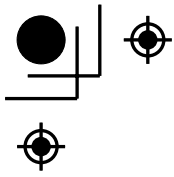
INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

- 5** Carefully assemble the mixer on to the bath, ensuring rubber washers are in place at the base.



- 6** Tighten the backnuts, ensuring equal torque is applied to both nuts.





AFTER INSTALLATION

Ensure that all connections are tight. Ensure that the handle is in the O position. Turn on the drain and main water supply, and check for leaks. Repair as needed.

CARE & CLEANING
