- Warning: This unit weighs approximately 25kgs. Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Safety note: It is recommended that this unit is secured to a wall using the bracket supplied.

Step 1


Prepare the drawer fronts

Screw 2 metal dowels **B** into the holes shown on the back of the left drawer front **12** and the right drawer front **13**.

Note: Tighten metal dowels up fully against the panels.



Note: The left drawer front 12 has a small identification hole.





Step 2

Prepare the drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut **①** into the hole shown on the left drawer side **8** and right drawer side **9**.

Note: Arrow on locking nut **must** point towards hole in edge of panel.





Step 3

Attach the drawer sides to the drawer front

Push the left drawer side

8 and right drawer side





Turn the small locking nuts **①** on the left drawer side **8** and right drawer side **9**.

Note: Turn the locking nuts clockwise to secure panels - more than 1/2 a turn.





Step 4

Fit the drawer base

Slide the drawer base 10 down the grooves in the drawer sides 8 and 9 and down into the groove in the drawer front 12 and 13.

Step 5

Fit the drawer back

Fit the drawer back 11 between the drawer sides 8 and 9.

Make sure that the drawer base 10 fits into the groove in the drawer back 11.

Hold the drawer back 11 in position and tap the knock-in pegs G through the holes in the drawer sides 8 and 9.


Attach the handles


Attach a handle **()** to each drawer front **12** and **13** using 2 screws **(1)**.




Fit the wedgefixes

Turn the drawer assembly over and slide 2 wedgefixes into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.










Step 8

Fit runners to the drawers

Turn the drawer assemblies over.

Fit the runner **Pc** to the bottom edge of the left drawer side **8**, as shown, making sure that it is pushed up against the back of the drawer front **12** and **13**. Use a bradawl to mark the fixing positions, then secure with 2 screws **K**.

Fit the runner **Pd** to the bottom edge of the right drawer side **9** using the same method.




Step 9

Prepare the 2 fascias

Check that the holes are in the same place as the diagrams, as one will be the left fascia and one will be the right fascia.

Screw 3 metal dowels **B** into each of the 2 fascias **7**.

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into each of the 2 fascias **7**.




Step 10

Prepare the left side

Insert 3 large locking nuts **©** into the left side **4**.


Note: The arrow on the locking nuts **must** point towards the holes in the edge of the panel.



Step 11


Join the left side to the left fascia panel

a: Push the left side 4 down onto the left fascia panel 7.



b: Use a screwdriver to tighten the 3 large locking nuts **6** fitted to the left side **4**.


Note: Turn the large locking nuts **(G)** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.



Step 12

Prepare the right side

Insert 3 large locking nuts **©** into the right side **5**.




Step 13

Join the right side to the right fascia panel

a: Push the right side **5** down onto the right fascia panel **7**.

b: Use a screwdriver to tighten the 3 large locking nuts **c** fitted to the right side **5**.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **(C)** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.



Step 14

Finish preparing the left side

a: Fit a runner **Pa** to the left side **4**.

The 1st screw **①** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws

use the holes that line
up with the other panel
holes.


Screw 3 metal dowels **B** into the left side **4**.


b: Fit a screw (3) into the 1st hole in at the top of the runner (Pa).


Insert 2 large locking nuts **©** into the left side **4**].

Fit 2 hinge plates **M** onto the left side **4**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the left side **4**.

Finish preparing the right side

a: Fit a runner **Pb** to the right side **5**.

The 1st screw **①** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws


Screw 3 metal dowels **B** into the right side **5**.

b: Fit a screw (3) into the 1st hole in at the top of the runner (P.b.).

Insert 2 large locking nuts **©** into the right side **5**.

Fit 2 hinge plates **M** onto the right side **5**, making sure that the slot is facing towards the finished front edge.

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the right side **5**.





Prepare the base

Insert 4 large locking nuts **©** into the base **2**.




Step 17

Fit the base

Push the base **2** onto the right side **5**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the base 2.




Step 18

Prepare the plinth

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into the plinth **6**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **©** into the plinth **6**.




Step 19

Fit the plinth

Push the plinth 6 onto the right side 5.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the large locking nut **©** fitted to the plinth **6**.




Step 20

Fit the left side

Push the left side 4 onto the assembly.


Use a screwdriver to tighten the 3 large locking nuts **©** fitted to the base **2** and plinth **6**.



Step 21

Prepare the top

Screw 6 metal dowels **B** into the top **1**.



Step 22

Prepare the divider

a: Fit a runner **Pa** to the divider **3**.


The 1st screw **①** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.


The 2nd and 3rd screws




b: Fit a screw **k** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner **Pa**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **©** into the divider **3**.









Note: Due to the manufacturing process, the 2 holes for the large locking nut can be on either surface of the divider.

Turn the divider over

C: Fit a runner **Pb** to the divider **3**.




d: Fit a screw (c) into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner (P.b.).












Step 23

Join the top and the divider

Push the divider 3 onto the top 1.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts • fitted to the divider 3.






Fit the top

Carefully stand the unit up for this step.

Push the top 1 down onto the assembly.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 4 large locking nuts **6** fitted to the left side **4** and right side **5**.





Step 25

Fit the back

Lay the unit back down for this step.


a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x** to **x** equals **y** to **y**.

b: Place the back 16 onto the unit.

Nail **E** around the outside edges of the back **16**.

Note: Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y



Step 26


Fit the 4 plastic nails

Tap 2 plastic nails into the bottom edge of each of the sides 4 and 5.

Stand the unit up for the next step.



Warning: The unit is heavy. Lift with care.



Step 27

Fit the overbalance protector

To prevent possible overbalancing we recommend that this unit is secured to a suitable wall by use of the overbalance protector kit


ightharpoonup fitted to the unit or, an alternative fixing method of your choice.

Wall fixings are not supplied as they will need to suit the wall type.

Note: Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.





Step 28

Fit the drawers


Slide the wheels of the runners fitted to the drawers, over the wheels of the runners fitted to the side panels and push the drawers into position.



Step 29

Fit the shelf studs


Insert the shelf studs finto the holes in the left side 4 and right side 5 at the required height.



Step 30

Fit the shelf

Lower the shelf 14 down onto the shelf studs **F**.




Step 31

Prepare the 2 doors

Push fit 2 hinges (1) into each of the 2 doors [15].

Secure each hinge with 2 screws **(K)**.

Note: Before securing with the screws, make sure that the hinges are positioned at 90 degrees with the edge of the door.



Step 32

Drill 2 handle holes in each of the doors

Important: Please follow these instructions carefully.

Lay the 2 doors 15 down onto a smooth surface.

Check that the hinges and holes are in the same place as the diagrams.


Note: We recommend the use of a small piece of waste wood, placed behind the holes while drilling, to reduce the possibility of any breakout.


Using the pilot holes in the rear face of the door, drill through the 2 holes indicated opposite, using a 2.5mm diameter drill.

Turn the door over and open out the 2.5mm holes that you have just drilled by drilling back through them with a 5mm drill.

IMPORTANT

Carefully choose which 2 holes you need to drill in each door





Step 33

Fit doors and handles

Note: The easiest way to attach each door 15 is to fit the top hinge first, then align and fit the other hinges.


onto the front part of the hinge plate **M**. The recess at the bottom of screw B goes into the slot in the hinge plate.

b: Keep the hinge N FLAT against the hinge plate M as you slide it across as far as it will go. Tighten screw A.

C: The hinge N must be flat against the hinge plate M prior to any adjustment.

d: The hinge N must NOT be AT AN ANGLE to the hinge plate when assembled. This would indicate that the recess at the bottom of screw B had not located in the slot in the hinge plate and the hinge would not be secure. Remove the hinge from the hinge plate and then re-assemble being careful to follow instructions a-c.

e: Attach a handle **o** to each door **15** using 2 screws **1**.



Step 34

Adjust the doors if needed

a: Before adjusting the doors, use a spirit level to check the base (or top) of the unit is level, front-to-back and side-to-side in the 3 positions shown.

Use suitable packing pieces (not supplied) to make the unit level BEFORE making any adjustment to the hinges, as shown.

b: Height adjustment.


Loosen screws A on hinge plates and move door up or down as required. Retighten screw A.

C: Forward and Back adjustment.

Loosen screw B on hinge plate and move door in or out as required. Retighten screw B.

d: Sideways adjustment.

To move door 'out' loosen screw C.
To move door 'in' tighten screw C.



Step 35

Assembly is complete
