A Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

• Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

• Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

• Place the product on flat and steady surface during use.

• Keep these instructions for future use.

• To ensure an easier assembly, we strongly advise that all fittings are only finger tightened during initial assembly. Only upon completion of the assembly should all fixing points be fully tightened.

Mattress height safety notice

Important

- 1) Please note the maximum mattress height is indicated on the corner post inside the opening at the top of the ladder.
- 2) This is legal requirement and it is vital that the mattress does not exceed this mark.
- 3) Maximum thickness of the mattress is 20cm:The top of the mattress shall not come above the line marked on the bed.
- 4) All assembly fixings should always be tightened properly. Take care to ensure that no fixings are loose.
- 5) Recommended size of the mattress for the top bunk is 90×190cm.
- 6) The bunk bed should not be used if any structural part is broken or missing.
- 7) Warning: High beds and the upper bed of bunk beds are not suitable for children under six years due to the risk of injury from falls.
- 8) Children can strangle in items such as ropes, strings, cords, harnesses and belts attached to or hung on a bunk bed.

Warning

1) Children can become trapped between the bed and wall. To avoid risk of serious injury the distance between the top safety barrier and the wall shall not exceed 75mm or shall be more than 230mm.

Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

Step 1

Assembling side frames

Lay front corner post 1 ,rear corner post 2, end panel 3 and lower stretcher 4 flat on the floor as shown.

Note: The holes in end panel **3** must be at the top.

Note: The bottom of rear corner post **2** is smaller diameter.

Insert end panel 3 into the large holes in posts 2.

Secure using fixings \triangle and \bigcirc .

Note: Do not fully tighten screws **A**.

Assemble lower stretcher **4** in between the corner posts using fixings **B** and **C**.

Note: Do not fully tighten screws **B**.

Insert end caps **D** into the top of the corner posts.

Repeat for the other side frame.



Step 2

Assembling guard rails

a: To assemble the rear guard rail, locate internal bracket **11** inside guard rail **6** as shown.

Secure using screw **D**.

Locate rear guard rail **5** onto guard rail **6** and secure using fixings **1** and **P**.



b: To assemble the front guard rail, repeat the steps from **a:** above, using front guard rail **7** and remaining guard rail **6**.

Step 3

Assembling rear guard

Two people are needed here.

With help, stand both side frames upright.

Assemble the rear guard rail **5** and **6** in between the side frames as shown.

Note: Do not fully tighten any screws during the assembly.

Secure at the top using fixings (a) and (c) as shown.

Secure at the bottom using fixings (**a**), (**b**) (**c**) and (**b**) as shown.

Note: Plastic washers are located in between the rear guard and the side frames.

With help, fit feet **Q** to corner posts **2** at the rear of the bunk.

Note: Ensure the feet extend out to the rear of the bed as shown.



Warning: The bunk bed is heavy. Lift



Step 4

Assembling front guard

At this stage, choose if you want the ladder on the right hand side or left hand side.

According to which side you want the ladder, assemble front guard rail **6** and **7** in between the side frames as shown.

Secure at the top using fixings \mathbf{B} and $\mathbf{\Theta}$.

Secure at the bottom using fixings (**3**, (**7**) (**6**) and (**1**).

Plastic plugs () can be used to cover the un-used holes in corner post 1 as shown.







Step 5

Assembling slats

Fit slats **9** in the very last fixing holes at each end of the bed.

Note: The arrow labels on 9 slats must point outside. 9

Note: Slats have been labelled for easier identification.



Step 6

Assembling slats

Locate external brackets **12** over the joints in the front and rear guard rails.

Note: Depending on which way round you have assembled the front guard rail, external bracket **12** may be visible on the outside of the bed.

With help, place two slats **10** on top of the external brackets and secure using Fixings **1** and **1**.



Step 7

Attaching ladder

Assemble ladder **8** to front guard **7** using fixings **G 1** and **(5**.

Fixings **J** are located inside the frame as shown.



Step 8

Assembling slats

Assemble remaining slats **10** using screws **1** as shown.



Assembly is complete.
