



#### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

• Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

 Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

• Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

• During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

• Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

• Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

- · Do not stand on the chair.
- Do not use this chair as step ladder.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

- Unit weight: 3.4 kgs.
- Maximum safe weight of user: 110kgs.

#### Care and maintenance

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners. • From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.


### **Handy Hints**

# **Assembly Instructions**

### Step 1

### Attaching backrest

Position the upper leg 1 and lower leg 2 in a crossed position as shown.

With the help of an assistant holding the legs, insert the legs into holes on the backrest 3 as shown.

Then fix through holes using bolts **A** and tighten with allen key **G**.

Important: Do not fully tighten the bolts at this stage.

Step 2

#### **Attaching seat**

Place the seat 4 face down on a flat and raised surface such as a table.

Position the chair frame on the seat 4 as shown then fix through holes using bolts **B** then tighten with allen key **G**.




Important:

Carefully turn over the chair. Place it on a flat even surface and make adjustments to ensure the legs are even on the floor.

Then fully tighten bolts A fixed on step 1 using allen key **C**.

Assembly is complete.
