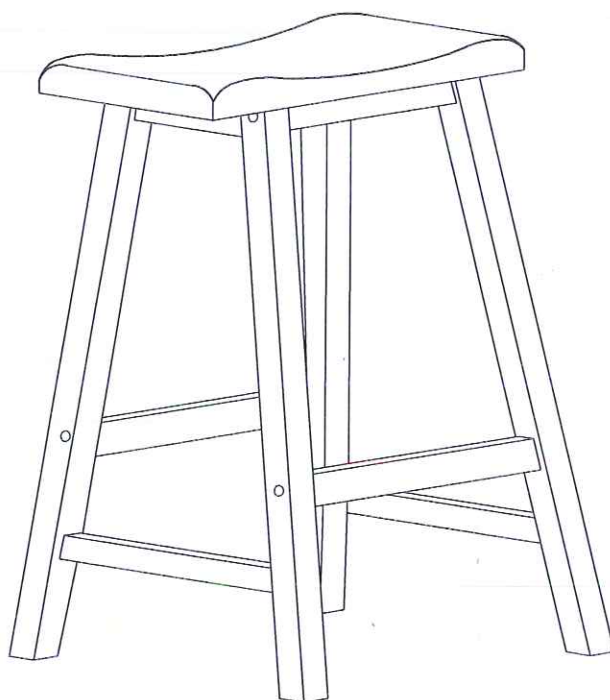

Safety and care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2.

- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



power drill is set on a low torque setting.

- To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

- Maximum Safe user weight : 110kgs

- Do not stand on the stool

- Do not use this stool as step ladder.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts

- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.

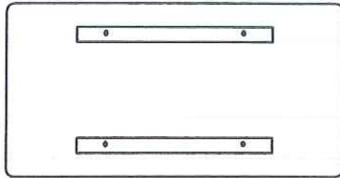

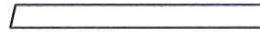

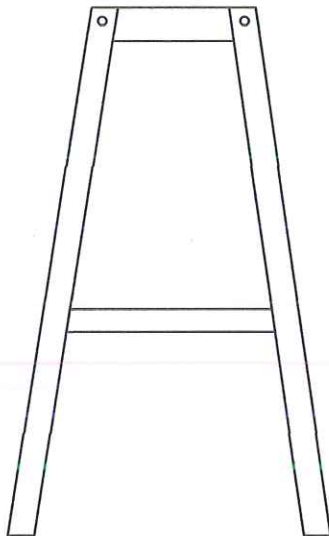
- 1** Seat x1

Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

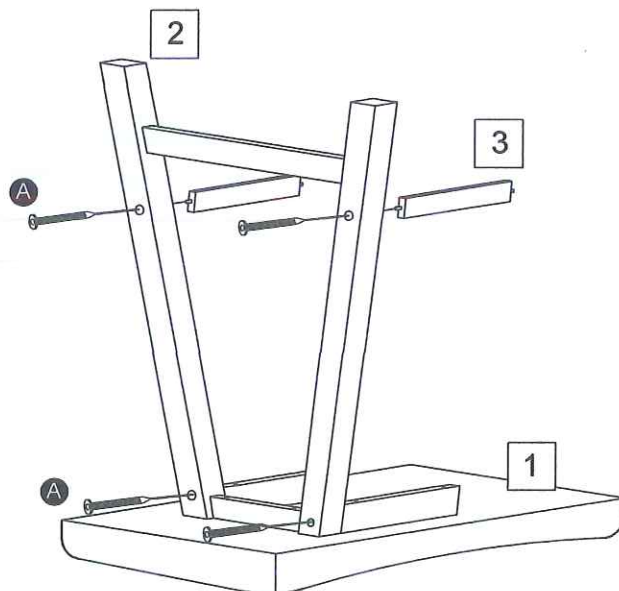
Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Assembling legs

- a. Place seat **1** upside down smooth carpet surface. Line up legs of leg frame **2** with screw holes on bottom of seat **1** and using fixing **A**.
- b. Insert Stretcher **3** into leg frame **2** and using fixing **A**

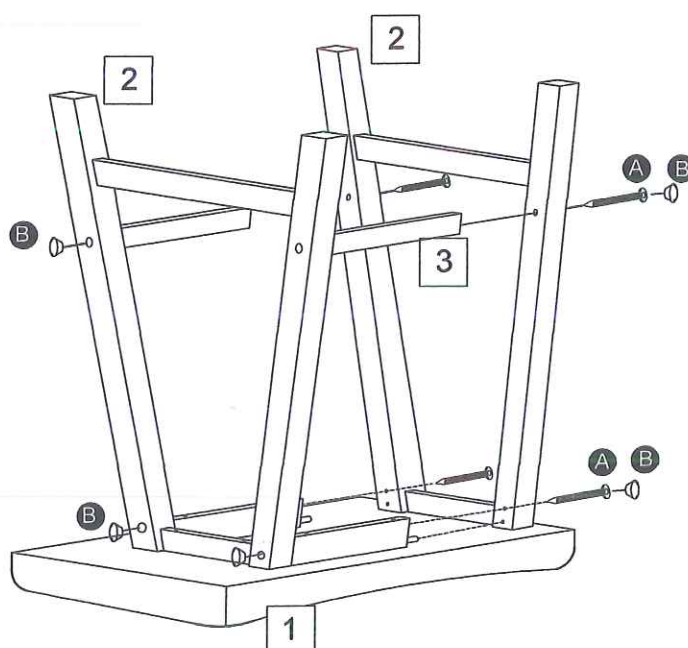
Note : Do not fully tighten at this stage.



Step 2

Assembling Legs

- a) Line up of second leg frame **2** with screw holes on bottom of seat **1** and using fixing **A**. Do not tighten these screw all the way until you insert the stretcher **3** when all holes are aligned. Tighten all remaining screw.
- b. Insert wood button **B** into every hole in leg frame **2**.

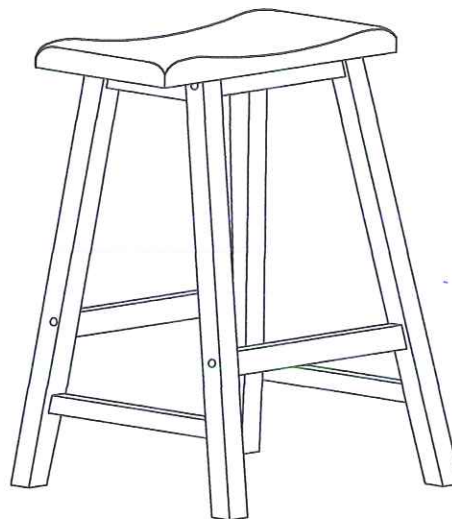
Step 3

Completing Assembly

Turn chair upright and place on a level surface.

Whilst applying a firm downward pressure to the seat, tighten all screws.

Assembly is complete.
