

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste.


1 Front panel (110.4 x 34.9cm)




2 Back panel (110.4 x 34.9cm)




3 Top panel (120.1 x 40.1cm)




4 Bottom panel (110.4 x 34.8cm)




5 Left side panel (29.5 x 34.8cm)






The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

Step 1


Fitting the left side and right side panels

a: Screw Locking pins ointo the Front left leg 7, Back left leg 9, Back right leg 10 and Front right leg 8.

Note: Insert Locking pins as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**




b: Insert Dowels **f** into the Left side panel **5** and Right side panel **6**.



C: Carefully locate the Front left leg 7, Back left leg 9, Back right leg 10 and Front right leg 8 onto the Left side panel 5 and Right side panel 6.

Insert 8 Locking nuts into the Left side panel 5 and Right side panel 6.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts clockwise to lock.



Step 2


Attaching front, bpttom and back panels

a: Insert Dowels **•** into the Bottom panel **•** .

Use Screws © to fix Foot onto the Bottom panel 4.

b: Screw Locking pins **o** into the Back panel **o** and Front panel **o** .

Note: Insert Locking pins as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**




C: Carefully locate the Bottom panel 4 onto the Back panel 2.

Insert 3 Locking nuts (a) into the Bottom panel (4).

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts clockwise to lock.


With help, ask someone to hold the Front panel 1.


d: Carefully locate the Front panel 1 onto the Bottom panel 4.

Insert 3 Locking nuts (a) into the Bottom panel (4).

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts **©** clockwise to lock.




Step 3

Attaching left side and right side panels

Use 8 Screws A to fix Left side panel 5 and Right side panel 6 onto the unit.

Use Screws covers **©** to cover the screw heads.




Step 4

Attaching top panel

a: Use Screws **3** to fix the Hinges **1** onto the Door panel **3**.






With help, ask someone to hold the Door panel 3.

b: Use Screws **3** to fix the Hinges **1** onto the Back panel **2**.








c: Use Screws • to fix the Left spring hinge • and Right spring hinge • onto the Left panel • and Right panel •



d: Use Screws **©** to fix the Left spring hinge **①** and Right spring hinge **⑥** onto the Door panel **③**.




Step 5
