

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

- Unit weight: 5 kgs.
- Maximum safe weight of user: 110kgs.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.


Warnings



Assembly Instructions

Step 1


Attaching legs


Position the upper leg 3 and lower leg 4 as shown. Align holes and fix using bolt **3** and **6**.



Important:

Tighten bolt and nut using allen key and spanner but do not fully tighten at this stage.





Step 2


Attaching stretcher


Position the stretcher 2 between the legs as shown. Align holes and fix using bolts **A**.



Important:

Tighten bolts using allen key but do not fully tighten at this stage.





Assembly Instructions

Step 3

Aligning the legs

Place the leg frame on a flat surface.

Fully tighten bolt **3** and nut **4** assembled in step 1 first using allen key **4** and spanner **7**.

Carefully make adjustments to the leg frame to ensure the legs are flat even on the floor.

Then fully tighten bolts **A** on stretcher **2** using allen key **6**.

Step 4

Attaching seat

Place the seat 1 face down on a flat protected and raised surface.


Position the leg frame on the seat as shown. Align the holes and fix using bolts **(A)** and curved washers **(D)**. Tighten the bolts using allen key **(E)**.





Important:
Do not over tighten bolt (A).

Carefully turn over the bar stool.
