• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.






Fitting the Back rest


Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

b: Insert Dowels **D** into Front apron **3** and Back apron **5**.









Fitting the Right side frame

Fitting the Left side frame


Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Insert Barrel nuts (E) into Back rest 6.

Use Screws (A) to fix Back rest (6) onto the Left side frame (1).

Note: Insert Barrel nuts into the Back rest taking care to align the screw holes.


Note: Do not tighten the screws at this moment.



Use Screw (A) to fix Back apron 5 onto the Left side frame 1.

Note: Insert Barrel nut into the Back apron taking care to align the screw hole.




c: Insert Barrel nuts **(B)** into Front apron **(3)**.


Use Screw (B) to fix Front apron (3) onto the Left side frame (1).

Note: Insert Barrel nut into the Front apron taking care to align the screw hole.



d: Use Screw **(**) to fix Cross bar **7** onto the Left side frame **1**.






Step 4

Fitting the Seat cushion

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

Use Screws **(b** to fix the Seat cushion **(4)** onto the unit.

Fully tighten all screws now.



Step 5

Finishing the unit

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

With help, turn the unit upright. Place the unit in the intended position.

Note: Before use always make sure the unit is secure.


