

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on page 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the panels during assembly, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/driver for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit.
Only use hand screwdrivers.

 Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.


Care and maintenance

 Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.






1 Table Top (60 x 40cm)




3 Shelf (45 x 29.6cm)


Step 1


Fitting the shelf

a: Insert dowels **B** into the shelf **3**.

b: Use screws to fix the right side panel 4 and left side panel 5 onto the support 6 and shelf 3.

C: Insert dowels **(3)** into the unit.

Step 2

Fitting the bottom panel


a: Use screws **()** to fix the bottom panel **(2)** onto the unit.

b: Use screws **D** to fix the feet **G** onto the unit.

Step 3

Fitting the table top


a: Screw locking pins a into table top 1. Insert locking pins as far as shown.





Step 3 - continued

b: Attach table top 1 onto the unit.



c: Insert locking nuts into left side panel 5 and right side panel 4, then use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts clockwise to lock.




Step 4

Finishing the unit

a: Use plastic plugs **a** to cover the screw heads.
