




Right hand side frame (73 x 55cm)





Step 2


Attaching top shelf

and spring washers A.




Step 3

Attach the keyboard shelf 5 push into the runner on the metal frame.




Step 4

Attaching bottom shelf


Two people are required here.


b: Fix the bottom shelf

Attaching castors


Fix 2 pcs of brake castors **©** and 2 pcs of castors **D** to the unit.
