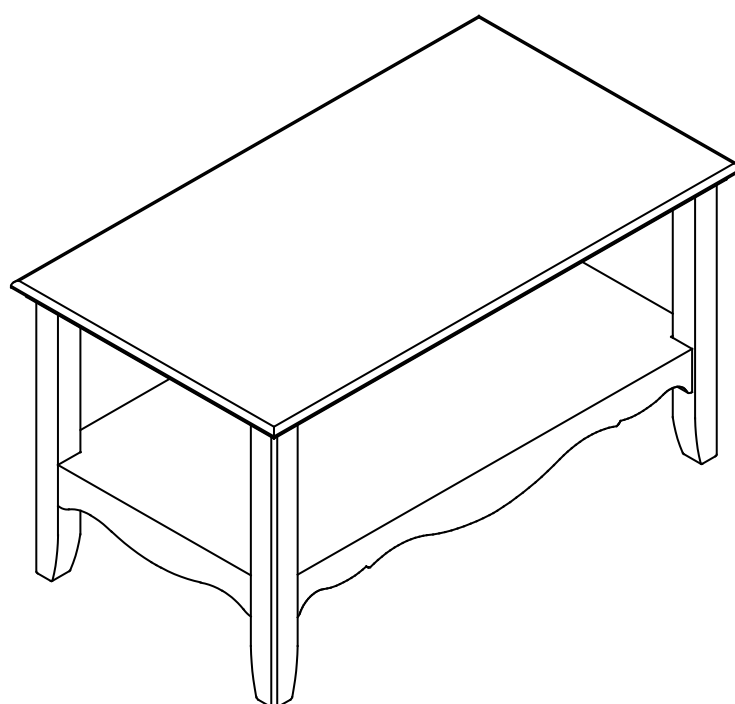

# Safety and Care Advice

**Important** – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.

## Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

## Handy Hints

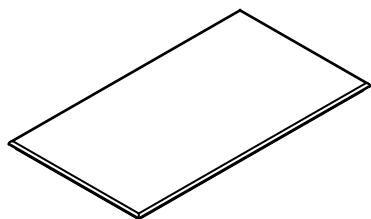
- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.

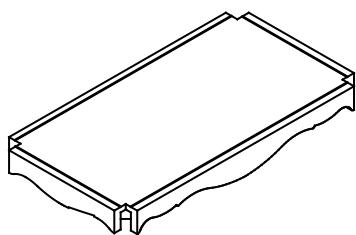

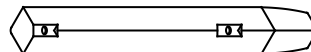

**3** Frame shelf (75 x 40cm)








**2** Legs x 4 (42.5 x 4cm)



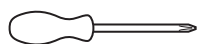

<p><b>D</b></p>  <p>Allen key x 1</p>	<p><b>E</b></p>  <p>20mm Pads x 4</p>	

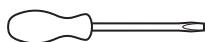

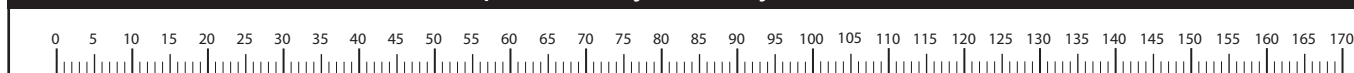


Ruler/tape

## Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws



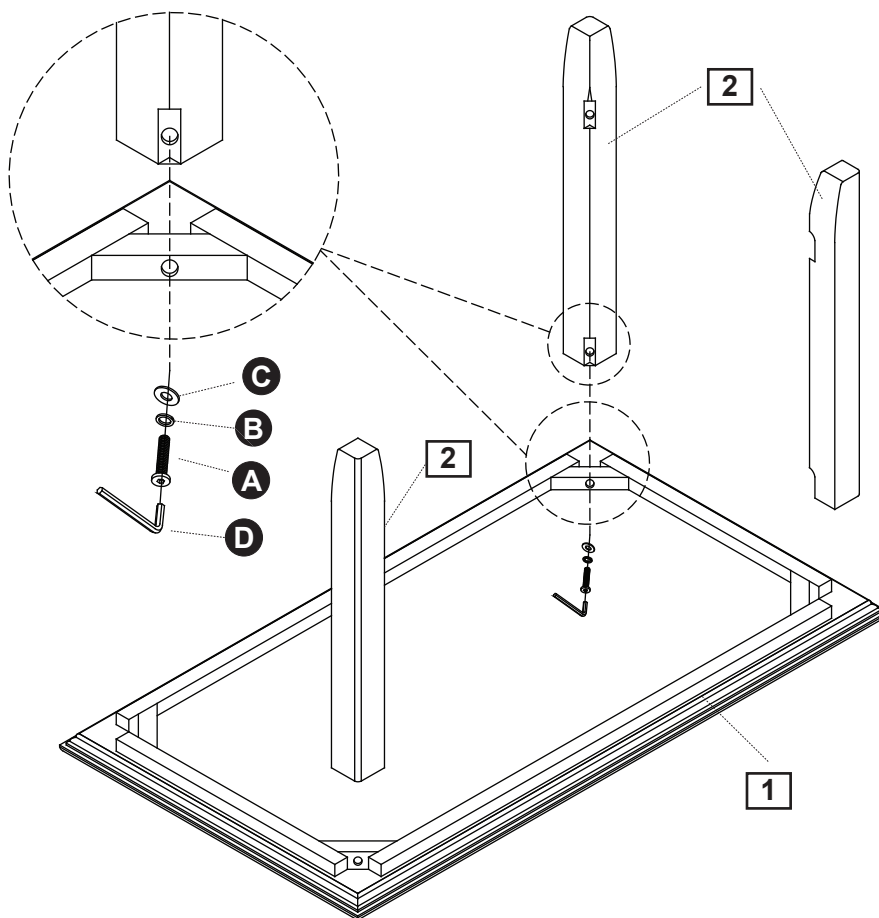
The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

# Assembly Instructions

## Step 1

### Assembly legs

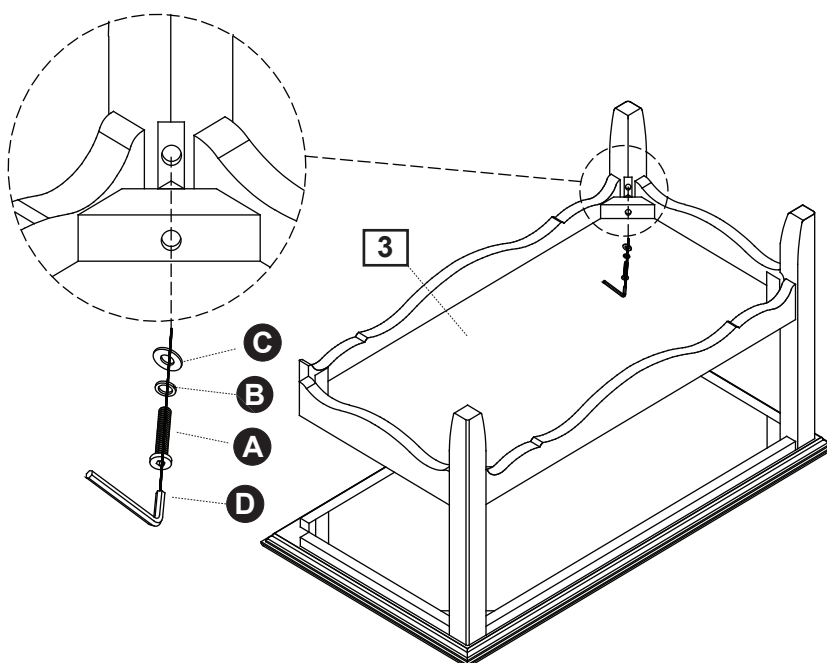
Attach Legs **2** to Table Top **1** Using bolts **A**, spring washer **B** and flat washer **C**. Tighten with supplied allen key **D**. Do not over tighten.



## Step 2

### Assembly frame shelf

Position frame shelf **3** into the legs **2** Using bolts **A**, spring washer **B** and flat washer **C**. Tighten with supplied allen key **D**. Do not over tighten.

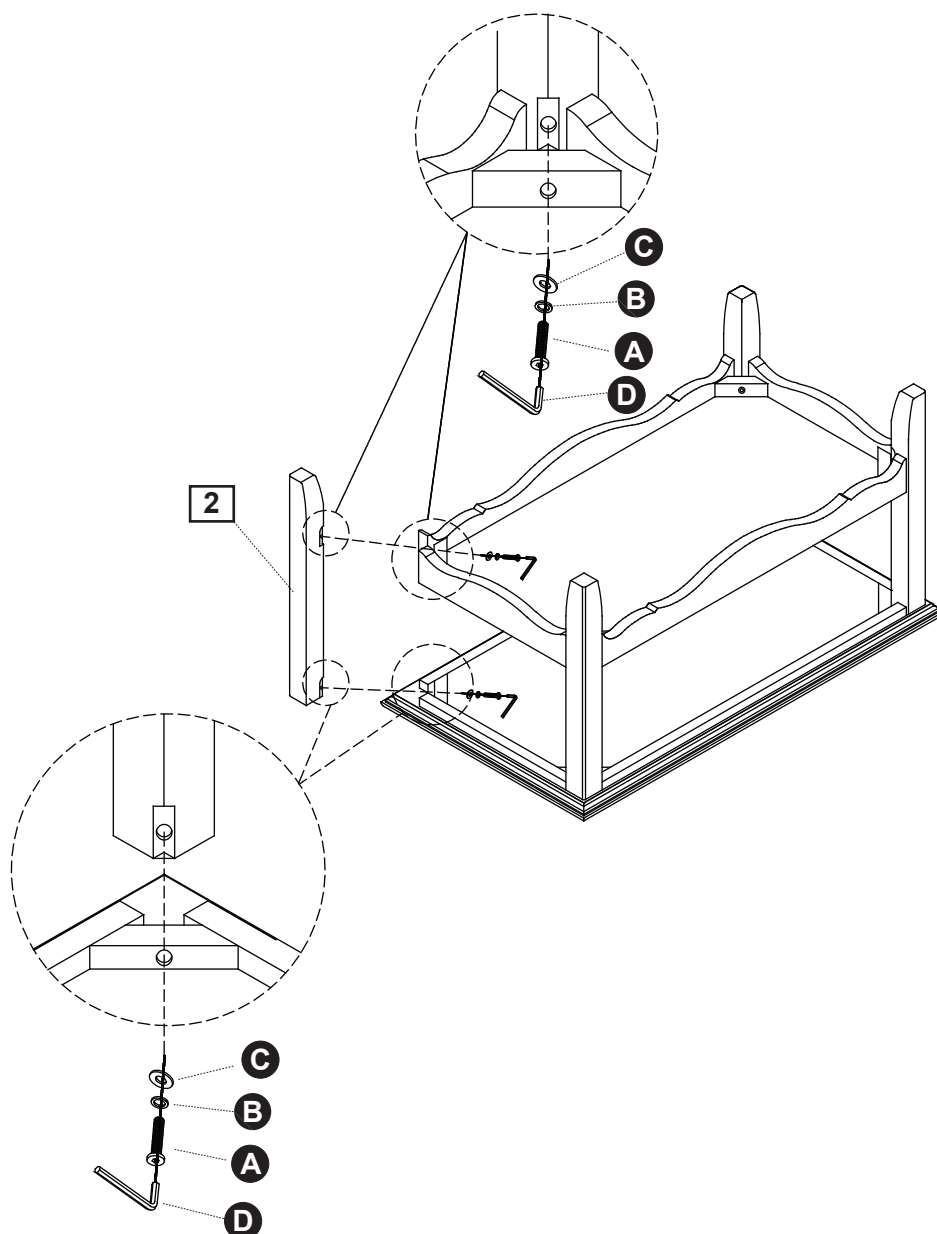


# Assembly Instructions

## Step 3

### Assembly legs

Position leg **2**  
to table top & frame shelf  
Using bolts **A**  
spring washer **B** and  
flat washer **C**. Tighten  
with supplied allen key **D**  
Do not over tighten.



## Step 4

### Attach the pad

Remove cover paper on the  
pad **E**. Attach the pad  
into under the legs.  
With help stand the coffee  
table upright.
