




Enclosure Set & Enclosure Net USER MANUAL

Assembly, Installation, Care, Maintenance and Use Instructions.

This Instructions manual is for Upper Bounce Enclosure Sets and Enclosure Nets which is designed to fit most model Trampolines.

- ▶ Models begins with UBES: for Inside type Enclosure Sets
- ▶ Models begins with UBESOS: for Outside Type Enclosure Sets
- ▶ Models begins with UBNET: for Enclosure Nets Only
- ▶ Models begins with UBESFG: for Flex On Top Models


Before you are ready to start installing your new Enclosure Set, please verify that the enclosure set you are going to install matches the trampoline size you have.

Measuring Tips For Enclosure Set

These are the steps to make sure you purchased the right Enclosure Set:

STEP 1 FRAME SIZE

Measure your frame from one outside edge vertically and horizontally to the other outside edge so you get the correct measurements.



STEP 2 POLE AMOUNT

Count the legs. The amount of W shaped legs you have that's the amount of poles you will need.



or connect 2 poles to each leg as shown in figure 2.




For example - If your legs count is 6 W shaped legs you need 6 poles. If it counts 4 legs you can either take 4 poles for every second leg (Fig. 1) or 8 poles (Fig. 2).

STEP**3****POLE CONNECTOR**

Measure the diameter of your trampoline leg to make sure that the pole connecting tool fits your trampoline. If the leg measures up to 1.75" you will need a 1.75" connector.



Measuring Tips For Enclosure Net

If you purchased an enclosure net only

1. Make Sure the Net size matches the frame size (see above how to measure the frame size).
2. Make sure the poles/arch amount of the product matches the amount of your trampoline.
3. Make sure the height of the product is matching to the height of your existing poles or arches.


Warning :

2 adults in good physical condition are required for the following assembly. Wear proper shoes and maintain balance to prevent a fall. Failure to follow all instructions and warnings may result in serious injury.

1. First, place all parts to be used in the process of installation in front of you.


For straight poles - For the lower poles use the ones that are tapered.

For curved poles - Use the curved pole as the upper pole.




2. Take the clamp and clasp the lower enclosure pole into the rounded end of the clamp. Make sure that the black rubber cap of the lower pole faces down.

- a) If the pole fits too loosely, insert the green rounded piece before clamping the pole so clamp will tightly clasp the pole.




- b) If the pole is too thick and does not fit into the hole, remove the green rounded piece to create more space for the pole. You should then be able to clasp the trampoline pole into the clamp.




- c) Once the pole is securely inserted into the clamp, you should now insert the plastic bracket until you reach the pole.


3. Be aware that the mark on the lower pole needs to align with the trampoline frame. If there is no line on the pole then please have it attached 18" below the frame.




4. The set comes with 2 clamps per pole. One being attached 2" **below frame**, while the other being attached 2" **above the end of the lower pole**.



5. Insert the plastic bracket, then clasp the trampoline leg into the clamp. Secure tightly with steel brackets and nuts.




6. Now you can have the upper part of the pole inserted into the lower part that is already attached to the leg.




7. Repeat the steps above to have all your enclosure poles connected securely to your trampoline legs.

Cover all the poles with the PVC Sleeve (Item T).




8. After connecting all enclosure poles insert the pole caps, if you have an inside type net use part number E1 and for outside type Net use E2. If you are using the curved poles, use the pole caps provided.


For inside type net E-1

Note: When installing the net make sure that the Upper Bounce logo is placed on the outside of the trampoline.

STEP 1

POLE STRAPS


If you purchased a straight pole Enclosure Set use this step

If you have a "C" Type pole cap. Hook on all straps into "C" & follow step 2




NOTE: If you purchased a ring on top enclosure set continue to page 12.

If you have a plain pole cap wrap all straps around cap & follow step 2




If Your Trampoline has Arches
Connect the straps to arches and tighten according to your preferences.



STEP 2


ROPE

Start by inserting one end of the rope to the beginning of the safety net entrance. Secure the rope by making a knot around the first V-ring so the rope is now attached to the trampoline. Weave it through the net and V-rings through every second V-ring until the other end of the net entrance. Make another knot around the last V-ring at the other end of the rope.



You can also connect the net to the v-rings with clips.

You can skip step 5 and connect the net to the V-rings with the clips. We always recommend to use the ropes for extra stability.

STEP

1

INSERT THE NET TO THE POLES

Start installing the Net to the poles by inserting the beginning of the Sleeve on the Poles Until it reaches 2 ft. and continue doing the same to all poles as figure 1.



Pull down each sleeve, a few inches at a time till all sleeves reach the bottom of enclosure frame as shown in figure 2.





CONNECT BOTTOM STRAPS





Choose whether you would like to connect the net on the outside (Option A), or the inside of the trampoline (Option B).

Option A - Attach the Net on the Outside of the trampoline

Connect bottom straps/clips to every few Jumping mat v-rings from under the Safety Pad. Attach the clips from outside as figure shows.

**Option B - Attach the Net on the Inside of the trampoline**

Pull the net closer to the mat on the bottom, and Connect the bottom straps/clips to every few jumping mat V-rings. The bottom of the net should be between the pad and the mat.




STEP

1

INSERT THE NET TO THE ARCHES

Disconnect the top arches, slide top arch part into sleeve.
When arch part and poles meet click them back together tightly.




STEP

2


ROPE

Start by inserting one end of the rope to the beginning of the safety net entrance. Secure the rope by making a knot around the first V-ring so the rope is now attached to the trampoline. Weave it through the net and V-rings through every second V-ring until the other end of the net entrance. Make another knot around the last V-ring at the other end of the rope.



Optional Step to connect the Net with Clips instead of ropes

You can skip step 5 and connect the net to the V-rings with the clips. We always recommend to use the ropes for extra stability.



STEP 1


Connect the Pole Caps to the top of the poles with screw.



STEP 2


Note : You will need to run the fiberglass into the top sleeves of the net, and connect 1 fiber to the other while running it from 1 sleeve to the other, there is various ways how to connect 1 to the other. See step 4,

Start connecting the Fiber glass to each other, by clicking them together, until you finish all the rods.



STEP 3


Start by running the Fiberglass Rods through the sleeves opening at the upper edge of the safety net until you reach the other side of the sleeve as figure 1.




STEP 4

After inserting the top rods through all the sleeves you need to connect all rods together, there is several ways to connect it:


1. With T pole caps as figure 1.





2. With nuts that connects it together with Adjustable Wrench as figure 2.



3. Connect each other by just clicking them together.




At last point add the connector to complete the circle





STEP 5

To connect the ring, have another person stand on the opposite side of you and push the rods towards the center as shown in fig.




STEP 6

Insert the assembled rod circle into the opening of the pole cap.



STEP 7

Start by inserting one end of the rope to the beginning of the safety net entrance. Secure the rope by making a knot around the first V-ring so the rope is now attached to the trampoline. Weave it through the net and V-rings through every second V-ring until the other end of the net entrance. Make another knot around the last V-ring at the other end of the rope.
