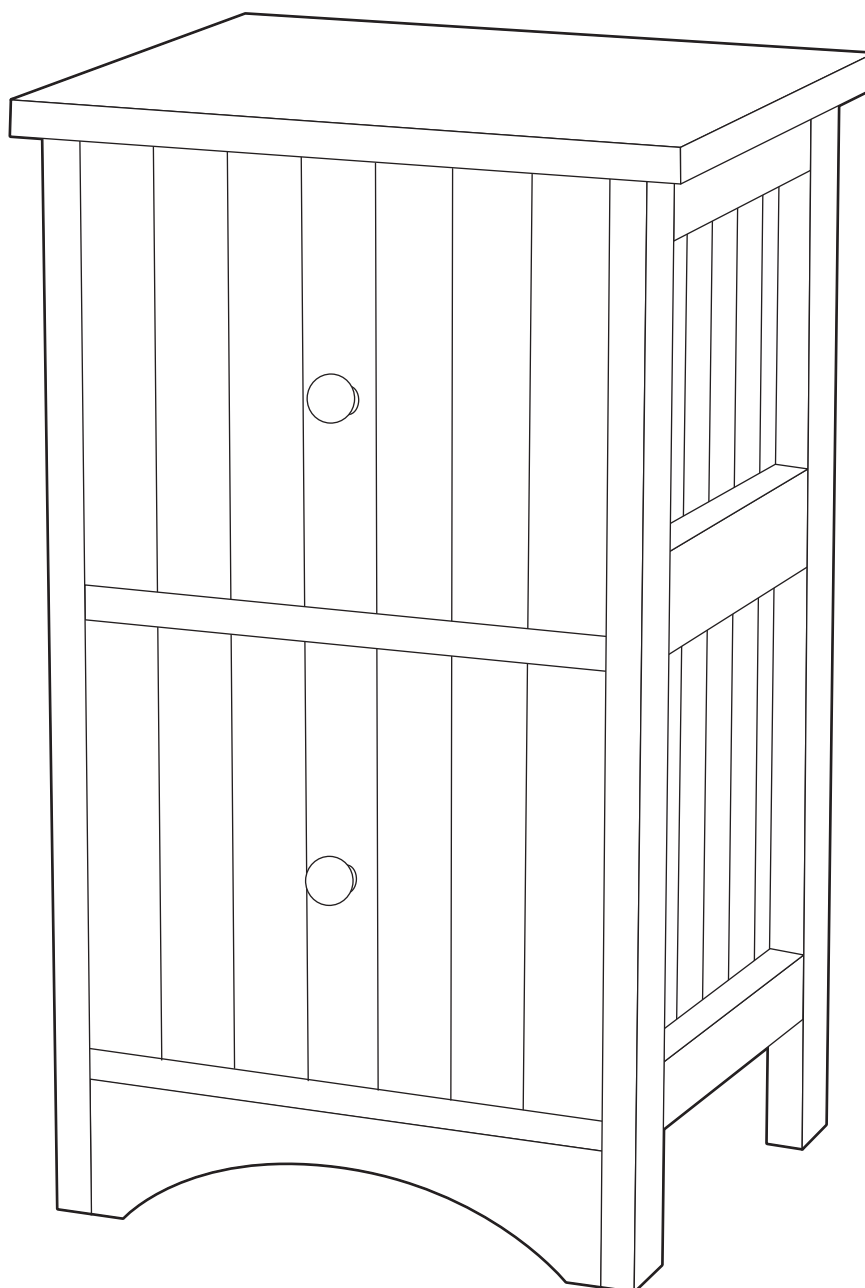


White Tongue & Groove 2 Drawer Unit

Safety and care advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the panels, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the unit as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

• **Note:** Only apply the glue once you are sure of the assembly.

- The wall plugs supplied are suitable for solid walls only. It is important that the correct type of fixing is used for your wall, seek professional advice if in doubt.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- If using power tools, please follow the safety instructions supplied with the tools.



- We do not recommend the use of power drill/ drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage

the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- **Warning:** Before drilling, check the wall for hidden pipes and cables.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

- **Warning:** The unit weighs approximately 5 kgs.

Please lift with care.

Glue safety - Take care when using glue, please follow the advice below

Skin contact: Remove contamination by washing with soap and water. This procedure should also be followed prior to eating and drinking.

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice.

If swallowed: Seek medical advice immediately. If possible show product information or label to the medical advisor.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

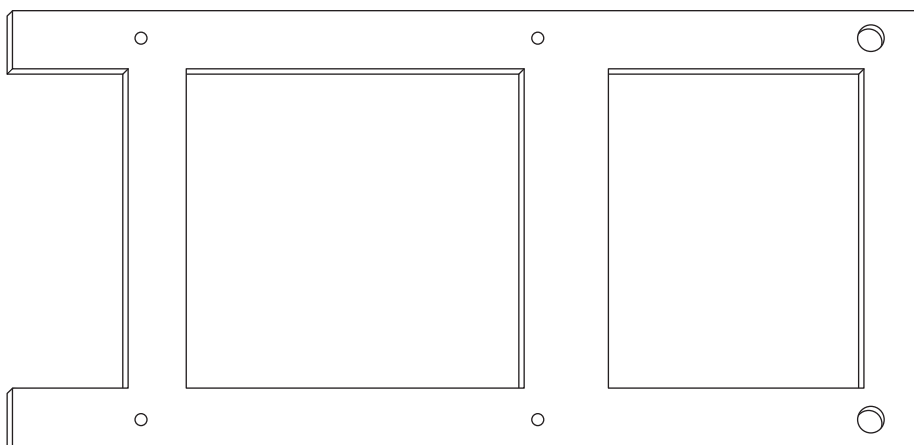
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

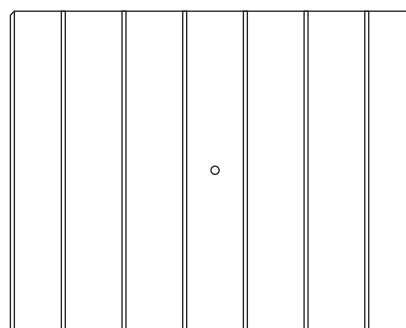

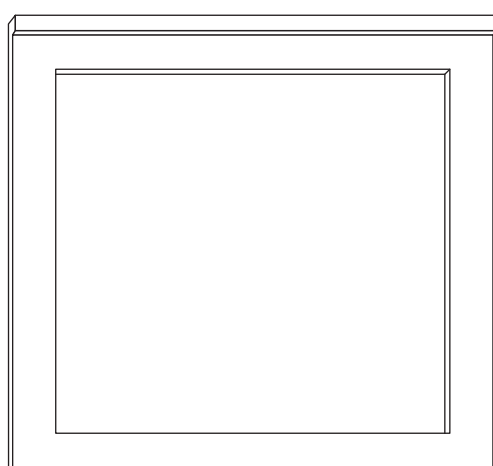
1 Side x 2 (54.5x26cm)



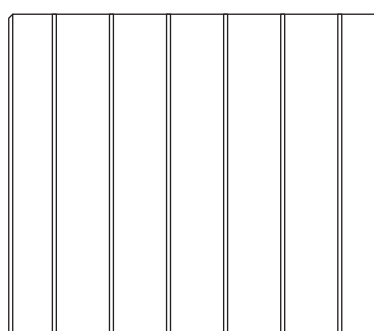
2 Table Top (34x28cm)



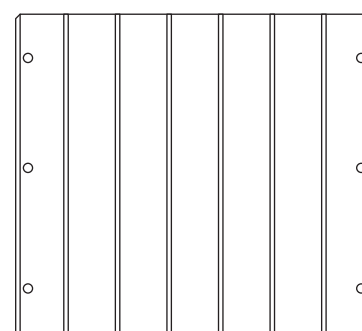
5 Drawer Front x 2 (22x27.5cm)



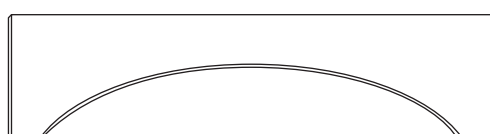
3 Support x 2 (26x27.5cm)



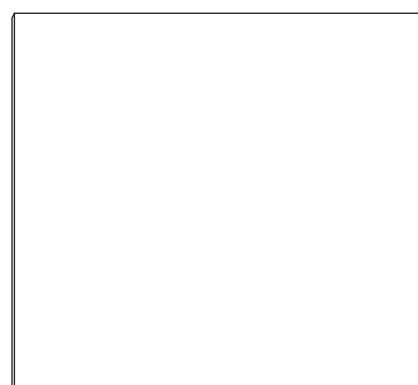
6 Drawer Back x 2 (22x25.5cm)

4 Front (7x27.5cm)










Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws



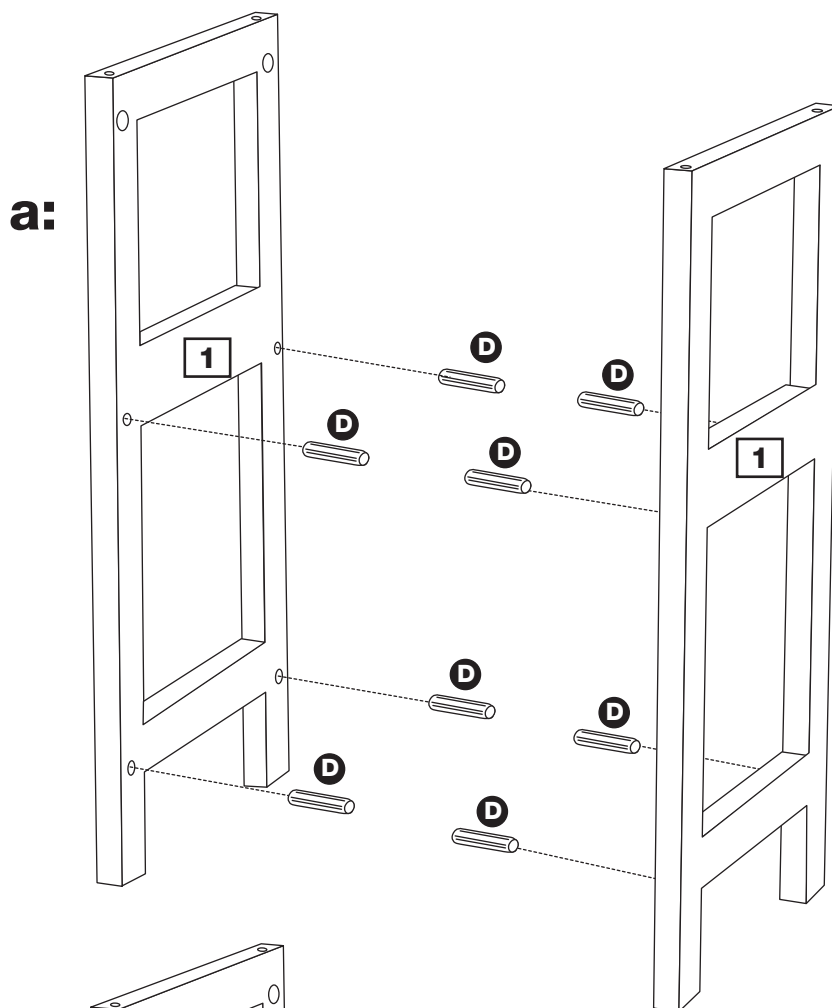

Step 1

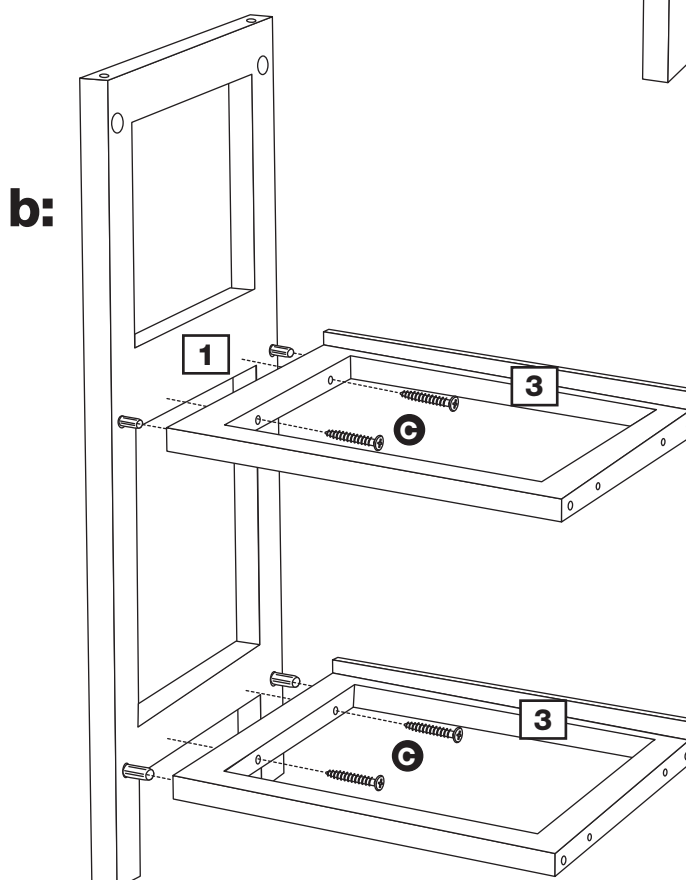
Assembling the Side Panels

NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Insert Dowels **D** into Side Panels **1**.



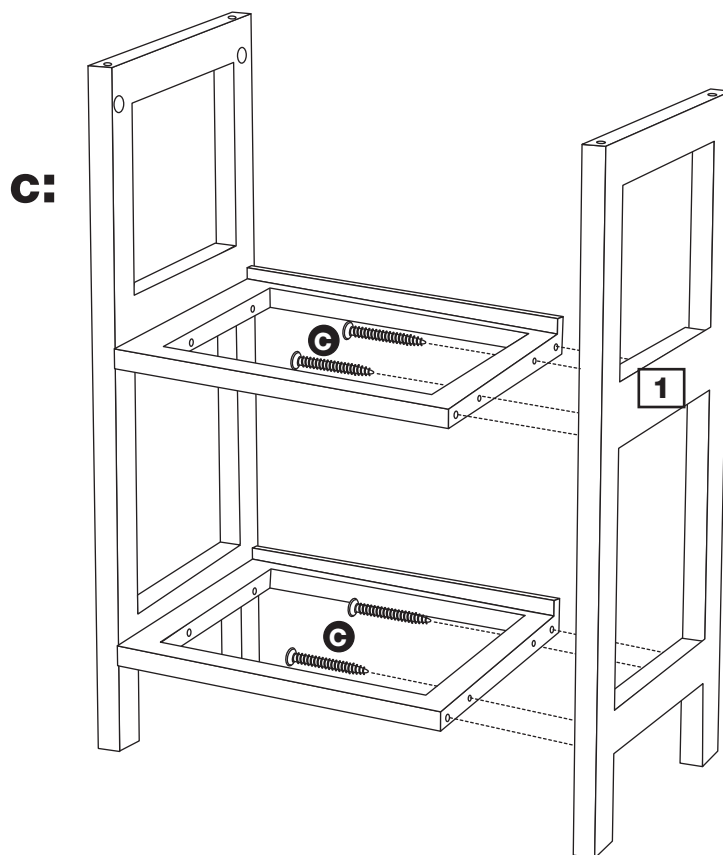
b: Use Screws **C** to fix the Supports **3** on the Side Panel **1**.



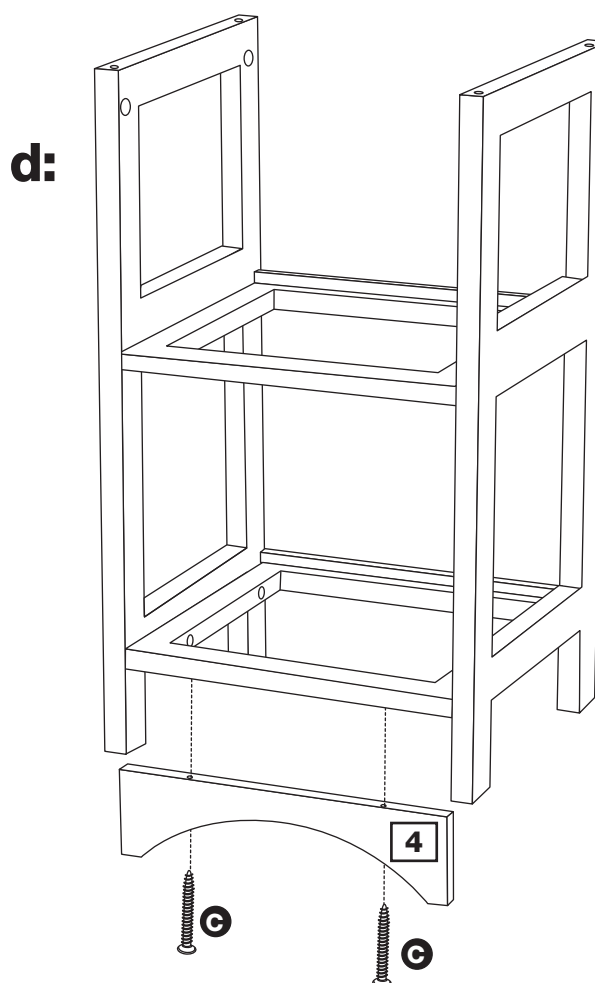

c: Use Screws **C** to fix the other Side Panel **1** onto the unit.



d: Use Screws **C** to fix the Front Panel **4** onto the unit.



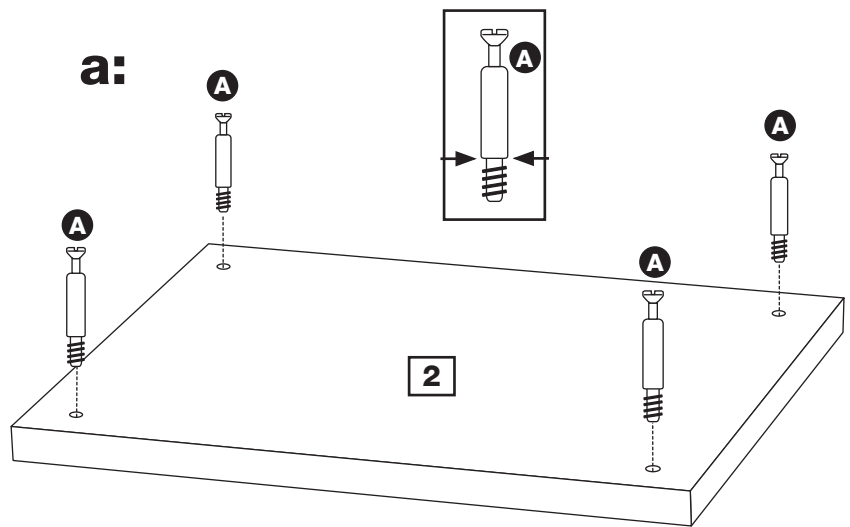

Fitting the Table Top

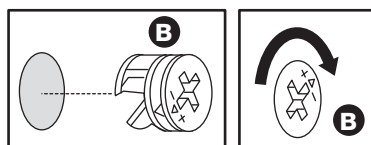
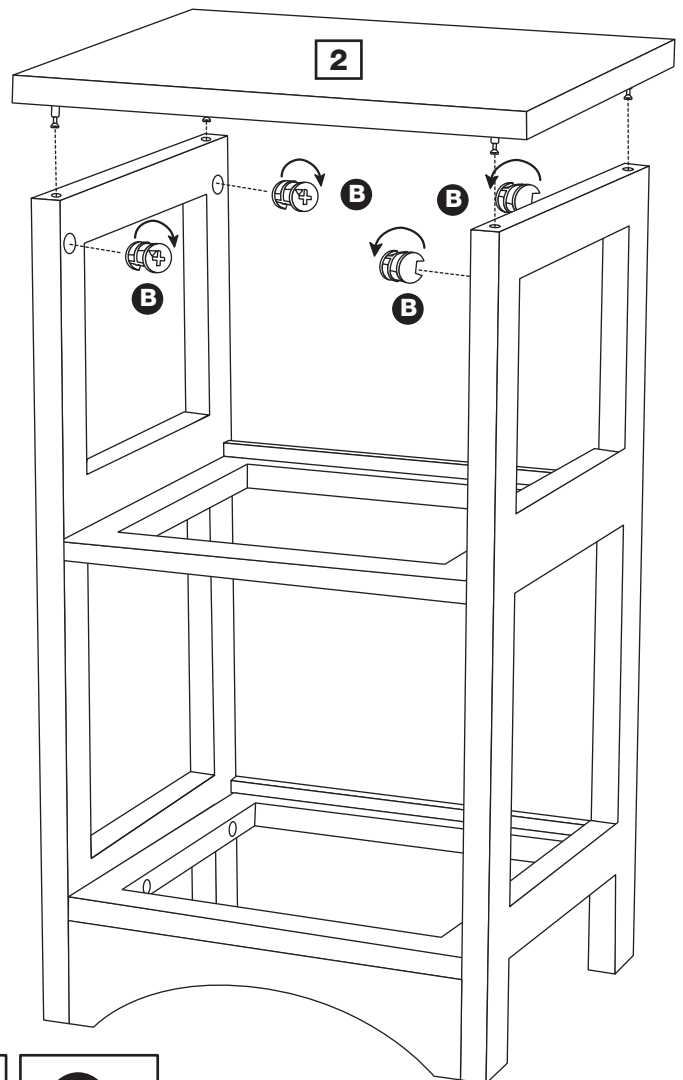
NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Screw Locking Pins **A** into Table Top **2**.



b: Carefully place the Table Top **2** onto the unit. Insert Locking Nuts **B** into the Side Panels **1**. Tighten the Locking Nuts **B** to secure the Table Top **2** to the unit.

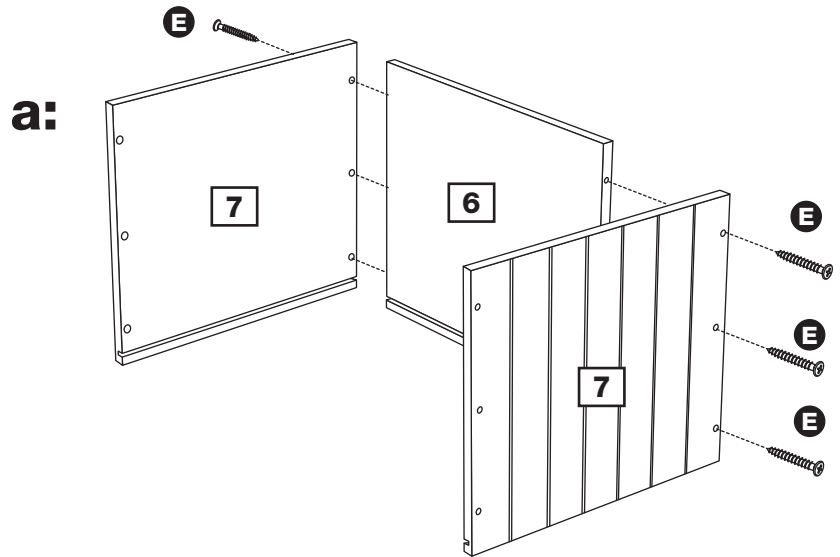

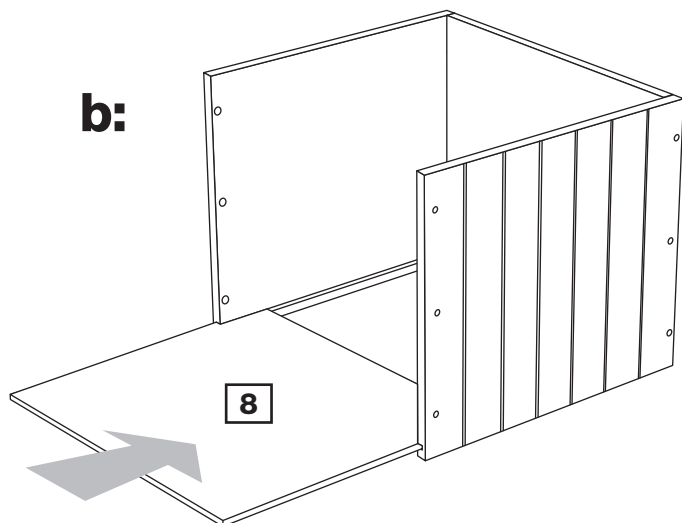
Assembling the Drawers

NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

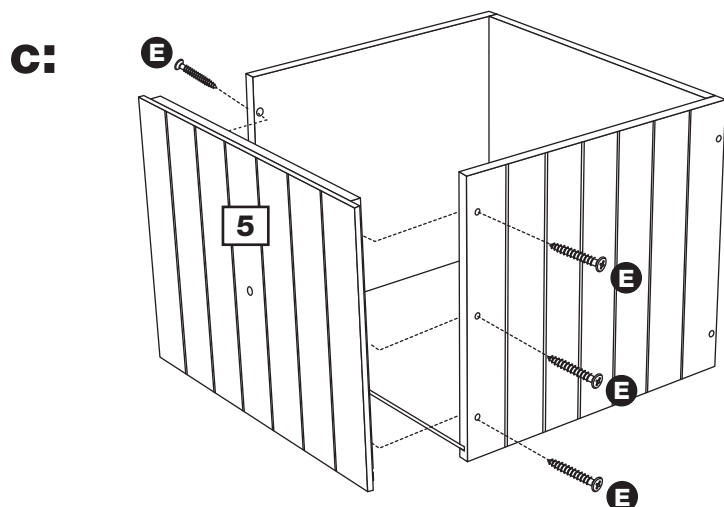
a: Use Screws **E** to fix the Drawer Sides **7** onto Drawer Back **6**.



b: Carefully slide the Drawer Bottom **8** into the unit.



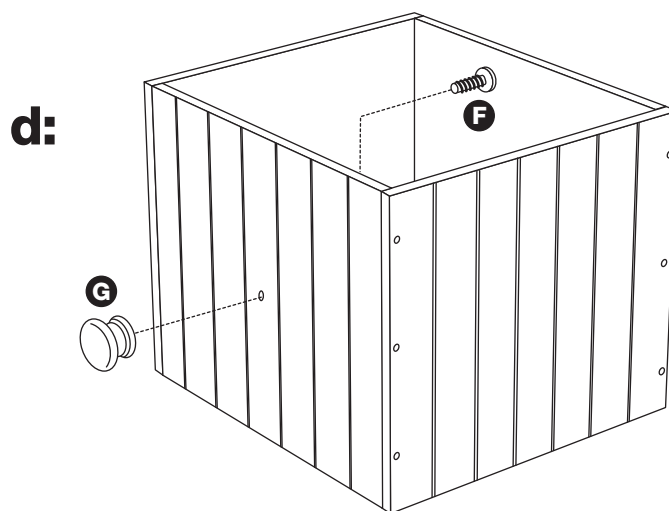
c: Use Screws **E** to fix the Drawer Front **5** onto the drawer.

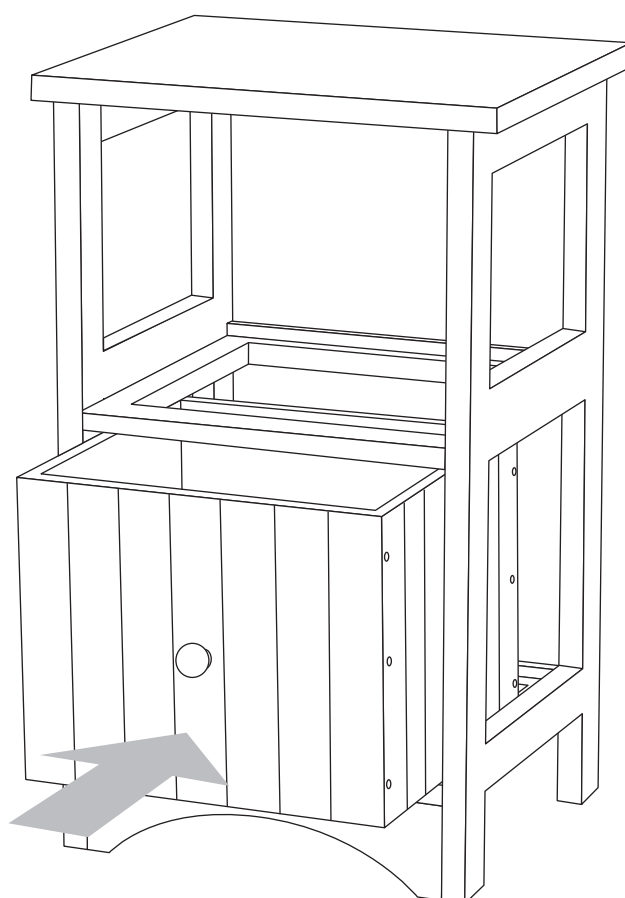
Step 3

d: Use Screw **F** to fix the Handle **G** onto the drawer.



e: Carefully slide the drawer into the unit.

Finishing the Unit

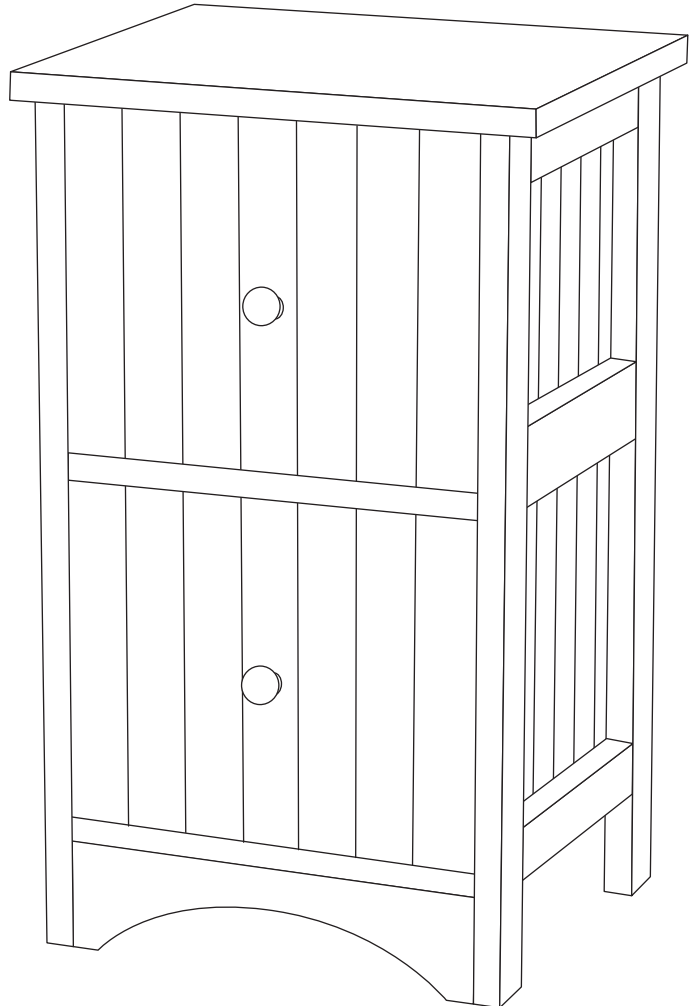
NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.
