

## Safety and Care Advice

## Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws.

as this could damage the unit.
Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- **Note:** Only apply the glue once you are sure of the assembly.

### Glue safety - Take care when using glue, please follow the advice below

**Skin contact:** Remove contamination by washing with soap and water. This procedure should also be followed prior to eating and drinking.

**Eye contact:** Rinse immediately with clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice.

**If swallowed:** Seek medical advice immediately.

#### **Care and maintenance**


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.


**2** Right side panel (178.4 x 29.9cm)




## Step 1

Fitting hinges and handles to doors

**a:** Use Screw **()** to fix the Metal plate **()** onto the Door **(8)**.

Insert the Door hinges into the Door 8.



**b:** Use Screws • to fix the Handle • onto the Door 8.

Use the same method as in **a+b** to assembly another doors.

## Step 2

Fitting dowels and door stopper



Caution: Always check the assembly method is correct before applying glue.

a: Insert Hinge plug ointo the Middle panel 5.

Place a small amount of Glue into the dowel holes. Insert Wooden dowels into the Middle panel 5.


**b:** Use Screws **F** to fix the Door stopper **G** onto the Shelf **6** .


Place a small amount of Glue into the dowel holes. Insert Wooden dowels into the Shelf


**C:** Insert Hinge plug **1** into the Top shelf **7**.

Place a small amount of Glue into the dowel holes. Insert Wooden dowels into the Top shelf.











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
## Step 3

## Fitting the bottom panel


a: Place a small amount of Glue into the dowel holes. Insert Wooden dowels into the Bottom panel 4.


Insert Hinge plug **1** into the Bottom panel **4** .

**b:** Use Screws **a** to fix the Plastic supports **o** onto the Front panel **9**.



## Step 4

### Fitting left side panel

a: Place a small amount of Glue into the dowel holes. Position Bottom panel 4 and Middle panel 5 onto Left side panel 1 using Screws
3.

Use Screws to fix the Plastic supports onto the Left side panel 1.

Use Screw covers to cover the Screw heads.


**b:** Place a small amount of Glue **()** into the dowel holes.


Position Door 8 onto the unit, locating the hinges into plug on Bottom panel 4 and Shelf 6 and corresponding hole.


c: Place a small amount of Glue into the dowel holes.

Position Door 8 onto the unit, locating the hinges into plug on Middle panel 5 and Shelf 6 and corresponding hole.




## Step 4 - continued

**d:** Place a small amount of Glue **\(\bigcup\)** into the dowel holes.

Position Top shelf 7 and Shelves 6 onto Left side panel 1 using Screws 3.

Use Screw covers to cover the Screw heads.




## Step 5

## Fitting the back panels

**Note:** It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

Place a small amount of Glue into the groove. Carefully slide the Top and Bottom back panel and and 11 onto the unit.



## Step 6

## Fitting the right side panel

Place a small amount of Glue into the dowel holes and groove. Use Screws it of fix the Right side panel into the unit.

Use Screws (a) to fix the Plactic Support (a) onto the Right side panel (a).

Use Screw covers to cover the Screw heads.

## Step 7

#### Fitting the top panel


**a:** Use Screws **F** to fix the Door stopper **G** onto the Top panel **3**.

**b:** Place a small amount of Glue **1** into the groove.


Position Door 8 onto the unit, locating the hinge into the plug on Top shelf 7 & Top panel 3 and corresponding holes.


Position Top panel 3 onto the unit using Screws 3.

Use Screw covers K to cover the screw heads.



## Step 8

### **Fixing to wall**

It is recommended that the unit is fixed to a wall.

Use Screw to fix the Wall strap Monto the top panel.

With help, move unit into position.



Warning:
The unit is heavy.
Lift with care.

Mark fixing hole on wall and remove unit.

Drill a hole and insert Wall plug N.




Warning:

Before drilling, check wall for hidden pipes and cables.


Reposition unit and fix wall strap using Screw.


**Note:** Before use allow the Glue to dry for 24 hours and make sure the unit is secure.



**Note:** Wall plugs supplied are for solid wall only.

The correct type of fixing must be used for your wall, seek professional advice if in doubt

# A Guide to - Wall Mounting & Fixings

### Important note:

If plastic wall plugs are supplied with your product:



- these are only suitable for use in masonry walls.

If you are in any doubt about the correct wall plugs for your wall, seek professional advice.

Failure of the product due to using incorrect fixings is the responsibility of the installer.



*Important:* When drilling into walls always check that there are no hidden wires or pipes etc.

Make sure that the screws and wall plugs being used are suitable for supporting your unit. Consult a qualified tradesperson if you are unsure.


#### Hints:

- 1: General rule: Always use a larger screw and wall plug if you are not sure.
- **2:** Ensure you use the recommended drill bit to match the wall plug and hole size.
- **3:** Ensure you drill the hole horizontally, do not force the drill or enlarge the hole.
- **4:** Take extra care when drilling high walls, ceilings and ceramic tiles. Ensure wall plugs are inserted beyond the thickness of the ceramic tiles to avoid the tiles splitting or cracking.
- **5:** Ensure wall plugs are well fitted and are a tight fit in the drilled hole.

### Types of walls


You can use one of the following types of wall plug if your walls are made of brick, breeze block, concrete, stone or wood.

#### No.1 "General Purpose" wall plug




Generally aerated blocks should not be used to support heavy loads, use a specialist fitting in this case. For light loads, general purpose wall plugs can be used.

#### No.2 "Plasterboard" wall plug




For use when attaching light loads on to plasterboard partitions.

#### No.3 "Cavity Fixing" wall plug




For use with plasterboard partitions or hollow wooden doors.

## No.4 "Cavity Fixing-Heavy Duty" wall plug




For use when fitting or supporting heavy loads such as shelving, wall cabinets and coat racks.

#### No.5 "Hammer Fixing" wall plug



For use with walls stuck with plasterboard. The hammer fixing allows it to be fixed to the wall rather than the plasterboard. Always check the fixing is secure to the retaining wall.

#### No.6 "Shield Anchor" wall plug Heavy loads



For use with heavier loads such as TV & HiFi speakers and satelite dishes etc.



**Safety:** Always check the fitting and location to ensure your safety in and around the home.

**Fitting:** From time to time check the fitting to ensure the wall plugs or screws do not become loose.
