

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

• Check you have all the components and tools listed on page 2.

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts are a chokong hazard.

• Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

• Assemble on a pad to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- If using power tools, please follow the safety instructions supplied with the tools.

• Assemble the unit as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers *for inserting screws*,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

• Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners. • From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.







Step 3

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.


a: Insert Locks B into the top of Lower side support 3.
Insert Upper side support 4 into the Locks B.
Don't tighten the Locks
B until the next step of height setting.


b: Set the height of the unit.

Ensuring the Locks (3) are loosened, slide the Upper side support (4) to the desired height and tighten the Locks (5) to affix in position as shown in fig.1.

Adjustment Range: 99.5-167cm.

Note: Please hold Upper side support 4 and pull downward. It will be fixed if locked or will glide downward if unlocked.
