Care and Maintenance

General

This pushchair was designed and manufactured with quality materials and craftsmanship. Always use the safety harness.

Inspect regularly for:

- Worn parts, torn materials or stitching.
- Loose screws, bent or broken frame parts.
- Broken, damaged or missing parts.

Lubricate moving parts regularly, especially the wheels, and lower parts of the chassis that tend to collect dirt.

Care and Maintenance:

Fabric parts may be cleaned in accordance with the fabric care labels. Do not machine wash. Seat: Sponge clean only. Canopy/Basket:Hand wash only.

Do not leave the stroller exposed to heat i.e. by a radiator orin direct sunlight.


If the stroller chassis parts have been exposed to salt water we recommend that they be rinsed down with soapy water as soon as possible, afterwards clean with a sponge. Do not fold or store the product while wet and never store a damp environment as this can cause mildew to form.


Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Assemble the front wheels

1 Press down the lock pin on the front tube.

2 Then insert the front tube into the adaptor of front wheel, until the lock pin position in the plastic hole.



Step 2

- 1 Locate the locking catch on the right side of the stroller and release it.
- 2 Repeat on both sides and open out the stroller by lifting the handles upwards.
- 3 Using foot, push the rear locking catch down fully to engage the primary lock.
- 4 Place the stroller on a flat surface and ensure that the stroller moves freely.


Step 3

To operate brakes

- 1 Your stroller has a parking brake. To engage brakes simply press down on the link brake located on the rear wheels with foot.
- 2 To release brakes simply lift the link brake located on rear wheels.







Step 4

To operate harness


- 1 Release: Press the two sides buttons to release the harness system. (See pic A)
- 2 Fastening: Insert the buckles into the socket until a " click". (See pic B)
- 3 Length of harness belt can be adjusted in accordance with the height of the baby. (See pic C)




Step 5

To fold the stroller

- 1 See pic A, locate the rear locking catch(1), pull out and lift upwards with fingers to release the primary lock. Then locate the second lock(2) and lift upwards gently by hands until the lock has released.
- 2 Grip handles and push forward on stroller(See pic B). Compress folded stroller and ensure the locking catch (located the right side of the stroller) has engaged.





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
