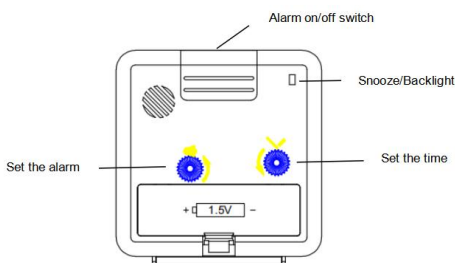

WARNINGS

- Keep out of reach of children.
- Batteries should only be installed by an adult.

Installation

1. Place your clock face down on a flat surface.
2. Remove the battery cover at the back of the clock.
3. Insert 1 x AA batteries into the battery compartment by observing the correct "+" and "-" polarity.
4. Replace the battery cover.



Setting the time

- To set the time, rotate the knob which has the clock hands symbol above until the hands of the clock reach the correct time.

Alarm function

- To set the alarm, rotate the alarm set knob (the knob with the bell symbol above it) until the desired alarm time is reached.
- Slide out the alarm switch (on top of the clock) to turn alarm on.

- When the time on the clock is the same as the alarm time that has been set, the alarm will sound.
- To use the snooze function, press the snooze button (light/snooze button is on the back of the clock) and the alarm will silence and then sound again after approximately four minutes.
- To turn off the alarm, push down the alarm switch.

Light function

To use the light, press the light/snooze button on the back of the clock.

Care instructions

- Wipe the clock with a soft dry cloth only.
- Replace the battery every 12 months or when the clock stops.
- Choose a suitable location for the clock away from areas where it will get wet or knocked. Do not position the clock in locations where there are strong magnetic fields (e.g. by loudspeakers) or use in extreme temperature conditions (above 40°C or below -5°C). These may cause damage to the clock or erratic timekeeping.

Battery safety & disposal

- Dispose of any used batteries responsibly by taking it to your local authority household waste recycling facility.
- Don't dispose of batteries in a fire as they may explode.
- This clock will only take 'AA' 1.5V batteries in this clock.
- Make sure you've inserted the batteries correctly, so you have the correct polarity (+ and -). You should only use batteries that are the equivalent of those recommended above. Don't use rechargeable batteries with this item. And never mix old and new batteries, change them at the same time.

We expect this clock to give you many years of use, but when you've finished with it, please don't just throw it in the bin. Do your bit for the environment by recycling electrical items.
