SETUP & USE:

WARNING: STRANGULATION HAZARD - Children have STRANGLED in cords. Keep this cord out of reach of children (more than 3 feet (0.9 m) away from the crib). Never use extension cords with AC Adapters. Only use the AC Adapters provided.

Initial Setup:

To set up the system, you will need two adults. One adult should be in the nursery with the Baby Unit (transmitter) while the other is in a different room with the Parent Unit (receiver).

Note: The Parent Unit includes a rechargeable battery and it should be charged for 4-5 hours before using the monitor in portable mode. Only charge the battery when the battery is low to achieve optimal battery life.

Step 1: Place the Baby Unit in the nursery near the crib, on a flat surface, and ensure the cord is more than 3-feet from the crib and out of baby's reach. Plug the AC adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

Step 2: Press the power button on the front of Baby Unit for 4-seconds to turn the unit on.

Step 3: Place the Parent Unit in the room from which you want to monitor baby. Plug the AC adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

Step 4: Press the power button on the front of the Parent Unit for 4-seconds to turn it on.

Step 5: Have the adult in the baby's room speak at different levels to adjust the volume to the desired setting. The volume can be adjusted up or down using the Volume Control buttons on the side of the Parent Unit.

Baby Unit Setup in Nursery:

Place the Baby Unit (transmitter) on a flat surface, such as a bureau or shelf (Fig A). NEVER place the Baby Unit or cords within 3-feet of the crib.

SETUP & USE (continued):

Pairing Baby Unit and Parent Unit:

The monitor is paired at the factory for privacy reasons. There are instances when the Baby Unit and Parent Unit may require pairing:

Step 1: Connect the Baby Unit to its power supply and make sure unit is powered OFF.

Step 2: Turn ON the Parent Unit.

Step 3: Press and hold the "VOL +" button and at the same time press the POWER button and hold for about 4 seconds. A continuous audible BEEP and red flashing lights will occur. The Parent Unit is now ready to be paired. **Step 4:** Within 20 seconds, turn on the Baby Unit. A single BEEP will emit from the Parent Unit to signify successful syncing.

If this is unsuccessful, you should repeat steps 1-4.

SPECIAL FEATURES:

• **Sound Lights:** The monitor lets you not only hear your baby but with sound activated lights, parents can "see" the sound level coming from baby's room. Displayed on a color bar, the color changes as the sound level changes; moving from green to amber to red as the sound level increases. These lights can be especially helpful for parents when they are in a noisy or crowded room.

• **Sensitive Microphone:** The high sensitivity microphone allows parents to hear low level sounds coming from the baby's room as well as louder sounds and crying, giving them peace of mind knowing they will be able to hear baby day and night. The microphone focuses on baby's sounds while filtering background, ambient sounds enabling a clear connection the parent unit.

• **Out of Range Indicator:** If the Parent Unit is too far away from the Baby Unit, it will be "out of range" and the monitor will emit 5 consecutive beeps. The beeps will continue until the Parent Unit is moved back within range of the Baby Unit.

• **Low Battery Indicator:** If the Parent Unit is low on battery power, the unit will emit a beeping sound. The low battery indicator beep will continue until the unit is plugged in.

• **Belt Clip:** Added convenience and portability is provided with a built-in belt clip on the Parent Unit. This feature allows parents a convenient way to keep the unit with them as they move throughout the house during the day.

PROBLEM SOLVING:

No sound coming from the parent unit

- Make sure both the Baby Unit and Parent Unit are plugged in and powered on.
- Make sure electrical outlets are working.
- Set volume to a higher setting.

Squealing Noise

- Move the Parent Unit and Baby Unit farther apart, the squealing sound indicates the units are too close together
- Turn down the volume on Parent Unit.

Weak reception or no reception

- Make sure both Parent Unit and Baby Unit are turned on.
- Move the Parent Unit closer to the Baby Unit.
- Make sure the battery in the Parent Unit is fully charged.
