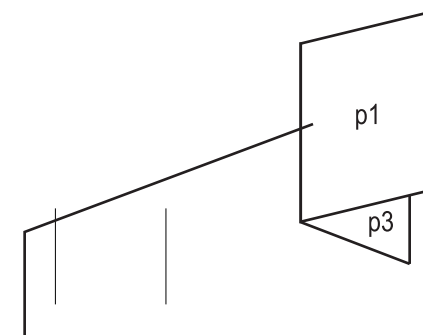

General

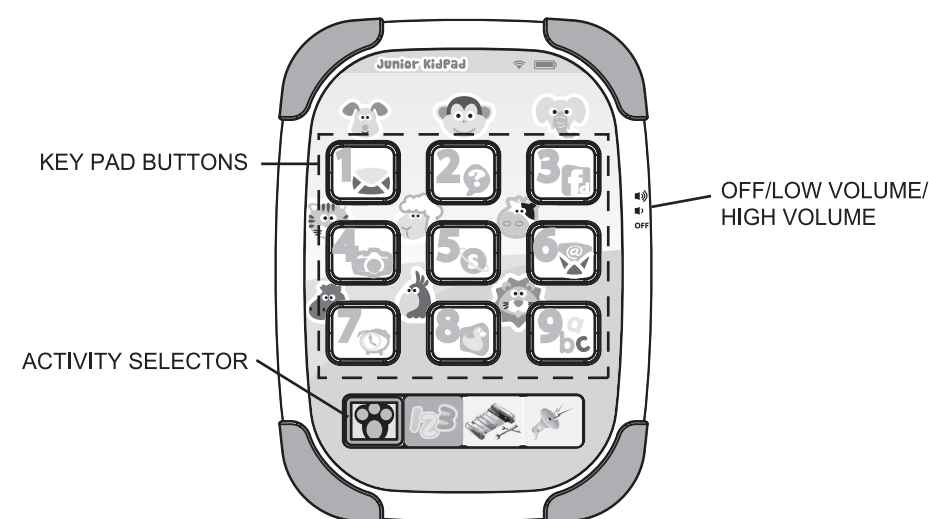
SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed. Only batteries of the same or equivalent types as recommended are to be used. Batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited. Do not dispose the battery in fire, battery may leak or explode. Battery should be replaced by adult.

BATTERY INSTALLATION & REPLACEMENT

Loose the screw by screw driver to open the battery compartment door at the back of the product. Insert/replace the new battery in the proper direction indicated inside the battery compartment. Close and screw the battery door.

Operation

Slide this switch located on the right side to LOW VOLUME position or HIGH VOLUME position; this will also turn the unit ON. Slide the switch down completely to the OFF position to turn the unit OFF.

Activity selector

Mode 1 - Learning Animals



Slide the **ACTIVITY SELECTOR** to the first position to activate the Learning Animals activity. Press any one of the **KEY PAD BUTTONS** to listen and learn each Animal name and the cry of this Animal.

Mode 2 - Learning Numbers



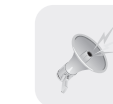
Slide the **ACTIVITY SELECTOR** to the second position to activate the Learning Numbers activity. Press any one of the **KEY PAD BUTTONS** to listen and learn each Number with its counting light sequence for the Number.

Mode 3 - Learning Notes



Slide the **ACTIVITY SELECTOR** to the third position to activate the Learning Notes activity. Press any one of the **KEY PAD BUTTONS** to listen a single note. Continue to press any of the **KEY PAD BUTTONS** to play individual musical notes or wait a bit after you press any of the key pad buttons for a melody to begin playing. You can listen and sing along to the musical melody. Each key pad button plays a different individual note as well as a musical melody.

Mode 4 - Learning Sound Effects

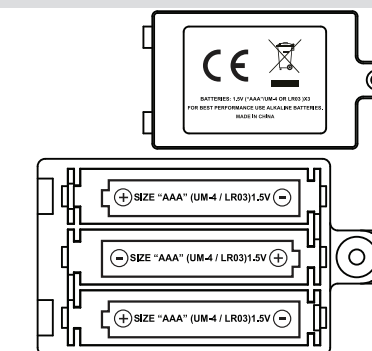


Slide the **ACTIVITY SELECTOR** to the fourth position to activate the Learning Sound Effects activity. Press any one of the **KEY PAD BUTTONS** to listen and be entertained by each different sound effect.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Installation of New Batteries

1. Make sure the device is switched OFF.
2. Open and remove the battery compartment door by removing the screw with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) and gently lift up.
3. Insert only three (3) "AAA" size batteries using the correct polarity (+ and -) as marked inside the battery compartment.
4. Replace the battery compartment door and gently tighten the screw. Do not over-tighten.
5. Close the battery compartment cover.
