

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed opposite.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- · Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.


• Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.





Using Camlocks


Step 1

Connect the male camlock as directed in the assembly instructions using a screwdriver.



Step 3


Push the male camlock into the entry hole.



Step 2

Insert the female camlock as shown in the instructions.

Note: ensure that the arrow on the top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock.




Step 4

Turn the female camlock clockwise with a screwdriver.


You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place.

The joint is now secure.



Step 1

Fix 4 x Male camlock **D**into underside of top 3 as shown using a Phillips screwdriver.



Step 2


Fix 2 x Female camlock into left side panel 1 and right side panel 2 as shown.

Note:

ensure that the arrow on top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock. Please refere to the "Using Camlocks" section for further assistance.

Step 3

Connect bottom shelf 4 and back rail 6 to back upright 7 using 4 x wooden dowel B as shown.



Step 4

Slide 1 x back panel 8 into the left end slots of bottom shelf 4 and back rail 6 as shown.

Step 5

Connect assembly completed at Step 4 to left side 1 using 3 x wooden dowel B and 3 x 60mm hex bolt


A as shown. Use Hex Key provided to do this

Connect front rail 5 to left side 1 using 1 x wooden dowel B and 1 x 60mm hex bolt A as shown. Use Hex Key

provided to do this

Step 6

Slide 1 x back panel 8 into the right end slots of bottom shelf 4 and back rail 6 as shown.



Step 7

Connect right side 2
to exposed ends of
assembly and front rail
5 using 4 x wooden
dowel B and 4 x 60mm
hex bolt A as shown
using Hex Key supplied

Step 8

Connect drawer stopper

to front rail using
1 x 10mm screw as
shown (a:).


Note: the loose end of the drawer stopper must point upwards and towards the back of the unit.

Connect top 3 to assembly using 4 x wooden dowel B as shown.

Push the male Camlock into the the adjacent entry hole


Turn the femal camlock clockwise with a screw driver. You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place

The joint is now secure



Step 9


Insert the drawer 9 as shown.



Step 10

Connect left door 11 using 4 x 12mm screws **©**


Repeat for right door 12. as shown.



Step 11

Insert 4 x wooden dowel

into holes inside unit
and set middle shelf
on them as shown.




Step 12




Warning: The unit is heavy. Ask someone to help you with this step.

Insert 2 x castor with brake and 2 x castor into bottom of legs as shown.



Step 13


Slide 2 x basket 15 into runners underneath bottom shelf as shown.



Step 14

Hang knife block 13 and storage box 14 onto hooks as shown

Assembly complete.
