

# Safety and Care Advice

**Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly**

- **Warning:** This unit weighs approximately 41.5kgs. Please lift with care.

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.

- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers **for inserting screws**, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- **Safety note:** If there is any chance of this unit being pulled over by children etc. it is recommended that the unit is secured to a wall using suitable fixings (not supplied).

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

## Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.






Eye protection (when using a hammer or drill)


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## Step 1

### Prepare the drawer fronts

Screw 2 metal dowels **B** into the holes shown on the back of each drawer front **5**.

**Note:** Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.




## Step 2

### Prepare the drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut **C** into the hole shown on the left drawer side **8** and right drawer side **9**.

**Note:** The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.




## Step 3

### Attach the drawer sides to the drawer front

Push the left drawer side **8** and right drawer side **9** onto the back of the drawer front **5**.

Turn the small locking nuts **C** on the left drawer side **8** and right drawer side **9**.

**Note:** Turn the locking nuts **C** clockwise to secure panels - more than 1/2 a turn.




**Note:** The locking nuts can be on either surface of the drawer sides. Make sure that the groove is on the inside, as shown.

## Step 4

### Fit the drawer base

Slide the drawer base **7** down the grooves in the drawer sides **8** and **9** and down into the groove in the drawer front **5**.




## Step 5

### Fit the drawer back

Fit the drawer back **10** between the drawer sides **8** and **9**.

Make sure that the drawer base **7** fits into the groove in the drawer back **10**.


Hold the drawer back **10** in position and tap the knock-in pegs **E** through the holes in the drawer sides **8** and **9**.



## Step 6

### Attach the handles


Attach a handle **J** to each drawer front **5** using 2 screws **G**.



## Step 7

### Fit the wedgifixes

Turn the drawer assemblies over and slide 4 wedgifixes **L** into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.


## Step 8

### Fit runners to the drawers

Fit runner **Kd**, marked with 'R', to the bottom edge of the right drawer side **9**, as shown, making sure that it is pushed up against the back of the drawer front **5**.

Use a bradawl to mark the fixing positions, then secure with 2 screws **I**.

Fit runner **Kc**, marked 'L', to the bottom edge of the left drawer side **8** using the same method.



## Step 9


### Prepare the 2 rails

Tap 2 wooden dowels **A** into each rail **6**.

**Note:** Wooden dowels **must not** stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **D** into each rail **6**.

**Note:** The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

## Step 10

### Prepare the left side

**a:** Fit 4 runners **K a** to the left side **1**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 2nd hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws **H** use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

**b:** Fit a screw **I** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runners **K a**.






Screw 2 metal dowels **B** into the left side **1**.

Insert a large locking nut **D** into the left side **1**.

**Note:** The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the left side **1**.

**Note:** Wooden dowels **must not** stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.

## Step 11

### Prepare the right side

**a:** Fit 4 runners **K b** to the right side **2**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 2nd hole in from the front of the runner.





The 2nd and 3rd screws **H** use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

**b:** Fit a screw **I** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner **K b**.

Screw 2 metal dowels **B** into the right side **2**.

Insert a large locking nut **D** into the right side **2**.

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the right side **2**.

## Step 12


### Join the right side and rails

**2 people are needed here**

Push the 2 rails **6** onto the right side **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the rails **6**.

**Note:** Turn the large locking nuts **D** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.




**Note:** Support this rail until the left side has been fitted in the next step.

## Step 13

### Fit the left side

Push the left side **1** onto the 2 rails **6**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the rails **6**.

## Step 14

### Prepare the first surface of the upright

**Note:** The colour of the upright may differ from the main unit colour.

**a:** Fit 4 runners **K b** to the upright **3**.





The 1st screw **H** uses the 2nd hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws **H** use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

**b:** Fit a screw **I** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner **K b**.

Tap a wooden dowel **A** into the upright **3**.

**Turn the upright over for the next step**



**Turn the divider over**

### Prepare the other surface of the upright





**a:** Fit 4 runners **K a** to the upright **3**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 2nd hole from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws **H** use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

**b:** Fit a screw **I** into the 2nd hole in at the top of the runner **K a**.

Insert 2 large locking nuts **D** into the upright **3**.



## Step 16

### Prepare the top

Screw 4 metal dowels **B** into the top **4**.




## Step 17

### Join the upright and top

Push the upright **3** onto the top **4**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the upright **3**.


## Step 18

### Fit the top

*2 people are needed here*

Push the top **4** onto the 2 sides **1** and **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **D** fitted to the sides **1** and **2**.



## Step 19

### Fit the back

**a:** Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x to x** equals **y to y**.

**b:** Place the back **11** onto the unit.

Nail **F** around the outside edges of the back **11**.


**Note:** Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

**Using 2 people, carefully stand the unit up for the next step.**



**Warning:** The unit is heavy. Lift with care.

**a:** The measurement from top corner X to bottom corner X must be equal to the measurement from top corner Y to bottom corner Y





## Step 20

### Fit the 4 plastic nails

Tap 2 plastic nails **M** into the bottom edge of each of the sides **1** and **2**.

Tap 1 plastic nail **M** into the bottom edge of the rail **6** in the centre.

## Step 21

### Fit the drawers



Slide the wheels of the runners fitted to the drawers, over the wheels of the runners fitted to the side panels and push the drawers into position.

**Note:** We recommend that you fit the drawers in the sequence shown on the diagram.
