

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put excessive weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- Place the product on flat and steady surface during use.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Keep these instructions for further use.
- To ensure an easier assembly, we strongly advise that all fittings are only finger tightened during initial assembly. Only upon completion of the assembly should all fixing points be fully tightened.


Care and maintenance

- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.






Phillips screwdriver

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Preparing side panels




Place side panels **2** down onto a clean flat surface with the holes facing up.

Screw metal dowels **A** into the panels as shown.

Note: Insert metal dowels as far as shown. Do not over tighten.

Apply a small amount of glue into the wood dowel holes as shown.

Fit wood dowels **B** into the holes.




Step 2

Preparing top

Place top **1** upside down onto a clean flat surface.

Assemble stretcher **3** to top **1** using long screws **D**.

Step 3


Assembling frame

Apply glue onto the wood dowels in side panels **2**.

Locate side panels **2** onto the ends of top **1**.

Insert locking nuts **C** into the holes in top **1**.

Using a screwdriver, turn locking nuts clockwise to secure.




Step 4

Attaching brackets

Secure stretcher **3** to side panels **2** using short screws **E**.

Insert shelf brackets **F** into the holes in side panels **2**.

Note: Ensure the screws in shelf brackets **F** are facing up at this stage.

Step 5

Locating glass shelves




With help,

over tighten!





Fitting stickers


a: Stickers **G** can be used to cover the fixing holes.
