- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.




- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.





The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Attach the legs

Upside down the seat 1 on a protected table.
Attach the shorter end of bolt B with flat washer C

into the center hole of seat 1.


Slide the nut plastics **E**onto legs **2**&**3** as shown in the figure.

Attached legs 2&3 to the seat 1 using bolts A with spring washers D, and then tighten with allen key F

Step 2

Fix the centre bolt

Fix the bolt **B** with a flat washer **C** and a spring washer **D** and a nut **G** to the seat, tighten with a spanner **H**.
