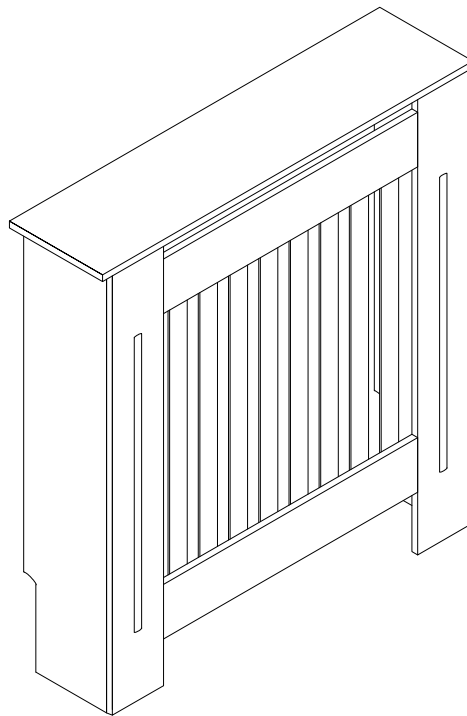


LONGSLOW RADIATOR COVER ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

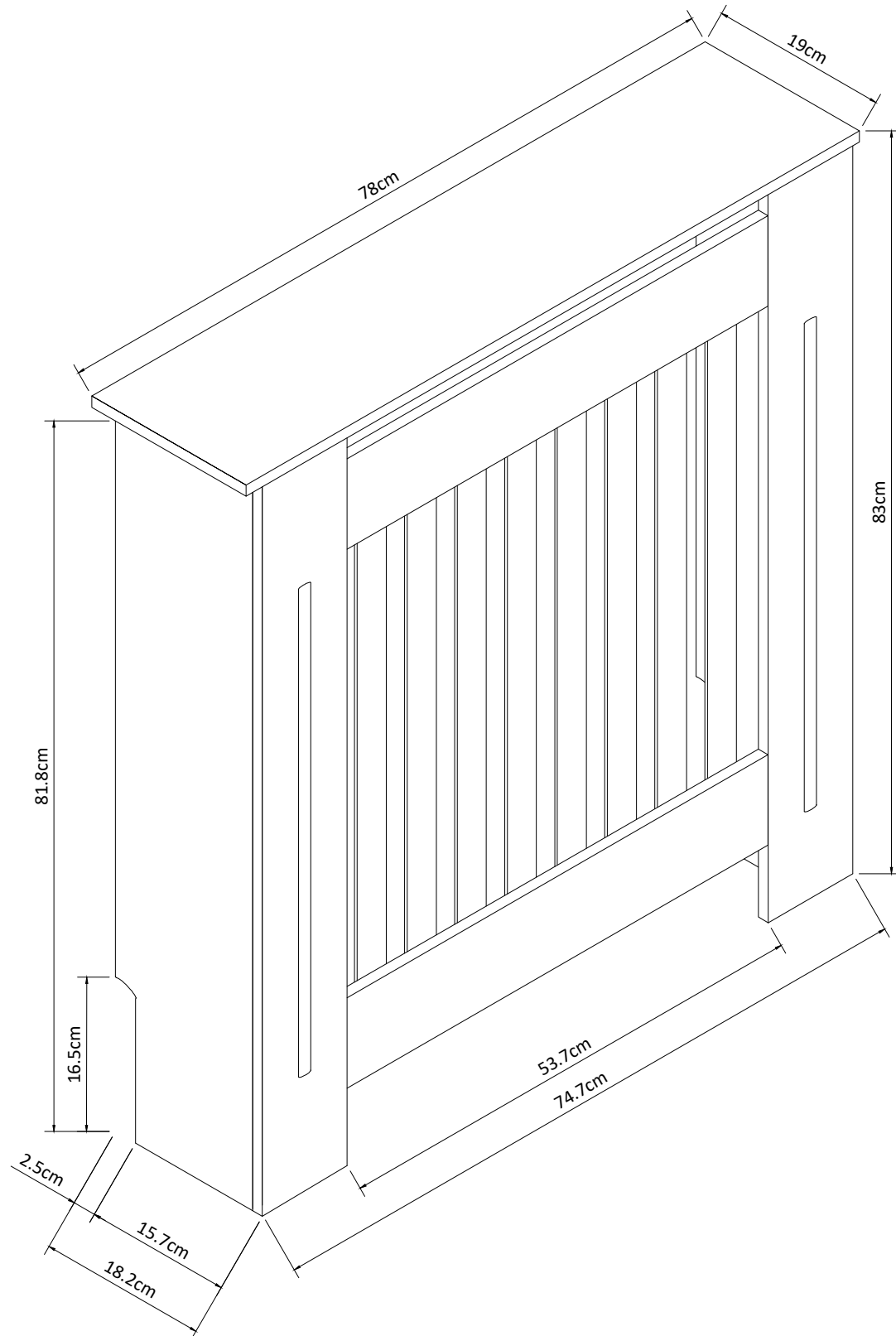
CAUTION : There are small components used in the construction of this unit. These loose items should be kept away from young children whilst assembling your unit to avoid the danger of choking hazards.

INFORMATION

This product is designed for to hold a combined weight of 5KG across the top. Do not exceed this weight.

Due to the size of this product we recommend that it is assembled in the room intended for use.

When you are ready to start, make sure that you have the right tools, plenty of space and a clean, dry area for assembly.

Unwrap all packaging materials and place the components on top of the carton box or on a clean floor to prevent it from scratching.

Check the pack and make sure you have all the parts listed .

Ensure that this product is fully assembled as illustrated before use.

Check all screws or bolts are tightened and inspect regularly.

This product should only be used on firm, level ground.

Keep small parts out of reach of children.

Make sure the legs remain in contact with the ground.

WARNINGS

DO NOT use power tools to construct this product.

DO NOT over tighten screws or bolts.

DO NOT use this product if parts are missing, damaged or worn.

DO NOT stand on the product.

DO NOT place very hot or very cold items on the surface unless adequately thick table mats are use to prevet such items damaging your table top.

We recommend the use of the wall brackets provided for safety reasons.

The wall plugs provided are for a solid wall only. Suitable fixings for your wall type must be obtained separately.

If in doubt please consult a qualified trade person.

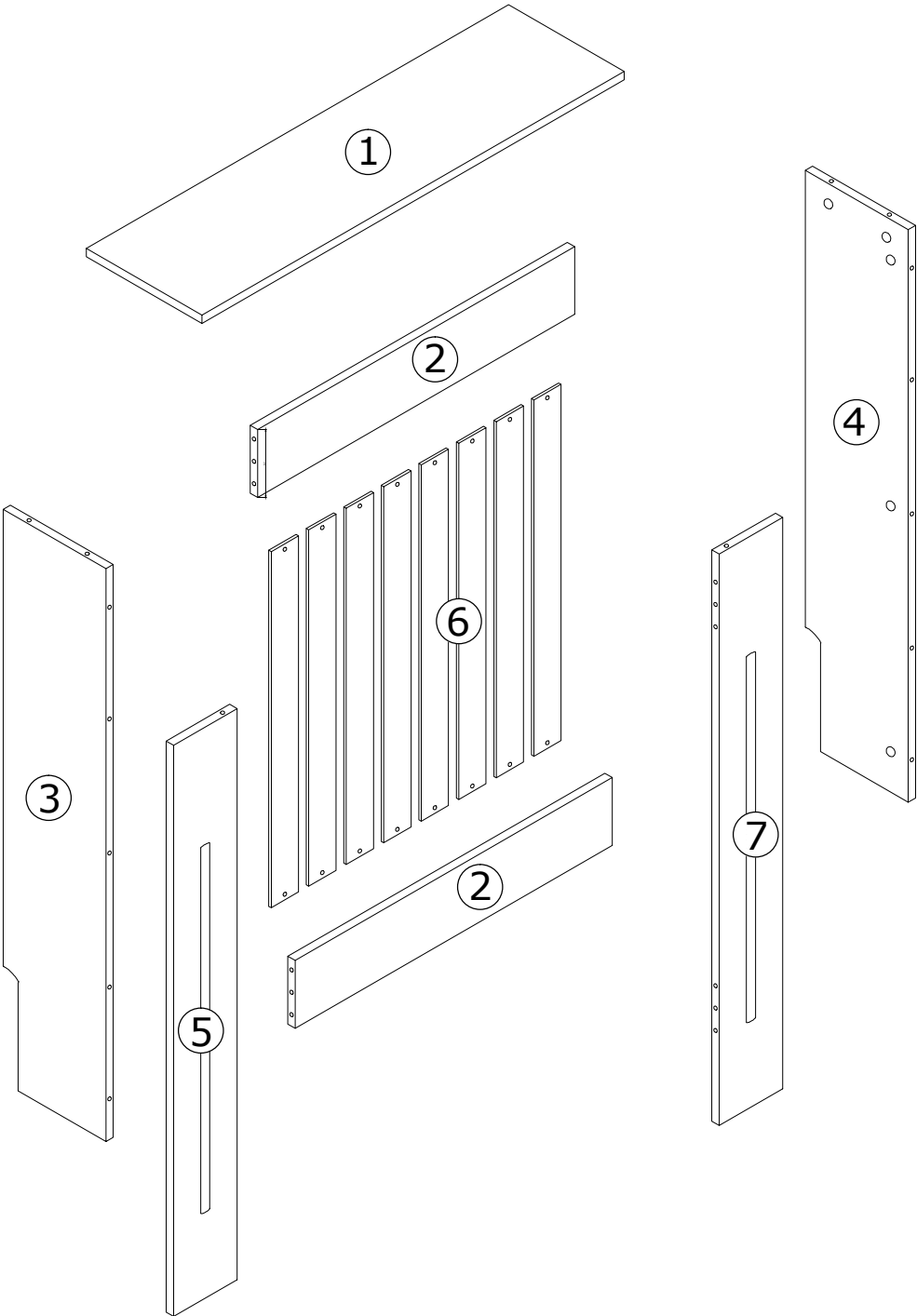
Always ensure the area to be drilled is free from hidden electrical wires, water and gas pipes.

Never use scourers, abrasives or chemical cleaners.

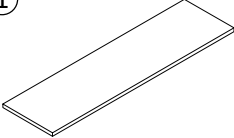
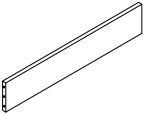
To clean wipe with a sponge and warm soapy water. Do not use solvent based cleaners or detergents as they can bleach or damage the product.

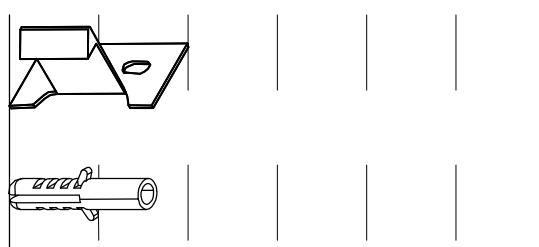

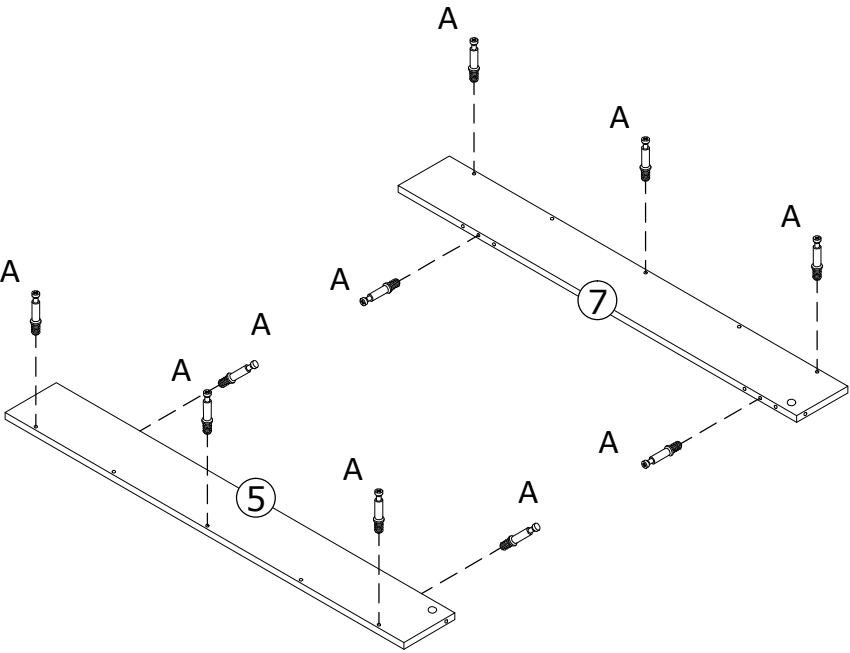
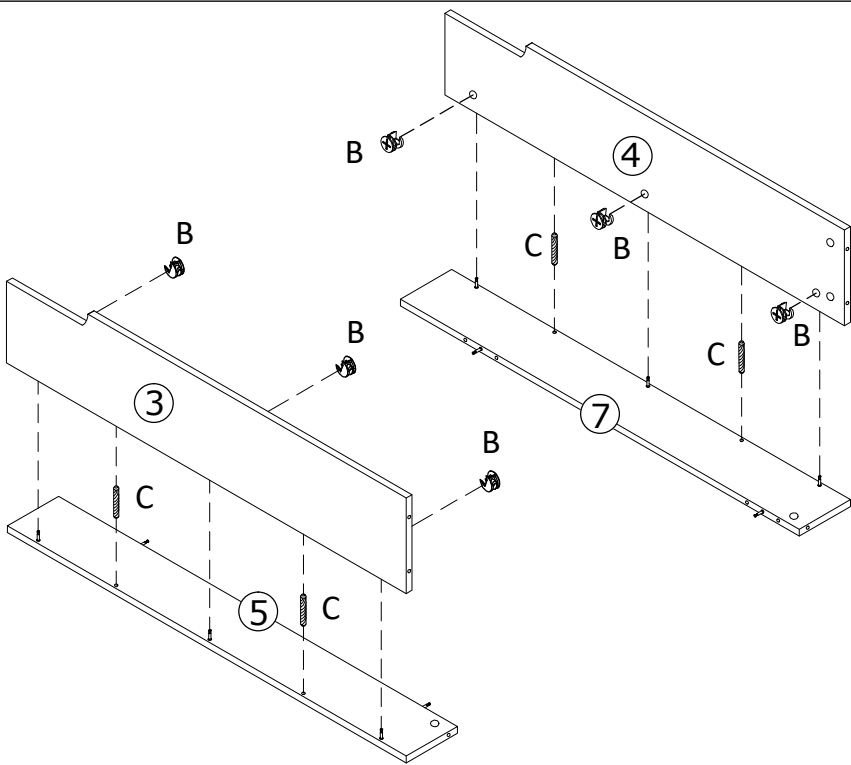
Layout Parts on Soft Surface

Lay out all parts on a soft surface i.e. Rug, Carpet or Packaging Carton

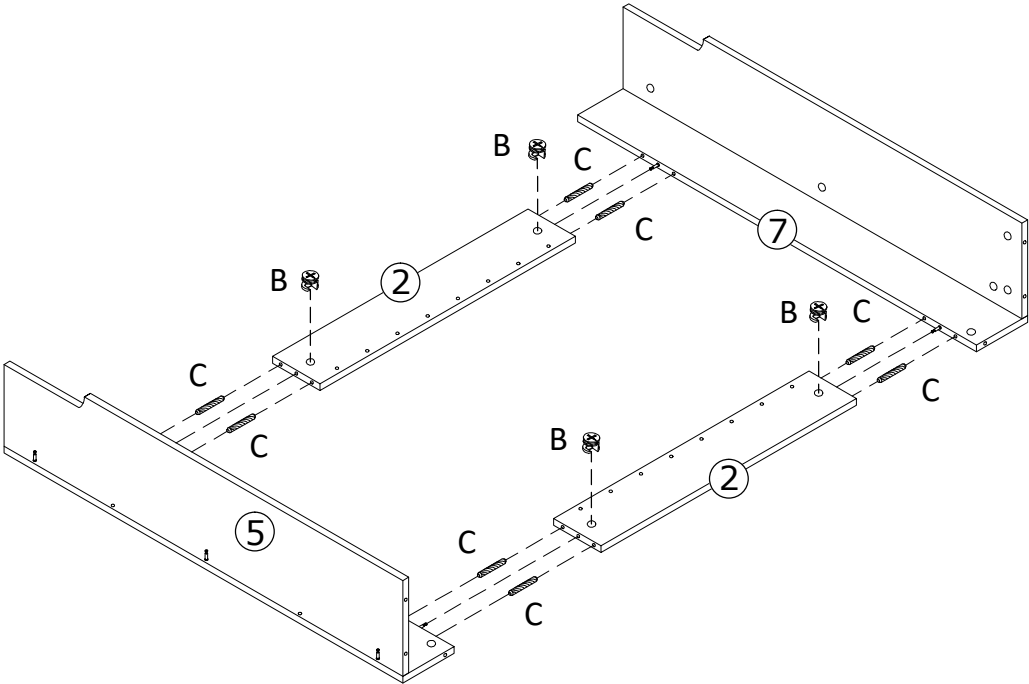
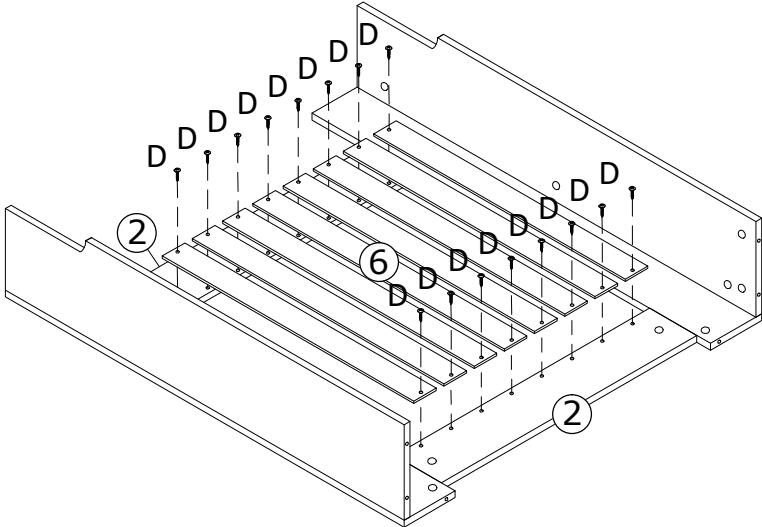

STEP 2	Parts Required
	③ Left side panel ×1 ④ Right side panel×1 ⑤ LH Vertical Panel ×1 ⑦ RH Vertical Panel ×1 B Cam (15x10mm) ×6 C Wood dowel (6x30mm) ×4

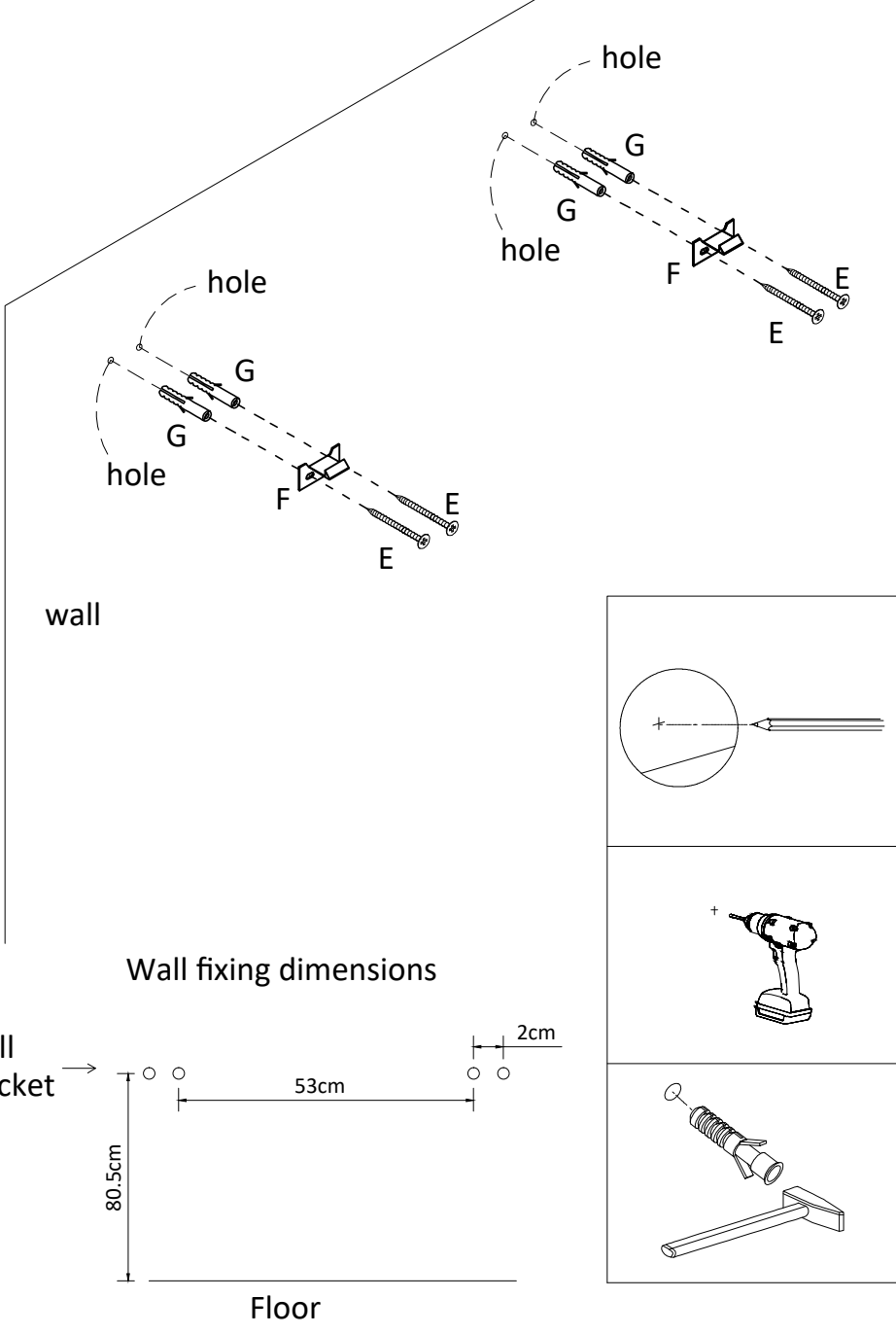

STEP 4	Parts Required
	② Support rail ×2 ⑥ Front slat ×8 D Screw (4x16 mm) ×16

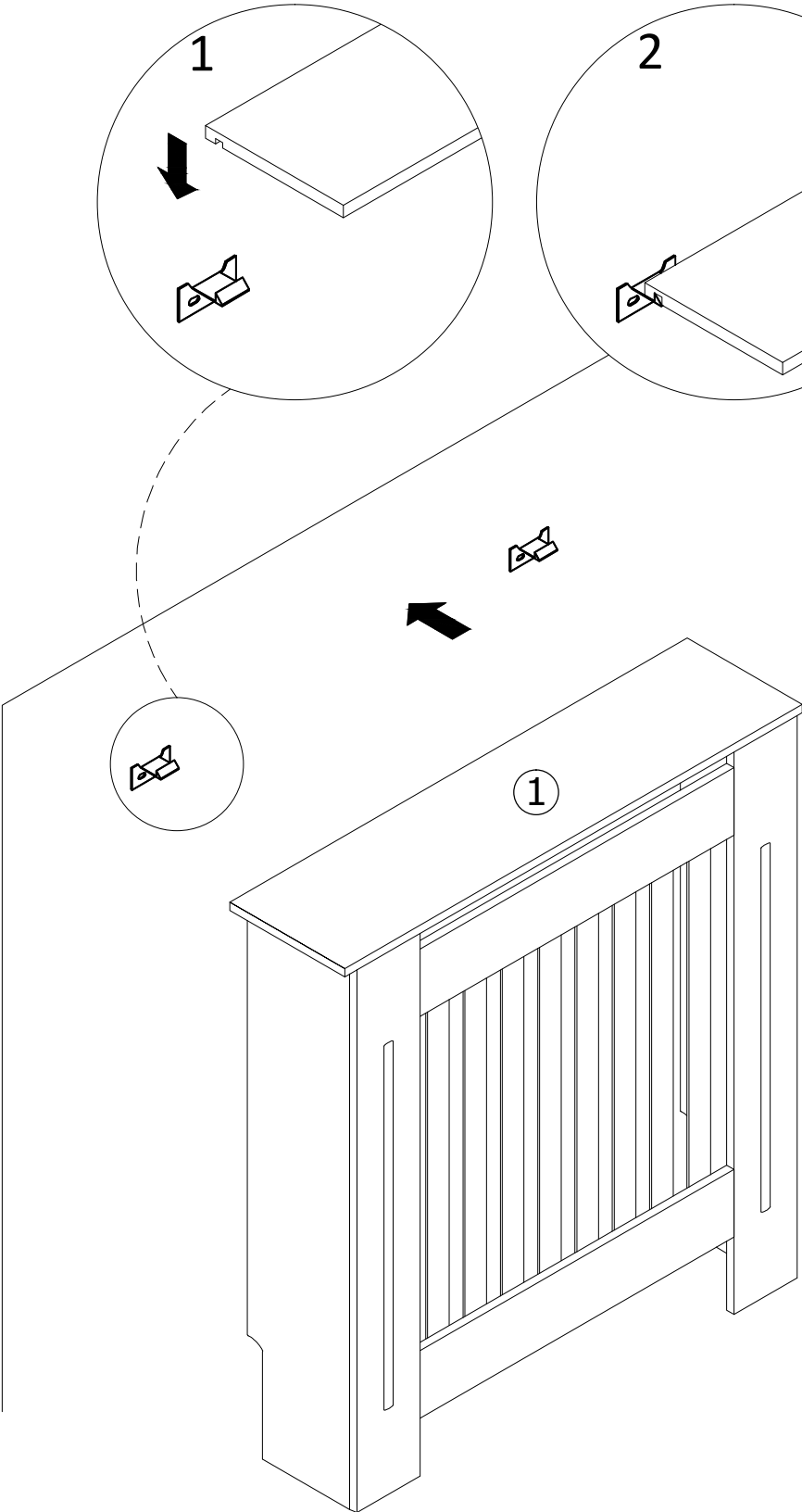

STEP 5	Parts Required
	① Cover Top Shelf ×1 A Cam bolt (6x35mm) ×6
STEP 6	Parts Required
	① Cover Top Shelf ×1 ③ Left side panel ×1 ④ Right side panel×1 ⑤ LH Vertical Panel ×1 ⑦ RH Vertical Panel ×1 B Cam (15x10mm) ×6

LONGSLOW RADIATOR COVER ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 7	Parts Required
Position the radiator cover against the wall that it will be fastened to and using a pencil,mark the position of the screw holes onto the wall. Drill where the holes have been marked and insert the wall plugs, ensuring the the edge is flush with the surface of the wall.  Wall fixing dimensions Wall bracket → 80.5cm 53cm 2cm Floor E Screw (4x40mm) ×4 F Wall Bracket ×2 G Wall plug ×4	

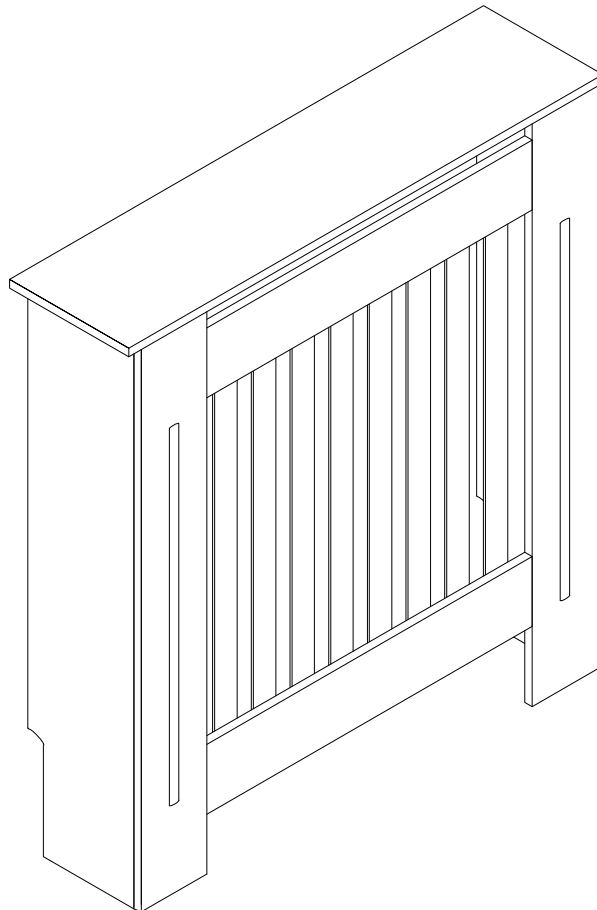

STEP 8	Parts Required

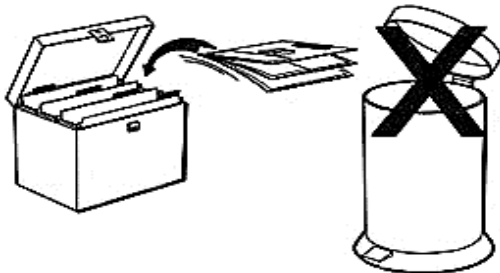
