



Components - Fittings



Step 1

Prepare the drawer sides

a: Insert a large locking cam nut **B** into the left drawer sides **11** and the right drawer sides **12**.

Note: The arrow on the locking cam nut **must** point towards the hole in the end of the panel.


b: Push 1 of the quickfit dowels **A** as far as it will go into the 6 left drawer sides **11** and the 6 right drawer sides **12**.

Note: Only the plastic thread of the quickfit dowel sticks out from the panel.

Use the Drawer Fittings Bag marked 'drw kit' for Steps 1 - 7


Step 2


Fit the drawer sides to the 3 drawer fronts

Push the left drawer sides 11 and right drawer sides 12 down onto the back of the 3 drawer fronts 9.

Turn the large locking cam nuts (3) clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.






Step 3

Fit the drawer bases

Slide a drawer base 13 down the grooves in the drawer sides 11 and 12 and down into the groove in the drawer front 9.




Step 4

Fit the drawer backs

Fit a drawer back 10 between the drawer sides 11 and 12.

Make sure that the drawer base 13 fits into the groove in the drawer back 10.


Hold the drawer back 10 in position and tap the knock-in pegs 6 through the holes in the drawer sides 11 and 12.



Step 5

Fit the handles

Attach 2 handles **()** to each drawer front **()** using screws **()**.




Step 6

Fit the drawer braces

Turn the 3 drawer assemblies over and hook a drawer brace onto the bottom edge of the drawer back 10.

Fix it to the drawer front and drawer back using 2 screws **(E)**.



Step 7


Fit runners to the drawers

Fit the DL runner Rc to the bottom edge of the left drawer side 11, as shown, making sure that it is pushed up against the back of the drawer front 9. Use a bradawl to mark the fixing positions, then secure with 2 screws F.

Fit the DR runner Rd to the bottom edge of the right drawer side 12 using the same method.

Step 8

Prepare the left side

a: Fit 3 CL runners Ra to the left side 1.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws **(H)** use the holes that line up with the other panel holes.

b: Fit a screw **(F)** into the hole at the top of the runner Ra.

Fit a rail holder K, to the left side 1 using 2 screws G.

C: Insert 2 large locking cam nuts **B** into the left side 1.

Push 2 of the quickfit dowels (A) as far as they will go into the left side 1.


Tap 3 wooden dowels M into the left side 1.


Note: Wooden dowels must not stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.

Use the Main Fittings Bag for Steps 8 - end

Step 9

Prepare the right side

a: Fit 3 CR runners **Rb** to the right side **2**.

The 1st screw **H** uses the 1st hole in from the front of the runner.

The 2nd and 3rd screws

use the holes that line
up with the other panel
holes.


b: Fit a screw **F** into the hole at the top of the runner **Rb**.

Fit a rail holder **(K)**, to the right side **(2)** using 2 screws **(3)**.

C: Insert 2 large locking cam nuts **B** into the right side **2**.

Push 2 of the quickfit dowels (A) as far as they will go into the right side [2].

Tap 3 wooden dowels **M** into the right side **2**.




Step 10

Prepare the horizontal

Insert 4 large locking cam nuts **3** into the horizontal **4**.

Push 4 of the quickfit dowels **A** as far as they will go into the horizontal **4**].

Tap 6 wooden dowels **M** into the horizontal **4**.



Step 11

Fit the horizontal to the right side

Push the horizontal 4 onto the right side 2.


Turn the 2 large locking cam nuts **B** clockwise as far as it will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.



Prepare the 2 cross rails


Tap 4 wooden dowels **M** into each of the 2 cross rails **7**.

Fit the 2 cross rails to the right side

Push the 2 cross rails 7 onto the right side 2 as shown.






Prepare the 2 plinths and the back rail

Insert 2 large locking cam nuts into the each of the 2 plinths and the back rail.

Push 2 of the quickfit dowels **A** as far as they will go into the each of the 2 plinths **6** and the back rail **8**.

Tap 2 wooden dowels **M** into the each of the 2 plinths **6** and the back rail **8**.






Step 15

Fit the 2 plinths and the back rail

Push the 2 plinths 6 and the back rail 8 onto the right side 2.

Turn the 3 large locking cam nuts **B** clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.




Step 16

Fit the left side

Push the left side 1 onto the assembly.

Turn the 5 large locking cam nuts 3 clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.




Step 17

Fit the top

Push the top 3 onto the assembly.

Turn the 4 large locking cam nuts **(B)** clockwise as far as they will go to secure the panels.

Important: Make sure there is no gap between the fitted panels.



Step 18

Fit the back

a: Square up the unit by making sure that measurement **x** to **x** equals **y** to **y**.

b: Place the back 16 onto the unit.


Nail ① around the outside edges of the back 16.

Note: Nails should be spaced about 150mm apart.

Step **19**

Fit the 5 plastic nails

Tap 2 plastic nails **1** into the bottom edge of each side **1** and **2**.

Tap the remaining plastic nail into the bottom edge of the plinth at the front of the unit.

Carefully stand the unit up for the next step and place it in its final position in the room.


Fit the overbalance protector kit


- a: Before fitting the overbalance protector kit, use a spirit level to check the base (or top) of the unit is level, front-to-back and side-to-side in the 3 positions shown.

 Use suitable packing pieces (not supplied) to make the unit level.
- a: To prevent possible overbalancing this unit must be secured to a suitable wall by fitting of the overbalance protector kit (1) to the unit, or an alternative fixing method of your choice.

Wall fixings are not supplied as they will need to suit the wall type.

Note: Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.





Step 21


Fit the hanging rail and drawers

Push the hanging rail 5 into the rail holders **k** fitted to the side panels.

Slide the wheels of the runners fitted to the drawers, over the wheels of the runners fitted to the side panels and push the drawers into position.


Prepare the 2 doors

Push fit 3 hinges P into each door 14 and 15.

Secure each hinge by tighteng up its 2 screws.

Step 23

Fit the doors and the handles

2 people are needed here

Fit 1 door 14 and 15 at a time, by lining up the 2 screws in the top hinge with the 2 holes at the top of the panel and push them in.

Working down the door, push in the other hinges.

When all of the hinges have been pushed into place, tighten the 2 screws on each hinge.

Attach a handle **()** to each door using screw **()**.








Step 24

Adjust the doors if needed

a: Before adjusting the doors, use a spirit level to check the base (or top) of the unit is level, front-to-back and side-to-side in the 3 positions shown.

Use suitable packing pieces (not supplied) to make the unit level BEFORE making any adjustment to the hinges, as shown.

b: Height adjustment.

Loosen screws A on hinge plates and move door up or down as required. Retighten screw A.

C: Forward and Back adjustment.


Loosen screw B on hinge plate and move door in or out as required. Retighten screw B.

d: Sideways adjustment.

To move door 'out' loosen screw C.
To move door 'in' tighten screw C.




Step 25

Fit the door buffers
