

A Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- *Warning:* This unit weighs approximately 25kgs. Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 1, 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers *for inserting screws*,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- **Safety note:** If there is any chance of this unit being pulled over by children etc. it is recommended that the unit is secured to a wall using suitable fixings (not supplied).
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.



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



Step 1

Prepare the 2 drawer fronts


Screw 2 metal dowels (A) into each of the drawer fronts (8) and (9).

Note: Tighten the metal dowels up fully against the panels.

Note: The right drawer front has a small identification hole.



Step 2

Prepare the drawer sides

Insert a small locking nut **B** into the hole shown on the left drawer side **10** and the right drawer side **11**.

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.


Step 3


Attach the drawer sides to the drawer frontS


Push a left drawer side **10** and a right drawer side **11** onto the back of each drawer front **8** and **9**.

Turn the small locking nuts **B** on the left drawer side **10** and right drawer side **11**.

Note: Turn the locking nuts **B** clockwise to secure panels - more than 1/2 a turn.









Step 4

Fit the drawer base

Slide the drawer base **13** down the grooves in the drawer sides **10** and **11** and down into the groove in the drawer front **8** and **9**.

Step 5

Fit the drawer back

Fit the drawer back **12** between the drawer sides **10** and **11**.

Make sure that the drawer base **13** fits into the groove in the drawer back **12**.

Hold the drawer back **12** in position and tap the knock-in pegs **5** through the holes in the drawer sides **10** and **11**.

Step 6


Attach the handles


Attach a handle O to each of the drawer fronts 8 and 9 using screws O.


Step 7


Fit the wedgefixes

Turn the 2 drawer assemblies over and slide 4 wedgefixes **1** into the front and back grooves, as shown, and tighten up the screws.











Step 8

Prepare the top

Screw 4 metal dowels (A) into the top **2**.

Screw 4 small metal dowels into the holes on the top 2.

Note: Tighten metal dowels up fully against the panels.

Step 9

Prepare the top divider

Insert 2 large locking nuts () into the top divider (4).

Note: The arrow on the locking nut **must** point towards the hole in the edge of the panel.

Tap 2 wooden dowels () into the top divider (4).

Note: Wooden dowels **must not** stick out from the edge by more than 10mm or they may damage other panels.


Step 10


Fit the top divider to the top


Push the top divider **4** onto the top **2**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts ⓒ fitted to the top divider 4.

Note: Turn the large locking nuts **O** as far as they will go - more than 1/2 a turn.







Step 11 Prepare the 2 x 2 horizontals Insert 4 large locking nuts C into each of the 2 horizontals 3. 3 K Step 12 Fit a horizontal Attach a horizontal 3 to the top divider 4 using 3 2 screws K. 4 *Note:* Support the G horizontal until the right Step 13 side has been fitted. G Fit the 2 large wooden dowels Gently tap the 2 large wooden dowels G 3 through the horizontal 3 and into the top divider 4 **4** until they ''bottom out".

Step 14

Prepare the right side


a: Place a runner **P** onto one of the sides **1**. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **M**.


b: Slide the runner **P** back the other way and fit the 2nd screw **M** into the corresponding hole in the side **1**.


C: Screw 5 metal dowels **B** into the side **1**.


Push 2 hollow core locking nuts **D** into the side **1**, making sure that they are flush against the panel's surface. Using a hammer, tap in the pin on the hollow core locking nut **D**.

Note: The pin should be tapped in flush with the top surface of the hollow core locking nut **D**.









Step 15


Fit the right side

Push the right side **1** onto the top **2** and the horizontal **3**.

The 2 small metal dowels fitted to the top 2 must slide into the top of the 2 hollow core locking nuts **D** fitted to the right side **1**.

Insert a screwdriver into the 2 hollow core locking nuts **D** and turn the nuts inside as far as they will go.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts ⓒ fitted to the horizontal ③.



Step 16

Prepare the lower divider

a: Place a runner **P** onto the lower divider **5**. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **M**.


b: Slide the runner **P** back the other way and use the 2nd hole from the back to fit the 2nd screw **M**.

C: Tap 2 wooden dowels **H** into the lower divider **5**.

Turn the divider over

d: Place a runner **M** onto the lower divider **5**. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **M**.

e: Slide the runner **P** back the other way and use the 2nd hole from the back to fit the 2nd screw **M**.




Finished front edge

Step 17

Fit the lower divider

Push the lower divider **5** down onto the horizontal **3**.




Step 18

Fit the other horizontal

Fit the horizontal **3** to the right side **1** and the lower divider **5**.

Attach the horizontal **3** to the lower divider **5** using 2 screws **6**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts **G** fitted to the horizontal **3**.




Step 19

Prepare the plinth

Insert 2 large locking nuts **C** into the plinth **7**.

Tap 2 wooden dowels (1) into the plinth 7.




Step 20

Fit the plinth

Push the plinth **7** onto the right side **1**.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the large locking nut **G** fitted to the plinth **7**.



Step 21

Prepare the left side


a: Place a runner **P** onto one of the sides **1**. Slide back the top of runner and use the 2nd hole from the front to fit the 1st screw **M**.


b: Slide the runner P back the other way and fit the 2nd screw M into the corresponding hole in the side 1.


C: Screw 5 metal dowels **A** into the side **1**.


Push 2 hollow core locking nuts **D** into the side **1**, making sure that they are flush against the panel's surface. Using a hammer, tap in the pin on the hollow core locking nut **D**.


Note: The pin should be tapped in flush with the top surface of the hollow core locking nut **D**.












Step 22

Fit the left side

Push the left side **1** onto the assembly.

Use a screwdriver to turn the nuts inside the 2 hollow core locking nuts **D** fitted to the left side **1**.


Use a screwdriver to tighten the 5 large locking nuts **G** fitted to the horizontals **3** and the plinth **7**.



Step 23


Prepare the back

Insert 2 large locking nuts () into each of the back (6).



Step 24 Fit the back Push the back 6 down onto the top 2.

Use a screwdriver to tighten the 2 large locking nuts C fitted to the back 6.



Step 25


Secure the back

Secure the back 6 to the 2 horizontals 3 using 4 screws **J**.

Carefully stand the unit up for the next step.



Warning: The unit is heavy. Lift with care.



Step 26


Fit the drawers

Slide both the runners P forward and locate the drawer sides 10 and 11 between them, lining up the holes in the drawer wrap with the 2nd 'threaded' holes in the runners P.

Working from the inside of the drawer, insert 2 screws (1) through the drawer sides and out into the 2nd threaded hole in the runner.

Note: Do not overtighten the screws N. If they catch on the runner you may need to loosen them slightly.

Assembly is complete



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
