

## Safety and Care Advice

#### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on page 2
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

#### Care and maintenance


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.





## Step 1

1. Into the ends of Bottom Rail 6 insert 2 x dowel


## Step 2

1. Connect Back Left Bar

1 to Front Left Bar
2 using 1 x Screw ,
1 x screw and
2 x Female Threaded
Boss as shown

## Step 3

- 1. Connect top rail 5 to Bars 3 and 4 with 1 x Screw 6 using Allen key A
- 2. Connect Bottom rail 6 to Bar 3 with 2 x Screw B using Allen key
- 3. Connect Bottom Rack
  7 to Bars 3 and 4
  with 2 x Screw B using
  Allen Key A


## Step 4


- 1. Connect top rail 5 to

  Screw 6 using Allen
  key A
- 2. Connect Bottom rail 6 to Bar 1 with 2 x Screw B using Allen key
- 3. Connect Bottom Rack
  7 to Bars 1 and 2
  with 2 x Screw B using
  Allen Key A

### Step 5

1. Connect 4 x hooks to panels 1 2 3 and 4 using 4 x Screw B as shown.
