## Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

- To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torgue setting.


## Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.


## Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts

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## Assembly Instructions

## Step 1

Fixing legs to Base frame

Fixing legs 12 to Base
Frame 10 by using Screw (A)Washer B \& C and turn Allen Key (D) clock wise to fix.

## Step 2

Repeat Step 1 to assemble the rest 3 legs.

## Step 3

a: Insert Wooden dowel
© to the Sides 2 and 3
b: Insert Large locking Pin into Base frame 10

Note: Insert locking pin as shown.

Do not over tighten.

## Step 4

Attach Left Side 2 to the Base frame, insert Large locking Nut © into Left sides 2 , use screw driver to turn Locking nut clockwise to lock.

## Step 5

Fix Runner outside left (J) to Left Side 2 by Screws (1).


## Step 6

Repeat Step 4 to Right Side 3.

## Step 7

Repeat Step 5 to fix (ㄴ)
Runner outside right to Right Side 3 .

## Step 8

Slip the Back panel 11 to the groves on the Sides.

## Step 9

Insert Large locking Pin © into Top panel 1

Note: Insert locking pin as shown.

Do not over tighten.

## Step 10

Attach Top panel 1 to the unit.

Insert Large locking nut $\boldsymbol{F}$ as show on picture and use screw driver to trun Large locking nut clockwise to lock.


## Step 11

## Assembling the drawer.

a: Insert 5 Small locking pin © into holes shown on back of Drawer front

Note: Insert Locking pin as far as shown.
Do not over tighten.
b: Fix Drawer sides and 6 and Drawer 5 support rail to Drawer front 4 .

Insert Small locking nuts into Drawers Sides and Drawer support rail.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts $\operatorname{P}$ clockwise to lock.

C: Slip Drawer base 8 into grooves on the Drawer walls.
d: Fix Drawer back 7 onto sides by using 6 Screws ©
e: Fix Runner inside left ( $\mathbb{C}$ and Runer inside right (1) onto the underside of Drawer sides by using 6 Screws (1).

F: Fix Handle © by using Screw (1).

## Step 13

a. Insert Wooden dowels (G) into Mirror post 14 as show on picture.
b. Attach Mirror post to the Mirror 14 by Screw (A) and Washer (S).
c. Attach Mirror post to Mirror base 15 by Screw
(A).

## Step 14

Put the mirror unit on the dressing table top panel and fix with Screw (B).

Assembly is complete.
