

Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on page 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the panels during assembly, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/driver for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

• Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Glue safety - Take care when using glue, please follow the advice below

Skin contact: Remove contamination by washing with soap and water. This produre should also be followed prior to eating and drinking.

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with clean water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice.

If swallowed: Seek medical advice immediately. If possible show product information or label to the medical advisor.


Care and maintenance



Step 1

Fitting the base




Caution:

Always check the assembly method is correct before applying glue.

a: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes. Insert dowels into side supports 10 and front panels 9.

b: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes. Attach the front panels 9 onto the side supports 10.

C: Place a small amount of glue **(a)** into the dowel holes. Attach the bottom panel **(4)** onto the unit.



Step 2

Fitting the bottom panel

a: Use screws **A** to fix side panels **6** onto the unit.


b: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes.

Insert dowels **B** into side panels **6** and support **7**, then attach support **7** onto the unit.

Step 3

Fitting the bottom shelf

a: Screw locking pins **6** into bottom shelf **3**. Insert locking pins as far as shown.



Step 3 - continued

b: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes. Attach bottom shelf 3 onto the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts **O** clockwise to lock, then use plastic plugs **G** to cover the locking nuts.


b: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes.

Insert dowels into left support , then attach left support onto bottom shelf .

Insert dowels **B** into right support **8** and back panel **5**, then attach right support **8** and back panel **5** onto the unit.

b: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes. Insert dowels into support and back panel 5.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts **O** clockwise to lock, then use plastic plugs **G** to cover the locking nuts.



Step 4

Fitting the top shelf

a: Screw locking pins into top shelf 2. Insert locking pins as far as shown.

Use screws (4) to fix side panels (6) onto top shelf (2).


b: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes.

Attach top shelf 2 onto the unit.

Insert dowels into support 7, then attach support 7 onto the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts **D** clockwise to lock, then use plastic plugs **G** to cover the locking nuts.

C: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes. Insert dowels into the unit.

Step 5

Fitting the top panel

a: Screw locking pins B into top panel 1. Insert locking pins as far as shown.

b: Place a small amount of glue into the dowel holes. Attach top panel 1 onto the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts **D** clockwise to lock, then use plastic plugs **G** to cover locking nuts.
