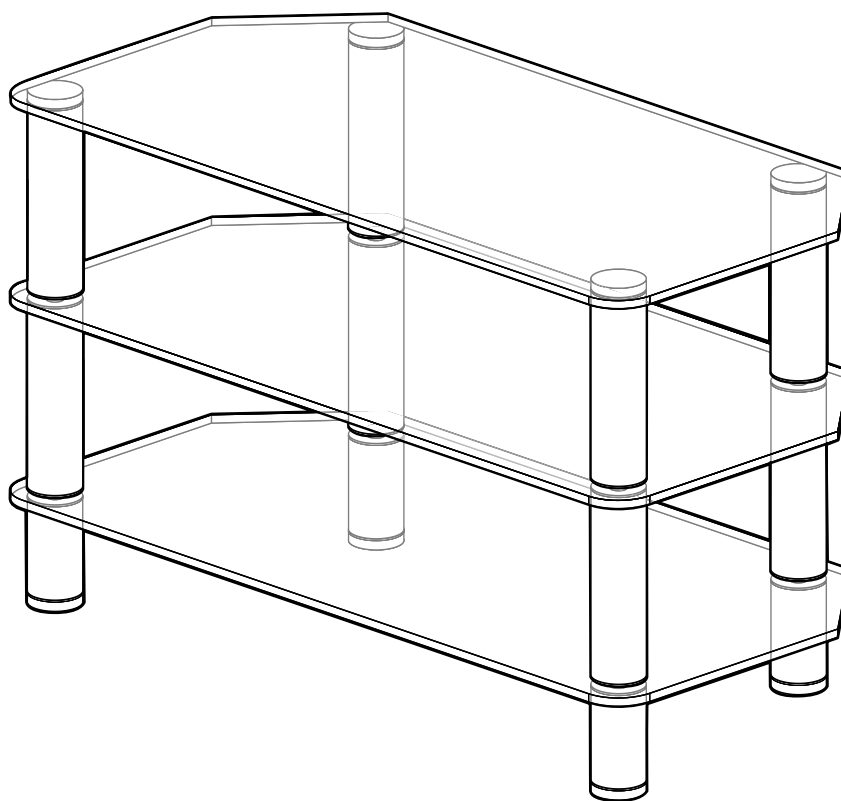

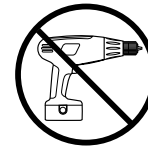


Safety and Care Advice

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers **for inserting screws**, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

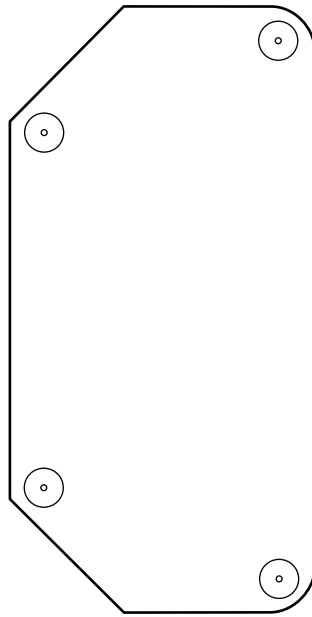
- Do not place very hot or very cold items against or in close proximity to glass surfaces unless an adequately thick insulating material is used to prevent such items from coming into contact with the glass.

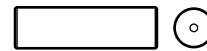

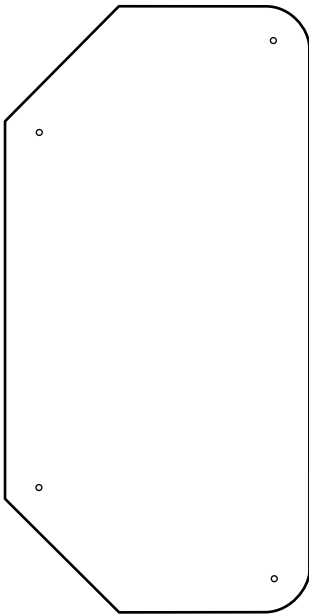
1 Metal rod x 4

(80 x 40cm)

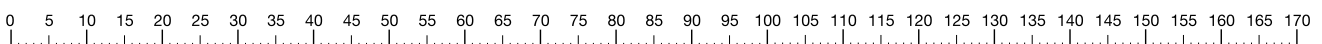


5 Metal tube x 4

Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

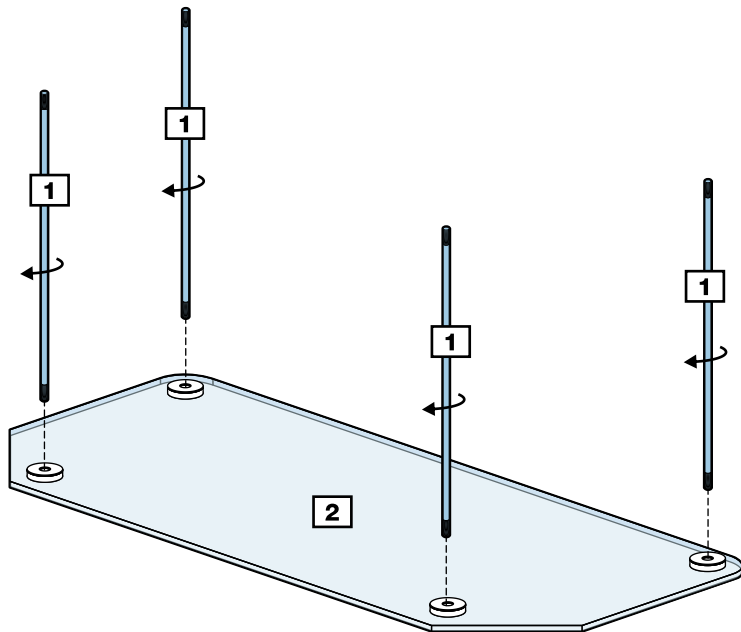

Step 1

Attaching metal rods

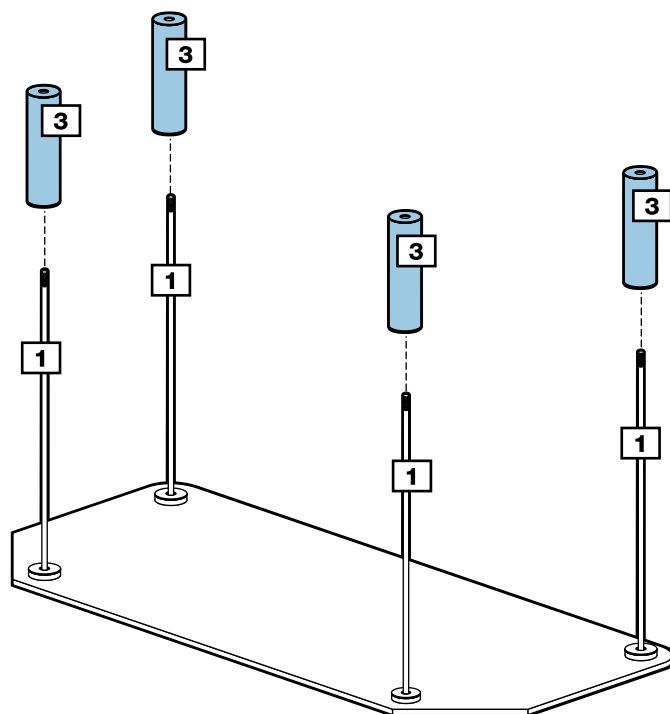
Please attach the 4pcs of metal rod **1** onto panel **2** as shown.

Attaching metal tubes

Attach 4 pcs of metal tubes **3** through 4 pcs of metal rods **1** as shown.

Step 4

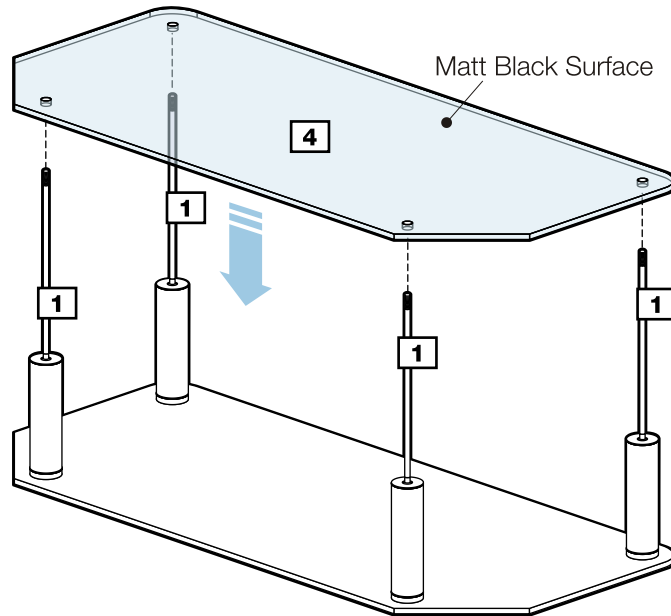
Attaching glass shelf

Two people are needed here.

Attach glass shelf **4** through 4 pcs of metal rods **1** as shown.



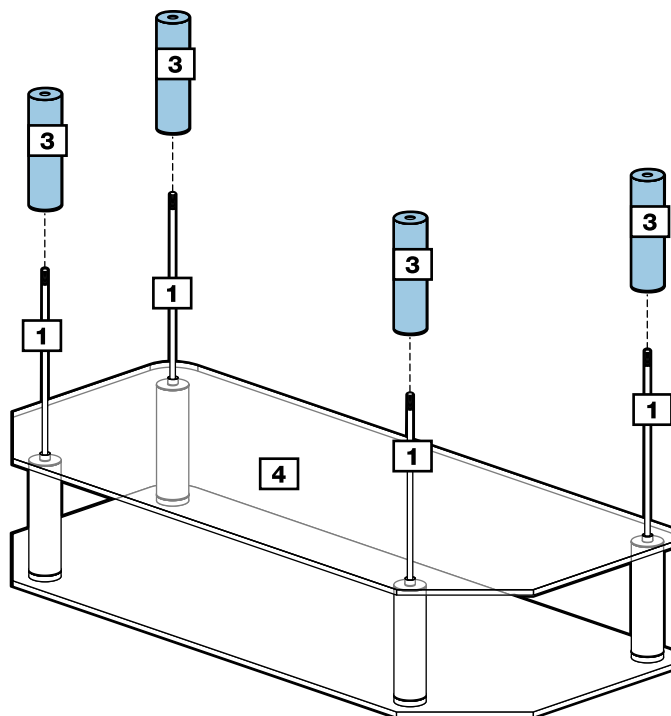

Step 6

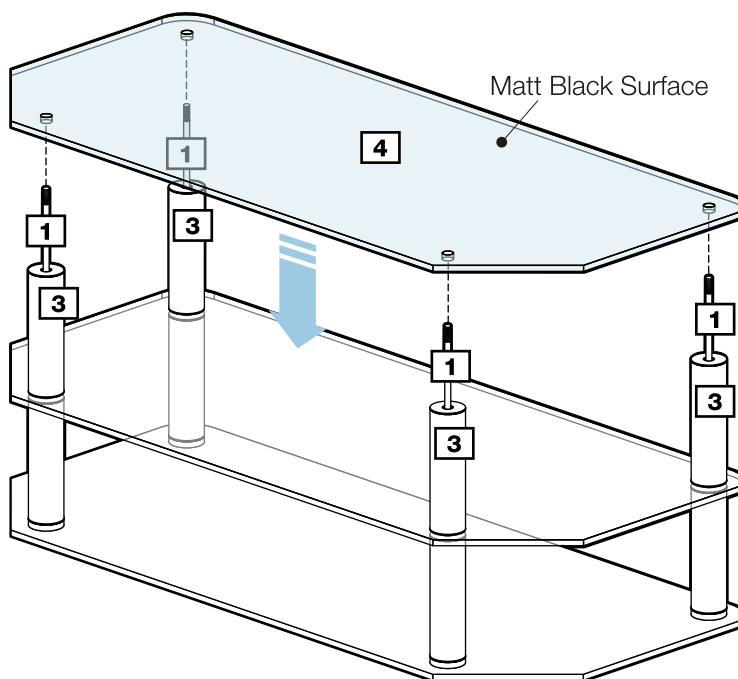
Attaching glass shelf

Two people are needed here.

Attach glass shelf **4** through 4 pcs of metal rods **1** as shown.



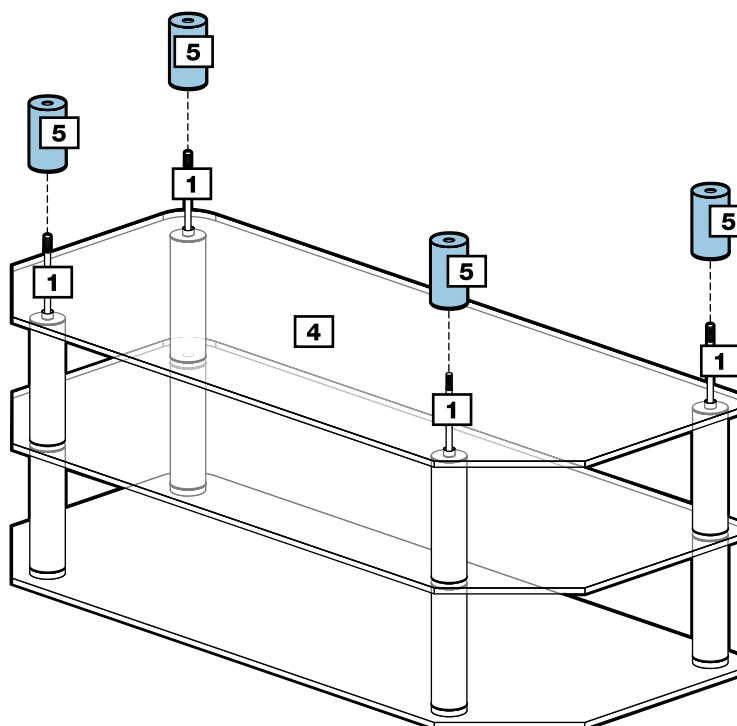

Attach 4 pcs of metal tubes **5** through 4 pcs of metal rods **1** as shown.

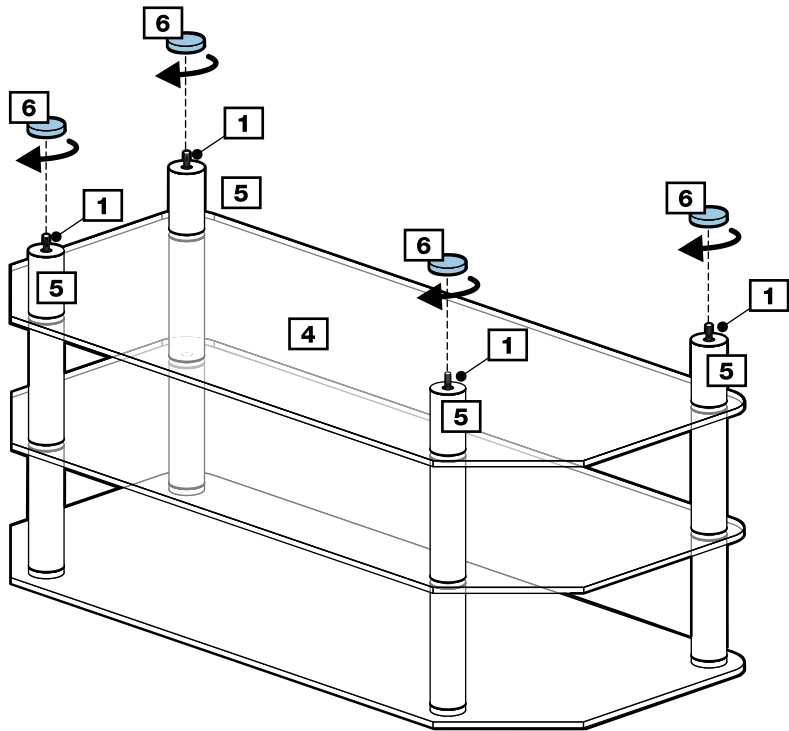

Attaching foot

Finger tighten 4 pcs of feet **6** onto the unit as shown.

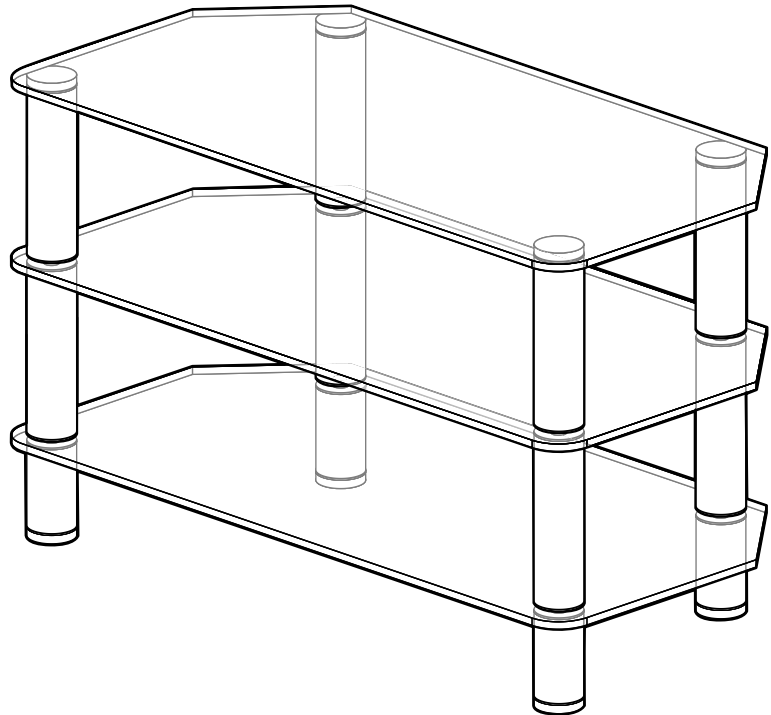
