
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.







2 Left side (67.5 x 47.8cm)





Step 1

Fitting the runners

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Use Screws **f** to fix the Runner left **G**, onto Left side **2**.


Slide top of the runner to access the screw hole.


Insert Dowel **©** into Left side **2**.

b: Use Screws **f** to fix the Runner right **f**, onto Right side **3**.

Slide top of the runner to access the screw hole.

Insert Dowel **6** into Right side **3**.





Step 2

Fitting the centre support

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Insert Dowels **©** into Cross shelf **9**.

b: Use Screws **D** to fix Back support **7** onto Centre support **6**.

C: Use Screws **D** to fix Cross shelf **9** onto the unit.


Step 3

Fitting bottom and side panels

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Use Screws **D** to fix Bottom **4**, Left side **2**, Right side **3** onto the unit.

Step 3 - continued

b: Use Screws **D** to fix Left side **2**, Right side **3** onto the unit.

C: Use Screws **f** to fix the Front castors **1** and Castors **1** onto the unit.

Note: The Front castors • feature a locking arm. We recommend you lock the castors when you have finally positioned the unit in place.


Step 4

Fitting the top panel

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

a: Screw in Locking pins **B** onto Top 1.

b: Use Locking nuts **(A)** to fix the Table top **(1)** onto the unit .




Step 5

Fitting the drawer panel

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

Use Screws **(F)** to fix the Keyboard **(5)** onto the unit.




Step 6

Fitting the shelf

Place Shelf supports **(E)** into the unit.

Slide shelf 8 into the unit.


Note: Adjust the shelf supports to the desired height.



Step 7

Cover the screws

Use Cover caps **(K)** to cover the screws.
