

Step1

Fitting the base


a: Push all the five castors

1 into the underside of
the base 2.

NOTE: Ensure all the castors are firmly located on the base.

b:Insert the gas lift 3 into the base 2.

c: Put the gas lift cover 4 on the gas lift 3.




NOTE: Ensure the gas lift is fully inserted and well fitted.

Step 2

Fitting the Seat Cushion Use bolts (A) with washer (C) to fix the seat plate (5) onto the seat (7).

NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.




Step 3

Fitting the armrest on seat

Use bolts **B** to fix the armrest

8 on seat 7 .

NOTE: Please don't fully fasten the bolts this step.




Step 4

Fitting the backrest

Flip the armrest up and use

bolts **B** to fix the armrest


8 on backrest 6 .



Step 5

Fully Fasten the aremrest bolts and fitting the armrest screw cap

Please fully fasten all armrest bolts before put the cap into the hole of armrest 8.




Step 6

Fitting the Unit

Note: adding M6 Allen key is to help customer to prevent armrest loosen.




Step 7
