The stroller is suitable for children under 36 months. The max load of the stroller is 15kg, never over loaded.

- WARNING: The parking device shall be engaged when placing and removing the children
- WARNING: To avoid injury ensure that your child is kept away when unfolding and folding this product.
- WARNING: Do not let your child play with this product.
- WARNING: Always use the restraint system.
- WARNING: This product is not suitable for running or skating.
- WARNING: Do not use if any part is broken, torn or missing.
- WARNING: It may be dangerous to leave your child unattended.
- WARNING: This seat unit is not suitable for children over 36 months.



Frame with fabric



Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Unfold Frame:

Locate the locking catch on the side of the stroller and lift to release from the locking stud.(fig 1)
Unfold the pushchair using both hands. Press the locking bar until it "clicks" into place.




Step 2

Assemble The Front Wheels:

Attach the swivel wheels by locating the wheel under the frame tube.


Put the wheels upwards until the wheels clicks into position. (fig 3)



Step 3

Fit Canopy:

Fix the snap button of the canopy on the each side and the back on the backrest.(fig 3)



Step 4

Adjust Canopy:

Follow the arrow 1 or arrow 2 to close or open the hood.




Step 5

Harness & Buckle:

To fasten the waist harness: Insert both buckle clips into each side of the buckle. Listen for the "click". To release the harness: Squeeze the buckles and pull apart.

To adjust the buckle: To adjust the shoulder straps move the slides as shown on. (fig 5)


Note: you can adjust the shoulder straps length according to the baby height.



Step 6

Lock Swivel Wheel:

Your pushchair has front lock swivel wheels. To lock swivel wheels press the pedal down (step 1) and fix into position to secure (step 2). Repeat on both wheels. Push up to release.(fig 6)


Step 7

Link Brake Operation:

To engage the brake push down brake locking pedal. Lift up pedals to release the brake.

WARNING: Do not step on the steel bar to lock the brake.


WARNING: Roll back and forth to make sure the stroller is fully engaged after braking.



Step 8

To Recline Backrest:

Locate backrest adjustment mechanism at the rear of the seat, squeeze the clip on the reclining harness and gently lower the back rest. To raise the backrest, squeeze the clip on the reclining harness and gently pull up the backrest to desired height. (fig 8)




Fold

To Fold:

Lift the the pedal upwards (step 1) and step down the second lock pedal(step 2). (fig 9). Push the handles over and the pushchair will naturally catch on the side of your pushchair (step 3)

Note: always fold the canopy before folding your pushchair



Care and Maintenance

General

This pushchair was designed and manufactured with qualified materials and craftsmanship.

Always use the safety harness.

Always check your pushchair for bullet points. Lubricate moving parts regularly, especially the wheels, and lower parts of the chassis that tend to collect dirt.

Inspect regularly for:

• Worn parts, torn materials or stitching.

• Loose screws, bent or broken frame parts.

• Broken, damaged or missing parts.

Should any of the above be evident do not use and contact the Helpline:03456 400 800 for advice.

Care and Maintenance:

Fabric parts may be cleaned in accordance with the fabric care labels. Do not machine wash.

Seat: Sponge clean only

Canopy/Basket:Hand wash only.

Do not leave the stroller exposed to heat i.e. by a radiator orin direct sunlight.

If the stroller chassis parts have been exposed to salt water we recommend that they be rinsed down with fresh (sap) water as soon as possible afterwards.

Do not fold or store the product while wet and never store in a damp environment as this can cause mildew to form.
