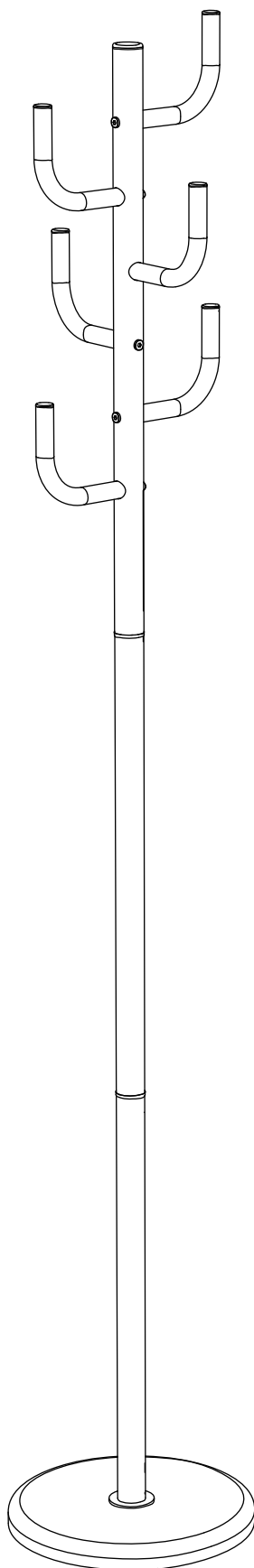

IMPORTANT, RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE: READ CAREFULLY.

1. Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
2. Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
3. This product has been constructed to be used in the domestic environment only and not for commercial purposes.
4. Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
5. Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
6. We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.
7. Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
8. Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

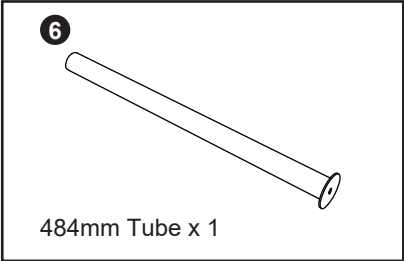
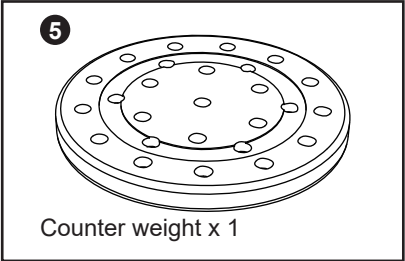
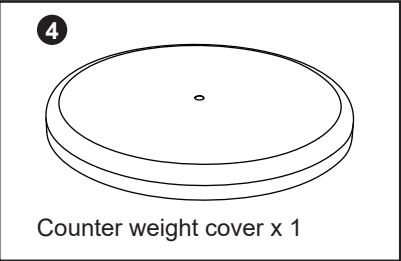
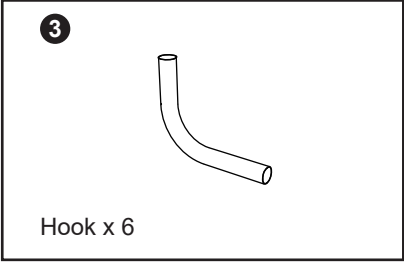
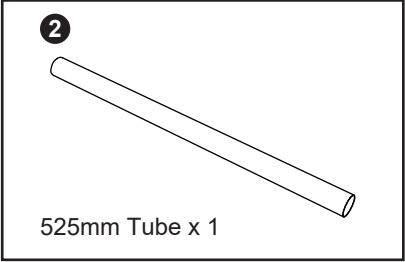
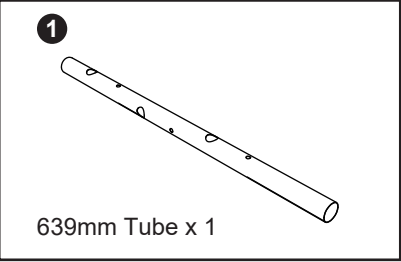
Care and maintenance

1. Use damp cloth to wipe clean, Furniture polish is not recommended.
2. From time to time check that there are no loose screws, nuts or bolts. If there are please re-tighten.
3. The product should not be disposed with household waste. The product should be take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

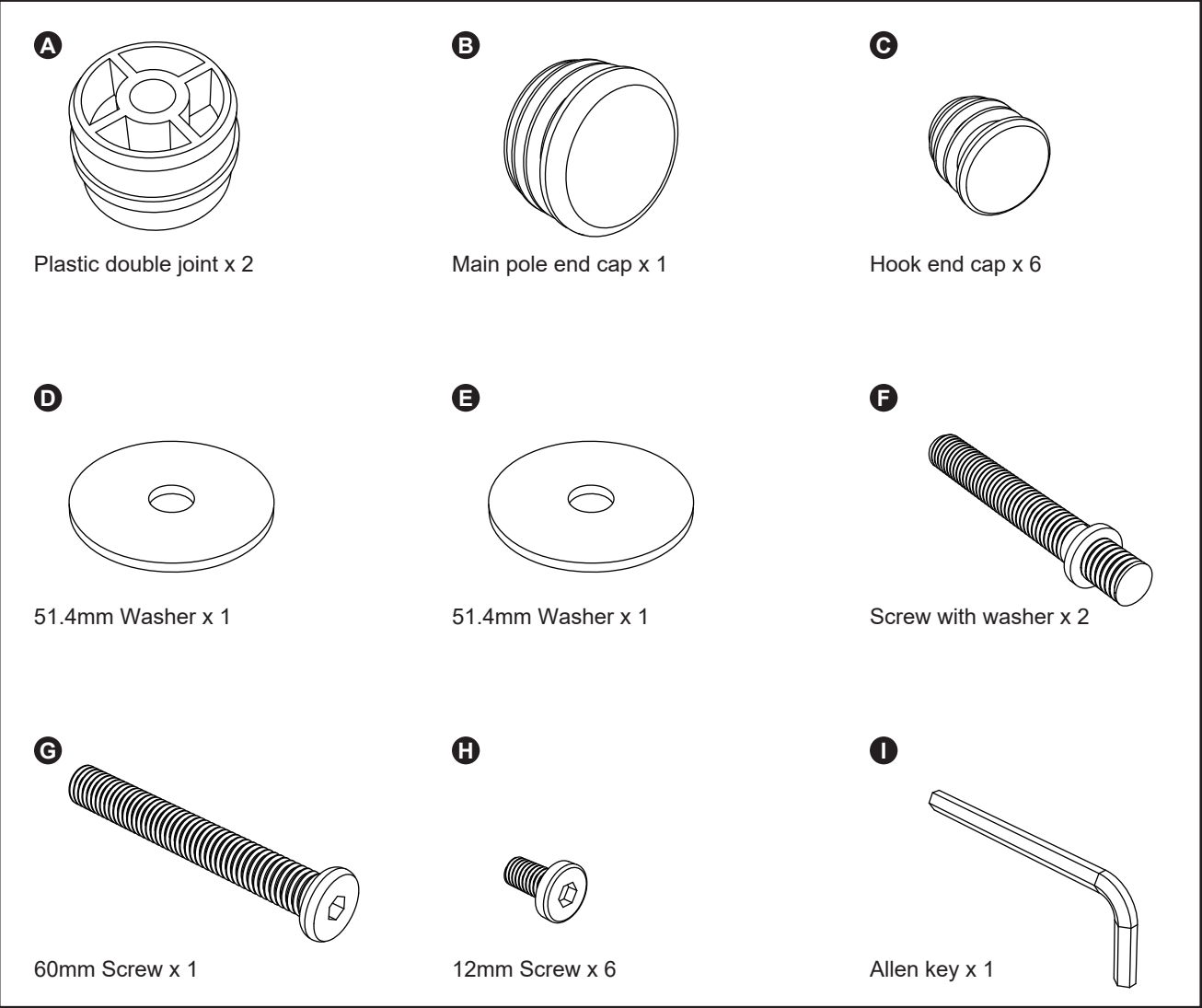
Additional Guidance

1. Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tightened the bolts.
2. Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.
3. DO NOT OVERLOAD and please loading evenly within maximum loading weight 1.5 kg/ rod.

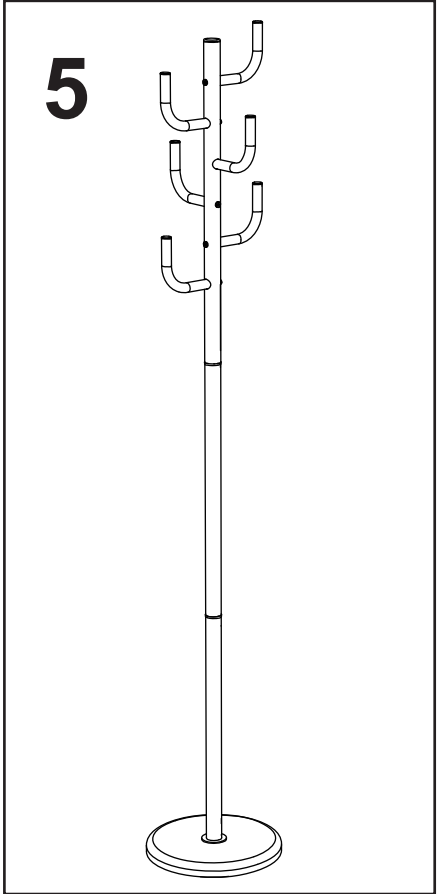
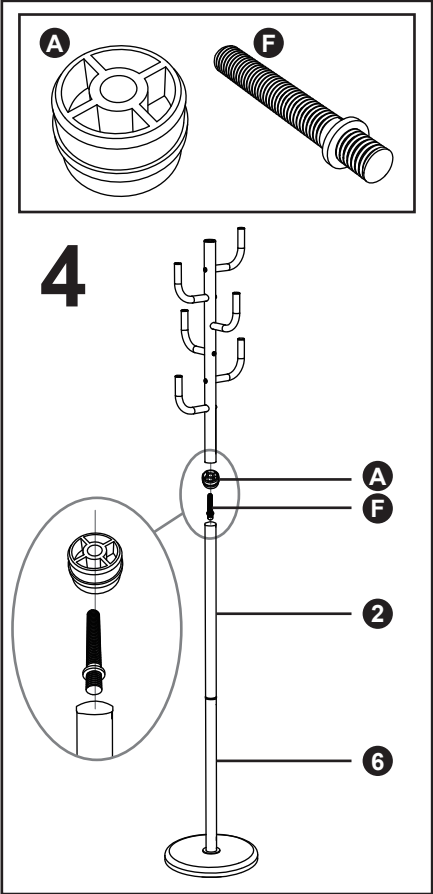
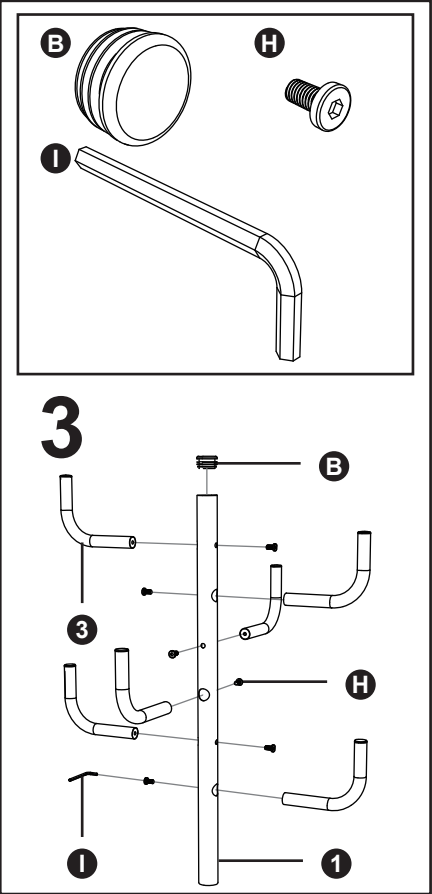
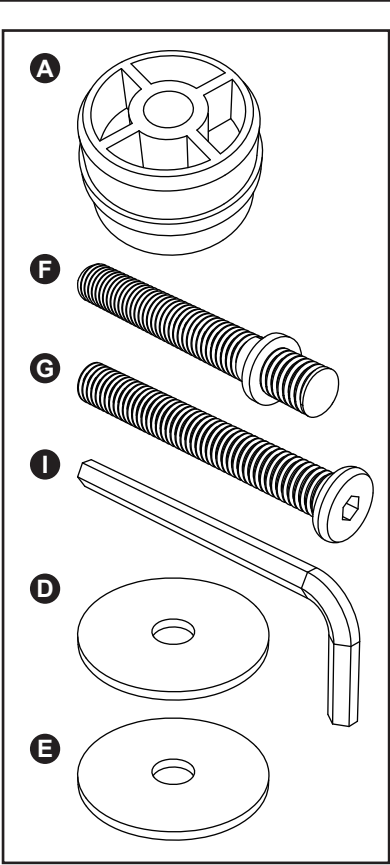
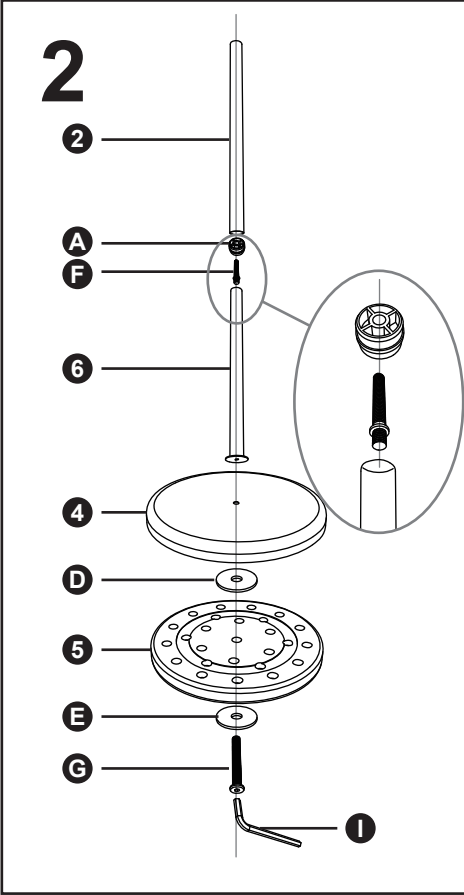
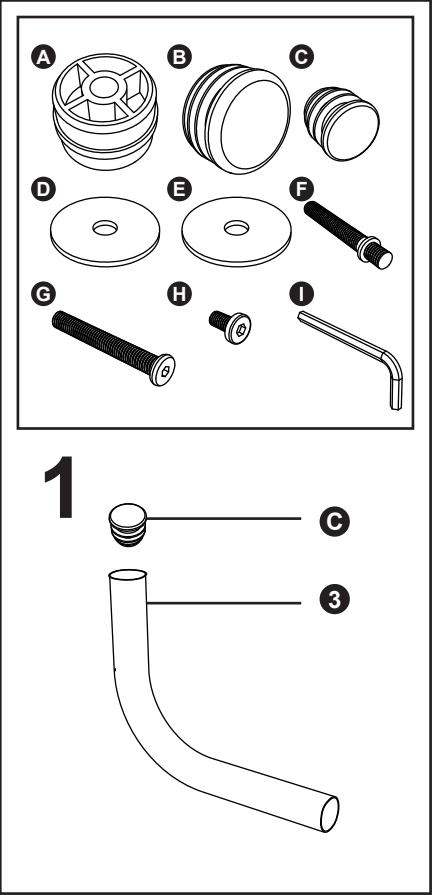
