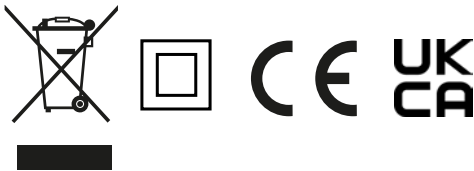
This fitting is designed for indoor use only.
Do not use polish or abrasive cleaner - just a soft dry cloth.

BULB REPLACEMENT

- 1. Disconnect the luminaire from the main power supply.
- 2. Allow the bulb to cool down for at least 10 minutes before replacing it.
- 3. Remove the shade or any parts if necessary.
- 4. Never touch the bulb directly with your fingers. Instead, cover it with a cloth.
- 5. Loosen and remove the old bulb from the luminaire.
- 6. Replace with a new bulb that does not exceed the indicated wattage on the fitting. (Max.5W LED G9, bulb not included)
- 7. Reattach the shade or any parts if removed.
- 8. Reconnect the luminaire to the main power supply.

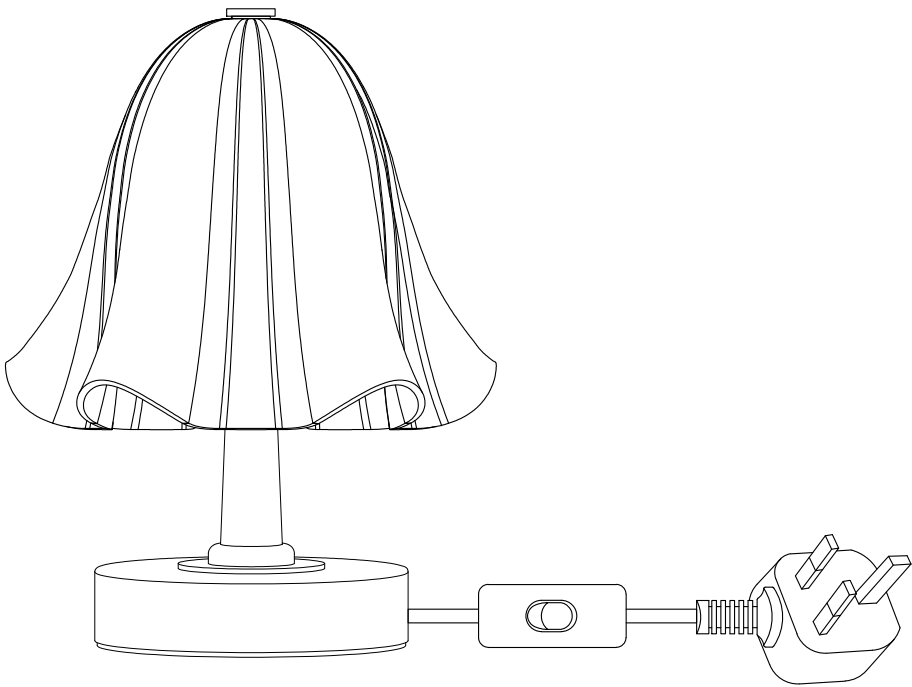

Care & Instruction Manual

Please read and retain these instructions for future reference

Important

- Read these instructions carefully and familiarize yourself with the procedure before assembling the unit.
- Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly.
- Always be sure to use the correct type and wattage of bulbs as indicated on the fitting. Never exceed the wattage stated.
- To avoid scratching it is recommended that you assemble the unit on a soft level surface.
- When changing the bulb, always switch off at the mains and allow the old bulb to cool down before handling. Dispose of used bulbs carefully.
- This luminaire is Class II insulated.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- The luminaire is designed for indoor use only.
- This product does not have a dimmer function and is not compatible with dimmable light bulbs.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the unit.

Instruction for use

1. Ensure the lamp is disconnected from mains.
2. Remove the metal plate, plastic seal ring from the metal frame.
3. Remove the holding ring from the lamp holder, then attach the metal frame onto it and secure in place with the holding ring.
4. Fit the bulb: Type and wattage as indicated on the fitting. The wattage indicated must not be exceeded.
5. Attach the glass shade onto the metal frame and secure in place with the plastic seal ring and metal plate. The shade may be tilted after assembly, adjust it to be leveled as step 7 on the diagram.
6. Plug the lamp into a suitable mains socket.
