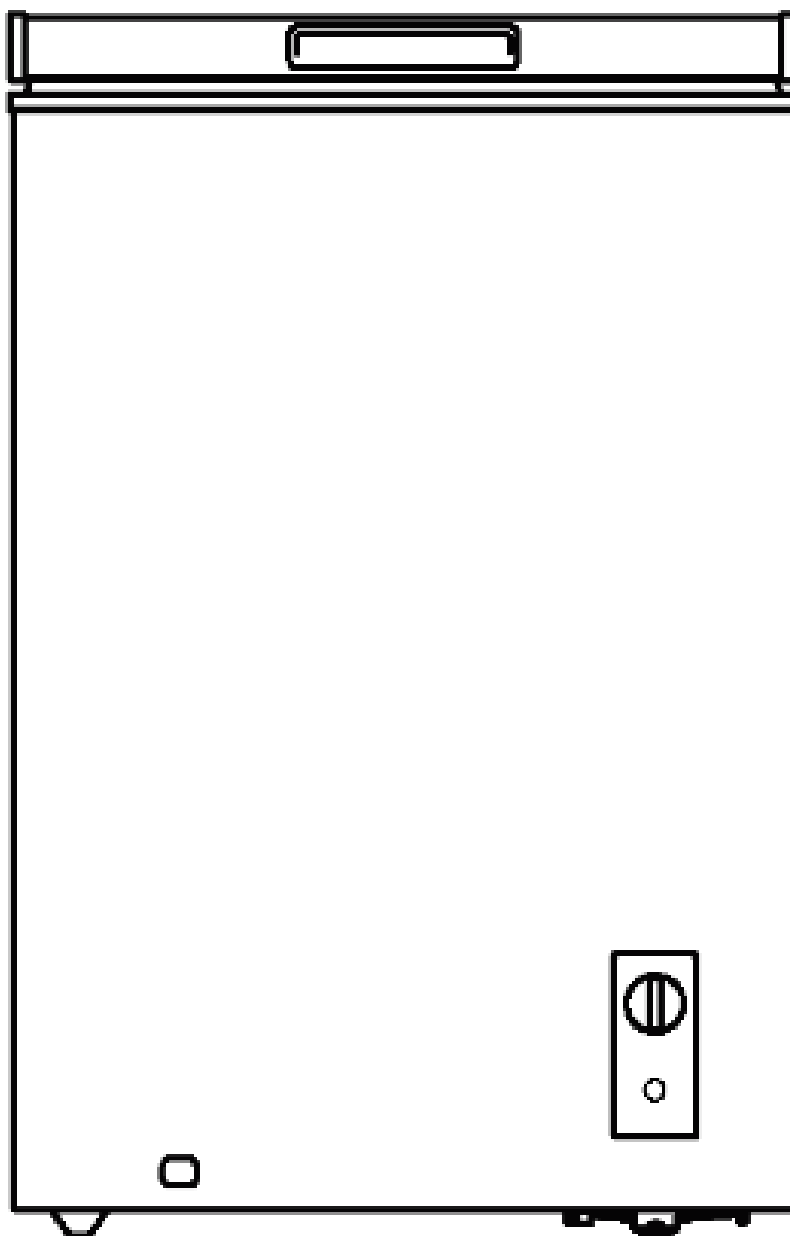

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IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- This model uses natural refrigerant gas as part of its cooling system. This gas is known as R600a (Isobutene) and is environmentally friendly but can be combustible. Care should therefore be taken when handling or transporting the product to ensure that none of the refrigeration circuit components are damaged.
- It is hazardous for anyone other than a competent person to carry out any service or repair operation that involves the removal of a cover which gives protection against exposure to electrical parts.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard. DO NOT use with damaged cord or plug.
- **DO NOT** use with an extension cable.
- This product is intended for household use only. DO NOT use outdoors.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children should not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance should not be made by children without supervision.
- **DO NOT** install on carpet or any surface that would prevent adequate ventilation of the appliance.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Use only parts and accessories supplied with the appliance, or sourced directly from the manufacturer. The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock or injury.
- Keep the appliance and plug away from water.
- Do not use mechanical devices or other artificial means to accelerate the defrosting process, such as a heater or a hair dryer.
- **DO NOT** use appliance if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors or dropped into water. Do not operate this appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- If unit is wet, do not plug unit into wall socket or turn unit on. Do not immerse in water or other liquids for cleaning.
- **DO NOT** handle the appliance with wet hands.
- **DO NOT** pull by the cord, close door on cord, pull cord around sharp corners or edges, or expose cord to heated surfaces.
- If this appliance is to replace an old appliance with a lock, the lock must be removed as a safety measure before storing it or disposing of it to prevent the entrapment of young children.
- Old refrigerators and freezers contain insulation gases and refrigerant, they must be disposed of properly. Contact your local authority or your dealer if you have any questions. Ensure that you do not damage the unit prior to being collected by the relevant waste disposal service.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Only use the appliance when fully assembled.
- Never place your fingers or other objects into any part of the appliance other than to load and unload food. Be aware that loose clothing or hair may become trapped if improperly used.
- Bottles containing a high percentage of alcohol must be sealed well and placed vertically in the refrigerator.
- Do not cover the body or the top of the appliance
- Fix down the accessories in the appliance during transportation to prevent damage to them.
- Allow to stand for 4 hours prior to first powering on.

ELECTRICAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- This appliance must be plugged into an earthed socket.
- Before switching on, ensure the voltage of your electricity supply is the same as that indicated on the rating plate. This product is designed to operate on AC220–240V; 50Hz. Connection to any other power source may damage the unit.
- This product may be fitted with a non-rewireable plug. If it is necessary to change the fuse in the plug, the fuse cover must be refitted. If the fuse cover becomes lost or damaged, the plug must not be used until a suitable replacement is obtained.
- Changing the plug should only be carried out by a qualified electrician. The plug removed must be disposed of safely, as insertion into a 13 Amp socket is likely to cause an electrical hazard.

FOOD SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

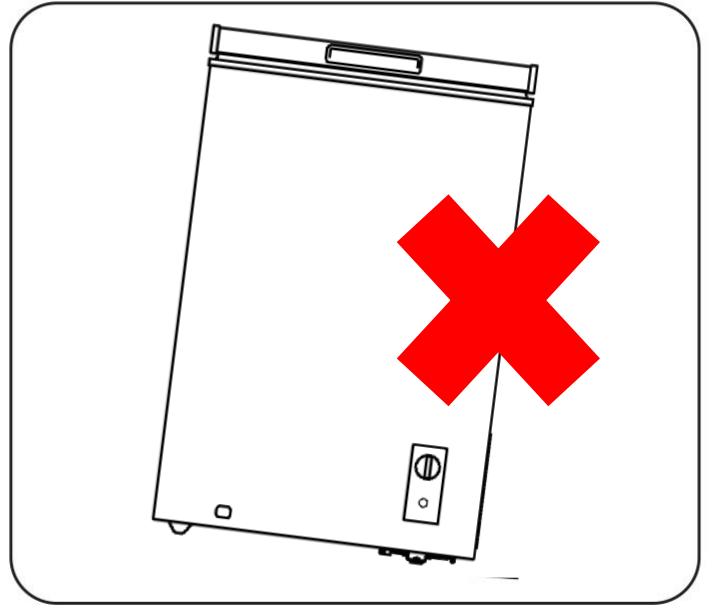
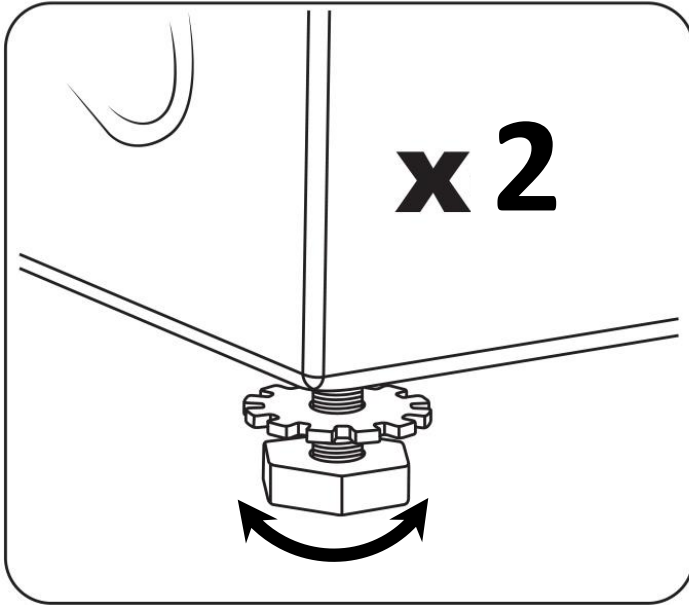
- Opening the door for long periods can cause a significant increase of the temperature in the compartments of the appliance.
- Regularly clean surfaces that come into contact with food, and accessible drainage systems.
- Store raw meat and fish in suitable containers in the appliance, so that it is not in contact with or drip onto other food.
- Two-star frozen-food compartments (if they are present in the appliance) are suitable for storing pre-frozen food, storing or making ice-cream and making ice cubes.
- One-, two- and three -star compartments (if they are presented in the appliance) are not suitable for the freezing of fresh food.
- If the appliance is left empty for long periods, switch off, defrost, clean, dry and leave the door open to prevent mould developing within the appliance.
- Ensure food is not stored for longer than recommended.

INSTALLATION GUIDANCE

CAUTION This is heavy. Ensure a minimum of two people are used to move the appliance.

- Place your appliance in an area that is not exposed to direct sunlight.
- Your appliance should be placed at least 30cm away from stoves, ovens and other heating cores.
- When your appliance is placed next to a chest freezer or freezer, there should be at least 10cms between them to prevent humidity on the outer surface.
- Do not place anything on top of your appliance and install the unit in a suitable place so that there is at least 5cm clearance around the appliance.
- The rear of the appliance should be at least 6cm away from the back wall.
- The appliance must be used in the vertical position and on a flat surface.
- **DO NOT** place your appliance on a carpeted surface as this will prevent adequate ventilation.
- This appliance should only be placed on a flat, firm surface.
- Choose a dry and well-ventilated space.
- The appliance should be positioned so that the plug is easily accessible.
- Suitable for storage in a garage, outbuilding or shed (can operate in a ambient temperature up to -15°C).

INSTALLATION – LEVELLING THE FEET



WARNING – we recommend a minimum of 2 people when moving or lifting the appliance.

WARNING – only level the appliance with the feet supplied. DO NOT use cardboard, wood or similar materials to level the appliance.

For optimal performance, your appliance must be levelled, which will prevent deterioration of performance, damage to the appliance, and reduce noise.

We recommend the use of a spirit level to gauge the surface before adjusting any feet, by placing the appliance in its location and checking both the Forward and Side elevations.

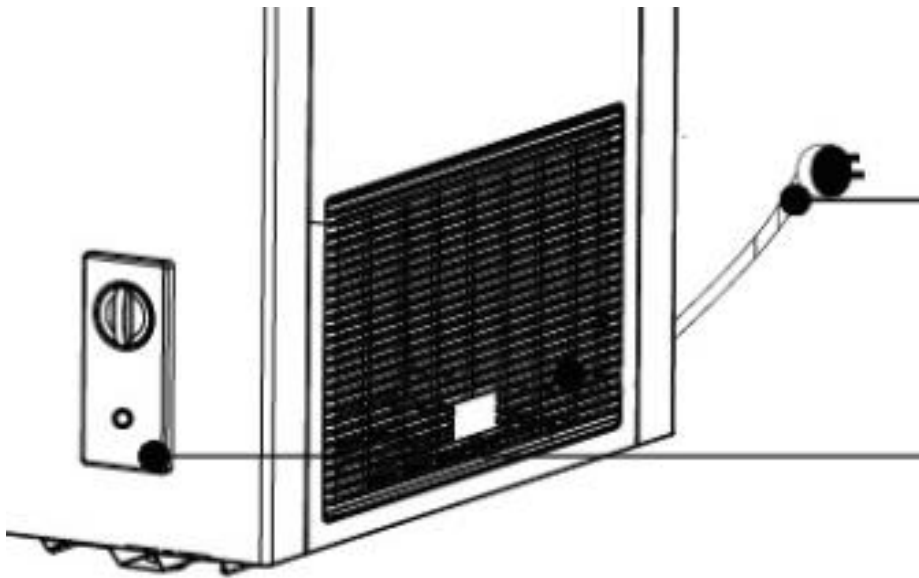
Once you know the level of the appliance, slightly tilt the appliance at the required corner and using a spanner, rotate the desired foot in an anti-clockwise motion. Ensure levels are checked regularly during this stage.

FIRST TIME USE

Your power cord may be stored behind the grille next to the temperature control dial.

Your appliance may have a emit an odour upon first use. This is normal, and can be reduced either through use or wiping down all internal surfaces with warm water.

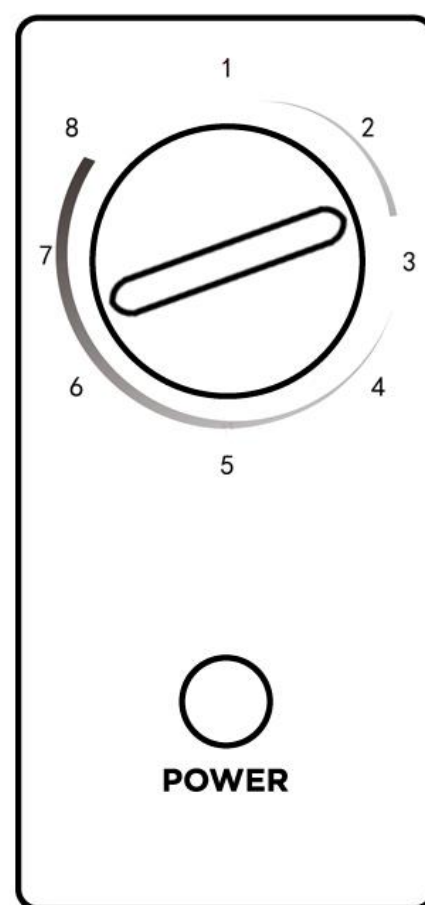
Plug your appliance in. Ensure your appliance is set to “6” or “7” for first time use. This will begin the compressor at which point there may be a bubbling sound. This is normal.



USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

The temperature in the appliance is controlled by the temperature control dial located on the front, at the bottom right. Rotate the control dial to the desired setting.

On the temperature control, 1 is the warmest setting and 8 is the coldest setting. Under normal conditions the temperature control should be set between 6 and 7. Once the temperature control has been set, we recommend that the door is not opened for a minimum of 4 hours to allow the appliance to reach the standard operating temperature. Settings 1 – 3 are cooling settings and this means the temperature inside the product will be between 1 °C and 10 °C. Settings 4 – 8 are freezing settings and this means the temperature inside the product will be between -12 °C and -26 °C.



Note: The standard operating temperature for the freezer compartment should be between -18°C and -26°C.

DEFROSTING

- Defrost twice a year or when a frost layer of approximately 7 mm (1/4") has formed.
- 6 hours before the defrosting process, set the thermostat knob at the "8" position to make sure the food is at the lowest temperature before removing the frozen foods. All food should be wrapped in several layers of newspaper and stored in a cool place (e.g., fridge or larder).
- Switch off the appliance at the socket outlet and remove the mains plug from the socket.
- Remove the freezer basket and ensure the lid remains open. Containers of warm water (never hot) may be placed carefully in the freezer to speed up the defrosting process.
- Never use hairdryers, electrical heaters, or other electrical appliances for defrosting.
- When the ice has melted, drain the water in the bottom of the freezer by removing the plastic stopper in the bottom of the appliance (this is inside the appliance)
- **NOTE:** KEEP THE PLASTIC STOPPER SAFE DURING THE DEFROSTING PROCESS AND REPLACE AFTER THE DEFROSTING PROCESS IS COMPLETE
- A Drain cap is located on the front bottom left of the outside of the appliance. Place a container under the drain cap to catch the defrosted water. Unscrew the cap slowly so the drips out at first, once the cap is completely unscrewed the water will flow in to the container. This may take several attempts to drain all the water. After the draining has been completed, replace the cap in the appliance and rotate the drainage cap on the outside of the appliance.
- Wipe up any spillages that may have occurred.

Excess ice or frost has built up inside the appliance	• Check that the door has not been left open • Check that the door gasket is clean and undamaged
Smoke coming from appliance	• Immediately stop using the appliance • If possible, remove all contents and remove from location, and unplug • Immediately contact customer services

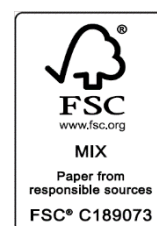
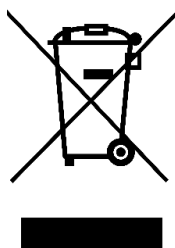
