

- · Do not stand or put weight on the product during assembly, this could cause damage.
- · Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

· We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- · Maximum safe seated weight: 220kgs.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- · Make sure each studs matches the corresponding figure to ensure correct assembly.
- From time to time check that there are no loose nuts on this chair.
- Assemble all parts and nuts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the nuts.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.



Assembly Instructions

Step1

Fit seat panel to back panel


Use stud (A), washer (B), and nut (C) to fix the seat panel (4) to back panel (2) by wrench.



Step 2

Fit left and Right panel to back panel

Use stud (A), washer (B), and nut (C) to fix the left panel (1) and right panel (3) to back panel (2) by wrench.




Assembly Instructions

Step3

Tighten all the nuts

Tighten all the nuts and turn the chair to its upright position




Important:

Step 4

Fit the cushion

Place the back pillow
