

Children are likely to play, bounce, jump and climb on beds, therefore the child's bed should not be placed too close to other furniture or windows, blind cords, curtain pulls or other strings or cords, and should be placed either tight to any wall or have a gap of 300mm between the wall and the side of the bed.

Always place the side of the bed with the safety rail against a wall.

Any additional or replacement parts should only be obtained from the manufacturer or distributor.

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers *for inserting screws*, as this could

damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

• Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

#### Care and maintenance


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.



### Step 1

Insert the dowels ① into the holes in bedsides ⑥ and back rail ⑧.

It may be necessary to tap the dowels in very gently with a small hammer.

Attach the lists 9 to the bedsides 6 using screws **9** and **0**.

#### Step 2


Attach the bedside 6 and back rail 8 to the endpanels 1 and 2 by placing the dowels into the holes in the end panels.

Insert barrel nuts into the holes in bedside and back rail. Attach endpanels and 2 using bolts . Note that the holes for the barrel nuts on the back rail should be facing out.

### Step 3

Attach the second bedside 6 to the endpanels 1 and 2 by placing the dowels into the holes in the end panels.

Insert barrel nuts **B** into the holes in bedside **6**. Attach endpanels **1** and **2** using bolts **A**.



### Step 4

Place two slats 5 in the ends of the bed, against the end panels. Fasten with four chipboard screws 6.


Place one slat 5 in the middle of the bed. Follow the measurements.


Push the bedsides 6 together whilst attaching middle slat 5 to the bed with two chipboard screws 6.

## Step 5

Position the remaining twelve slats 5 in the bed with an approximate distance of 66 mm between each.

Fasten each slat with two screws **G** 





## Step 6

Attach the list 10 to the trundle front 4 using screws **6**.

### Step 7


Attach the trundle front

4 and back 7 to the
distance pieces 3 using
screws 6.

Place felt pads • to the ends of the trundle back 7.

## Step 8

Attach castors to the distance pieces using screws **5**.




### Step 9

Position slats 5 in the bed with an approximate distance of 64 mm between each and 130mm from the edge of the distance piece 3.

Fasten each slat with two screws **G** 

Assembly is complete.



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
