15.19 You may experience false alarms for several reasons. The most common reason is the Camera has not been turned OFF after you have removed your baby from the cot. Another reason is the Sensor Pad has not been placed under the mattress properly. Be sure the Sensor Pad is on a fals, firm surface with the Angelcare logo pages to the padjuted. Neter to Step 5.1. Always be sure to immediately check on baby whenever an alarm sounds.

16. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS RELATED TO USE OF BATTERIES

16.1 Use ONLY the type and size of battery specified in the owner's manual. There is a risk of explosion if battery is replaced with an incorrect type.

16.2 Charge the <code>Dattery</code> for 9 hours prior to first use. Be sure to have the monitor in the <code>OFF</code> position during this period. ONLY use the adapters included with your monitor.

16.3 DO NOT use these adapters with any other equipments.

16.4 When unplugging the adapter from the Camera, be sure it is switched to the **OFF** position.

16.5 DO NOT dispose of batteries in fire. They may explode. Check with local regulations for possible special disposal instructions.

16.6 Exercise care in handling batteries in order not to short out the batteries with conducting materials such as rings, bracelets and keys. Overcharging, short circuiting, reverse charging, mutilation, or incineration of batteries must be avoided to prevent one or more of the following occurrences: release of toxic materials, release of hydrogen and/or oxygen, gas and rise in surface temperature.




STEP 1 - CHARGING THE PARENT UNIT (9 HOURS)



Rear View

- Unlock the battery compartment on the rear and remove the cover. Insert the provided rechargeable battery into the compartment. Contacts of the battery and the contacts in the compartment must be aligned.
- Connect the USB plug to the Parent Unit and connect the power adapter with an electrical outlet.
- 3) Charge the unit for 9 continuous hours prior to first use.


STEP 2 - POSITIONING THE MOVEMENT SENSOR PAD

2.1 - SELECT A LOCATION FOR THE CAMERA

Camera can be installed on the wall (see included parts) or using the tabletop stand. Depending on the position you choose, you'll need to remove the metal ball from the stand to wall mount Camera.


IMPORTANT

Place the cot near a supporting wall and far from air currents. Install the Camera on a flat, stable surface facing the cot at a distance of at least 1 metre. Make sure to plug the adapter to the socket outlet nearest to the equipment and that is easily accessible.




1) Insert jack 1 into the Sensor Pad and twist it clockwise to lock it.

2.2 - SELECT THE COT LEG TO SECURE THE CORD COVERS



Use the cot leg by the wall closest to the Camera (**Figure 1**). In cases where the Camera is across the room, use the leg closest to the Camera to position the covered wire (**Figure 2**). It is always preferable that the covered cord run along a wall.





2.3 - INSTALL THE SENSOR PAD ON THE MATTRESS SUPPORT

IMPORTANT


If your cot does not have a solid, stable surface for the Sensor Pad, you will need to place a support under it, to ensure correct operation of the system.






The Sensor Pad functions with any size and type of mattress except memory-foam mattresses, hollow frame mattresses and water beds. The hardboard maintains a constant pressure on the Sensor Pad, enabling it to detect the baby's movements even when the baby is at the edges of the cot.



- Remove the mattress from the cot.
- Place the Sensor Pad -Angelcare logo side up - on top of the hardboard.
- 3) Run the connection pin, warning label and the first 5 cord covers down along the backside of the cot leg, between the mattress support and the inside edge of the cot.




- 4) Bring the first 4 cord covers down the floor, and keep the 5th cord cover vertically, along the backside of the cot leg, between the mattress and the inside edge of the cot.
- 5) Remove any cord slack to make sure no parts of the cord are loose.
- **6)** Place the 6th cord cover approximately **8 cm** from the edge of the mattress support.



Snap together the remaining cord covers that will run along the floor.



- 8) Remove any cord slack to make sure no parts of the cord are loose.
- 9) Peel off the double-sided tape on the 4th cord cover and place it securely under the cot leg.
- 10) Check to make sure the Sensor Pad has not moved from position and place the mattress back inside the cot.








WARNING

- Remove all slack from Sensor Pad Cord.
- When lowering the mattress support as your child grows, slide the vertical Cord Cover downward so it remains approximately in the center between the mattress support and the floor. Slide the Sensor Pad Cord through the Floor Cover to eliminate any additional slack
- The Sensor Pad is not designed for use with adults, children or infants older than 24 months.
- Discontinue used of the Sensor Pad when baby is older than 24 months. Remove Sensor Pad from cot and store for future use.
- BEFORE FIRST TIME USE: To test that the unit is ready for use, refer to instruction manual on how to test that the installation has been done correctly.


STEP 3 - SETTING UP THE CAMERA



- Connect the USB plug to the Camera.
- 2) Connect the USB plug with the power adapter and then with an electrical outlet.
- **3)** Adjust the Camera using the magnetic mount to get the best view of baby in the cot.

Note: Each time you power **ON** your Camera, the internal thermometer will need to calibrate to ensure accuracy. This automatic process will take approximately 30 minutes. The colour changing temperature display, by default, will be turned "**OFF**". You may turn this feature "**ON**" in the settings mode on your Parent Unit.

STEP 4 - TURNING ON YOUR MONITOR


Your Camera and Parent Unit come pre-paired.



1) Slide the Camera ON/OFF switch to the ON position.

 Press and hold the Parent Unit ON/OFF button for 2 seconds until LCD screen is turned ON. Angelcare's logo will be shown for 1 second.



The Camera connection signal strength icon will appear in the status bar.




When Parent Unit is turned **ON** and Camera is **OFF**, Parent Unit will display **Out-of-Range** icon.



If there is a lost connection between the two units after 15 seconds, the **Out-of-Range** alarm will sound on the Parent Unit (refer to **Troubleshooting** section):


• The Out-of-Range icon will appear on the screen and on the info bar.


4.1 - HOW TO SET THE DATE

When activating the Parent Unit for the first time, you'll be asked to set the date and time in order to record movement & temperature data. If you choose to skip this step, you can always go back later by accessing the settings menu \$.



- 1) Press **OK** to switch between Month/Day/Year and Day/Month/Year display.
- 2) Press the **down arrow** ∇ once and then **OK** to set the date.
- Set the day with the up/down arrows △∇ and confirm with OK. Do the same for the month and year and confirm with OK.
- **4)** Press the **down arrow** ∇, the **Save** icon at the bottom is highlighted in blue then Press the **OK** button to save the settings.

4.2 - HOW TO SET THE TIME



- 1) Press **OK** to switch between 12 h and 24 h mode.
- 2) Press the **down arrow** ∇ once and then **OK** to set the time.
- Set the hours with the up/down arrows △∇ and confirm with OK. Do the same for the minutes and am/ pm display and confirm with OK.
- Press the down arrow ∇, the Save icon at the bottom is highlighted in blue then Press the OK button to save the settings.





IMPORTANT

The Sensor Pad will be automatically **ACTIVATED** when the screen returns to video display view. If no movement is detected on the surface of the Sensor Pad after 20 seconds, a series of loud beeps will emit from the Parent Unit & Camera - this is the movement alarm. When activating any functions on your monitor, to prevent this alarm either:

- 1) Gently tap the surface of the pad
- 2) De-activate the movement function, see below for information

STEP 5 - GETTING TO KNOW YOUR MONITOR

TOUCH CONTROL KEYS



Access to the different operation settings



Exit or to go back to main menu when in sub-menu



Navigate the different functions



Confirm a selection or setting and allows you to access to a guick menu



IMPORTANT

When in menu or sub-menu modes, sound transmission between the Parent Unit and the Camera will be temporarily deactivated. ONLY movement-detection alarm will remain active (if function is activated).

5.1 - SENSOR PAD

TO ACTIVATE/DEACTIVATE THE SENSOR PAD:



- In the Sensor Pad settings, press the OK button to activate/deactivate the Sensor Pad (when activated the toggle will turn blue).
- 2) Press the down arrow

 till the Save icon at the bottom will be highlighted in blue then Press the OK button to save the settings.

TO TEST THE SENSOR PAD:

IMPORTANT

- Test your monitor before first use.
- Test your monitor regularly to ensure it is functioning correctly.
- Test your monitor every time you move the Sensor Pad to a different place.







- 1) After activating the Sensor Pad, the alarm will sound after 20 seconds.
- Rub you hand over the mattress to confirm the alarm stops.

MOVEMENT ALARM

- If NO movement is detected after 15 seconds you will hear a single 'TIC' pre-alarm sound from the Camera.
- If after a further 5 seconds there is still NO movement detected both the Parent Unit and Camera speakers will emit loud continous beeps. - this is the movement alarm.




Movement Alarm icon will show on the LCD screen.

IF THE ALARM DOES NOT SOUND

- Avoid contact with the cot while Sensor Pad is in operation.
- Place the cot near a supporting wall to reduce vibrations.
- · Adjust the Sensor Pad sensitivity level.
- Turn OFF cot mobile, fans, loud music or anything else that may cause vibration.

PAUSING AND RESTARTING THE SENSOR PAD:

Allows you to pause the Sensor Pad if you remove baby from the cot, e.g. for feeding or comforting.







IMPORTANT

- If you do not pause the Sensor Pad, the alarm will sound if there is no movement after 20 seconds/if baby is removed from the cot.
- Ensure to unpause the Sensor Pad before putting baby in the cot.

TO ACTIVATE/DEACTIVATE TIC FUNCTION:

Allows you to detect baby's movements as well as hear a TIC sound.



- 1) In the Sensor Pad settings, press the **OK** button to activate/deactivate the Tic function (when activated the toggle will turn blue).
- 2) Press the **down arrow** ✓ until the **Save** icon at the bottom is highlighted in blue then Press the **OK** button to save the settings.

TO ADJUST THE SENSOR PAD SENSITIVITY LEVEL:

To ensure adequate monitoring of your child's movements, you can adjust the sensitivity of the Sensor Pad in the main settings menu. Set a high sensitivity for a newborn and a lower sensitivity as the child grows and gains weight. A thicker mattress will also need a higher sensitivity.



- In the Sensor Pad settings, select the Sensor Pad sensitivity bar.
- Use the up/down arrows △∇ to adjust the sensitivity level and confirm by pressing OK.
- 3) Press down arrow

 until the Save icon at the bottom is highlighted in blue then Press the OK button to save the settings.







5.2 - **SOUND**

TO ADJUST/MUTE SOUND:



Press the **Volume up / Volume down** button
to adjust the sound
level.



To mute the sound level press the **Volume down** button until the mute symbol is displayed.

5.3 - BATTERY

HOW TO CHECK THE BATTERY:

Unplug the adapter from the Parent Unit and check the battery level indicator.

HOW TO CHARGE THE BATTERY IN THE PARENT UNIT:

Leave the Parent Unit plugged in to fully charge the unit. Although the battery at 1/4 capacity works normally, we recommend that you fully recharge it.

- · Alert activates when the battery needs to be recharged.
- · Parent Unit will emit a beep sound every 30 seconds.
- Battery Alert icon will show on LCD screen.

STEP 6 - ACTIVATING AND DEACTIVATING ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS

6.1 - TWO WAY TALK

Your Parent Unit is equipped with **Two Way Talk.** This feature allows you to talk to baby without being in the nursery.

TO ACTIVATE TWO WAY TALK:



Press the ${\bf Microphone}$ button ${\bf Q}$ to activate/deactivate the ${\bf Two~Way~Talk.}$



The Microphone icon appears in the Screen when the microphone is active.

6.2 - VOICE ACTIVATION (VOX) OR CONTINUOUS SOUND MODE

Allows you to select your option on how your monitor sound. Your monitor is preset to 'Sound Activated' (VOX ON). This means that it will transmit sounds only when it detects them, based on the setting of the sensitivity level. To save power, after 10 seconds, the sound transmission will stop if no sound is detected. Once sound is detected transmission will automatically activate.

Or, you can switch to 'Continuous Sound' (VOX OFF). The sound monitoring is continuously **ON**, picking up all sounds.

NOTE:

By deactivating VOX, Continuous Sound setting will turn ON.

TO ACTIVATE/DEACTIVATE VOX:



- In the Camera settings, press the down arrow

 to the VOX toggle and press OK to activate/deactivate the VOX function.
- 2) Press the **down arrow** ∇ until the **Save** icon at the bottom is highlighted in blue then Press the **OK** button to save the settings.

TO ADJUST THE CAMERA SPEAKER VOLUME:



- In the Camera settings, adjust the Camera speaker volume level with the up/down arrows △∇ and confirm by pressing OK.
- 2) Press the **down arrow** ✓ until the **Save** icon at the bottom is highlighted in blue then Press the **OK** button to save the settings.

TO ADJUST THE SOUND SENSITIVITY (VOX):



- In the Camera settings, adjust the microphone sensitivity level with the up/down arrows △
 and confirm by pressing OK.





6.3 - ROOM TEMPERATURE DISPLAY

TO ACTIVATE THE ROOM TEMPERATURE ALERT:



 In the temperature settings menu, select the alarm settings by pressing OK.



- 2) Press OK to switch the temperature alarm ON/OFF.
- 3) Press the down arrow

 until the Save icon at the bottom is highlighted in blue then Press the OK button to save the settings.

TO SET THE ROOM TEMPERATURE RANGE:



 In the temperature settings menu, select the alarm settings by pressing OK.



- Set the lower temperature limit with the up/down arrows △∇ and confirm with OK. Do the same for the upper limit and confirm with OK.
- Press the down arrow ∇, the Save icon at the bottom is highlighted in blue then Press the OK button to save the settings.

TO ACTIVATE/DEACTIVATE THE CAMERA TEMPERATURE DISPLAY AND COLOR CHANGING MODE:


