Raffaele's gesture went down very well and the Margherita now exists as one of the most-loved traditional Italian pizzas worldwide. Prezzo's twist on the classic combines creamy mozzarella with fresh tomatoes and basil to create an unmistakable appearance and blend of flavour. If you'd like a bit more bite to your base, the Tre Gusti pizza is made up of the delicious combination of pepperoni, seasoned chicken, pancetta, rosemary, mozzarella and tomato.

Meanwhile, pasta is a versatile yet magnificent staple ingredient in many Italian dishes. The passionate relationship between Italy and pasta spans across many centuries and even journeyed over waters to reach the household status it holds today.

A descendent of the ancient Chinese noodle, pasta is thought to have been introduced into Italian culture by the explorer Marco Polo way back in the 13th century. Although once reserved for the banquets of the Italian elite, pasta's versatility, affordability and ability to be stored easily has resulted in the many forms of pasta becoming an essential staple in millions of pantries. With over 350 different types of pasta across the globe, one of the most iconic forms is of course, spaghetti.

Rising to fame following the classic scene between the Lady and the Tramp in 1955, spaghetti has been associated with romantic, moonlit meals ever since. Prezzo offer two delicious dishes featuring pasta in this renowned form; the Spaghetti Carbonara and Spaghetti King Prawn. While the hearty classic Spaghetti Carbonara serves pancetta and crispy prosciutto in a carbonara sauce with parsley, the Spaghetti King Prawn combines fresh seafood with spinach, red onion, red chilli and garlic, presented with a pomodoro sauce.
