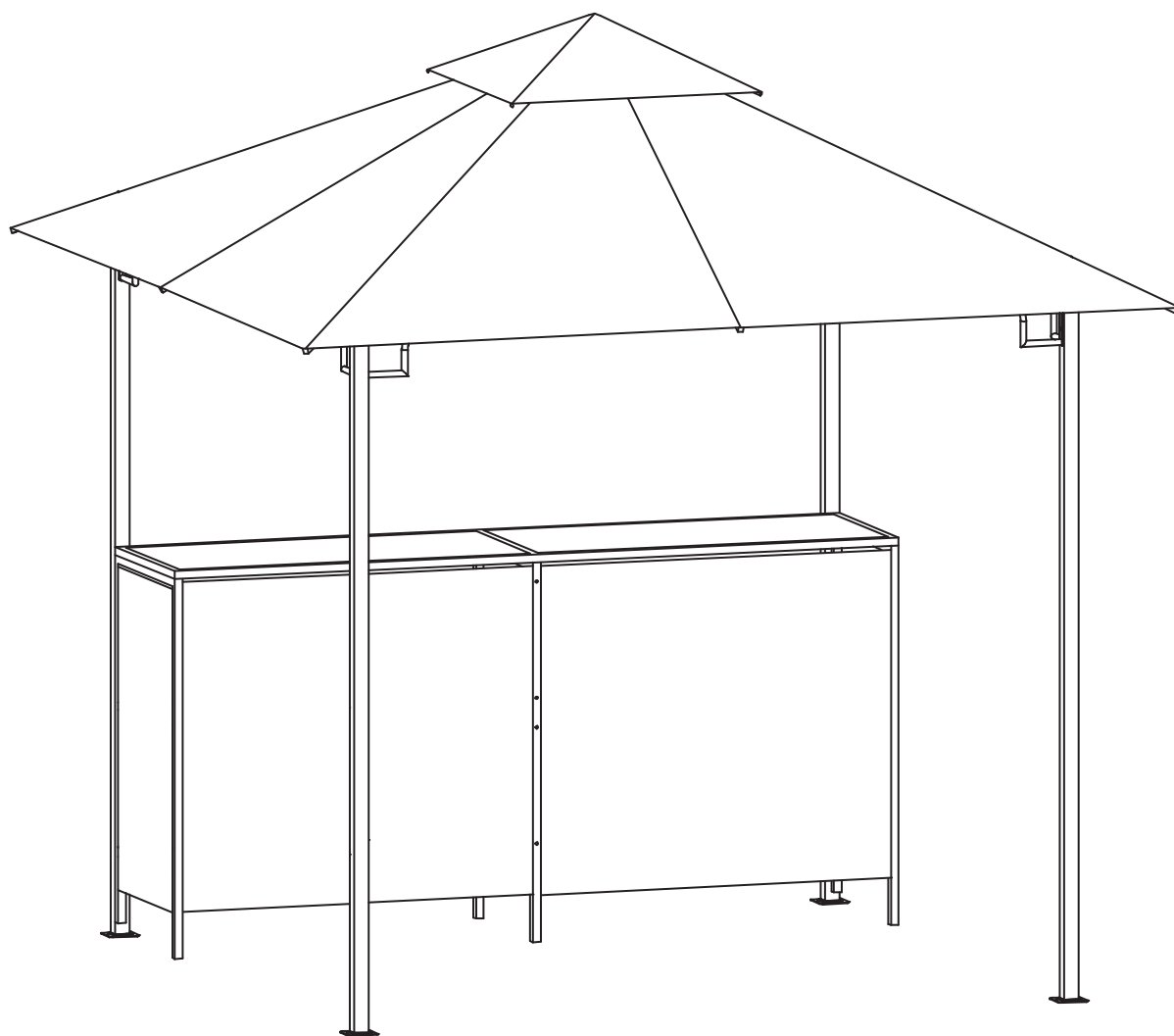

# IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

**Read all instruction before using and keep for future reference**

- Read these instructions carefully and familiarise yourself with the procedure before assembling the unit.
- Check that you have all the component parts following the list on the page 3 and familiarise yourself with each part before proceeding.
- Take all the fittings out of the plastic bag and separate them into their groups.
- Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly.
- To avoid scratching it is recommended that you assemble the unit on a soft level surface.
- Please keep children away when assembly. Please keep children under direct supervision of adult when using.
- **Please do not use the gazebo under windy condition.**
- Always use the pegs to secure the gazebo when using.
- This Gazebo is not a permanent structure and should be disassembled and stored away after using.
- Do not repack your Gazebo until completely dry.
- We recommend assembly by four persons under light or no wind conditions.
- This Gazebo must not be left erect in windy conditions.
- Keep the Gazebo Fabric away from screws, nails, staples, hooks, etc to avoid damage to the fabric and frame.
- **Warning:** The unit weight approximately 61 kgs.
- **Please lift with care.**

## CAUTION

### Recommend Caution

- **To prolong the life of** the fabric/canopy, we recommend to dismantle it and store it indoors over the winter months.
- **Each shelf can bear 45kg** maximumly. Please do not put more than this weight on the shelf.
- **This gazebo should be** secured to the ground at all times. If positioned on grass then tent pegs can be used. If positioned on concrete, then bolts should be used.
- This product contains toughened safety glass. In the unlikely event that the glass fails it will break into a large number of small fragments that may be spread over a wide area.

### Safety

- To avoid any risks of suffocation to animals or children dispose of the plastic bags immediately.

- Do not strike the glass with hand or pointed items.
- Do not sit or stand on the glass surface, as this would be hazardous.





















### Cleaning





# Assembly Instructions

## Step 1

### Assembling Gazebo Leg and Support Poles

**a:** connect the support pole **4** to leg pole **1** with screws **A**

**Note:** suggest to complete this product assembly by 2 persons



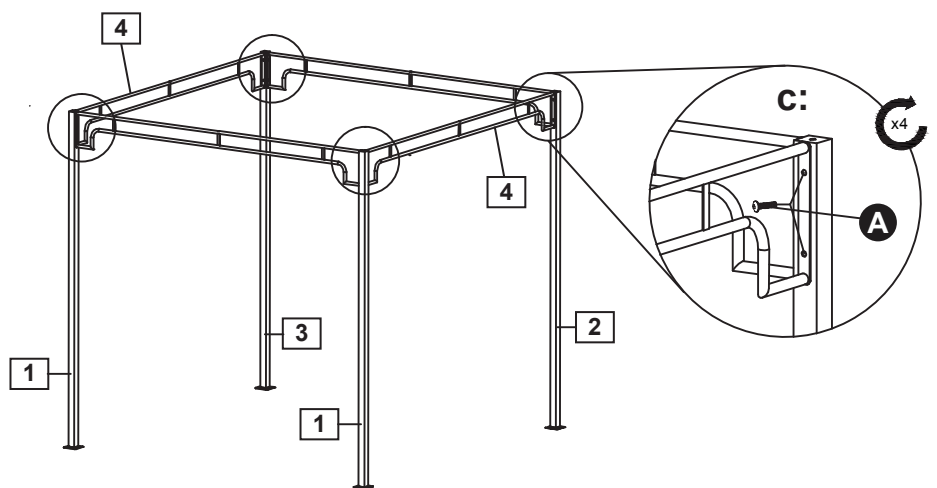
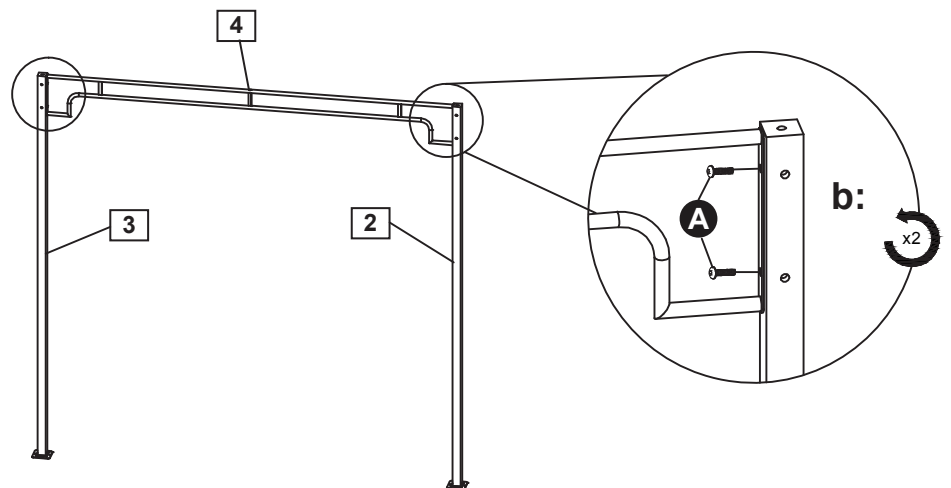
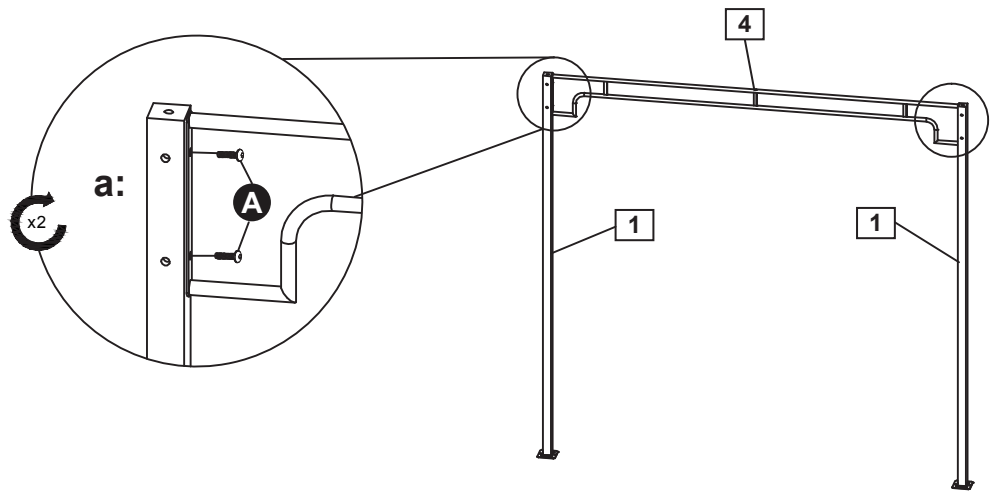
**Important note:**

Because of the size of this unit we recommend that it is built in the place intended for using.

Ensure to locate the unite on the flat ground free from obstruction, in a sheltered area away from wind and heavy rain as this will damage the unit.

**b:** repeat this step for leg pole **2** and leg pole **3**.

**c:** use support pole **4** to connect two assembled units by screws **A**.

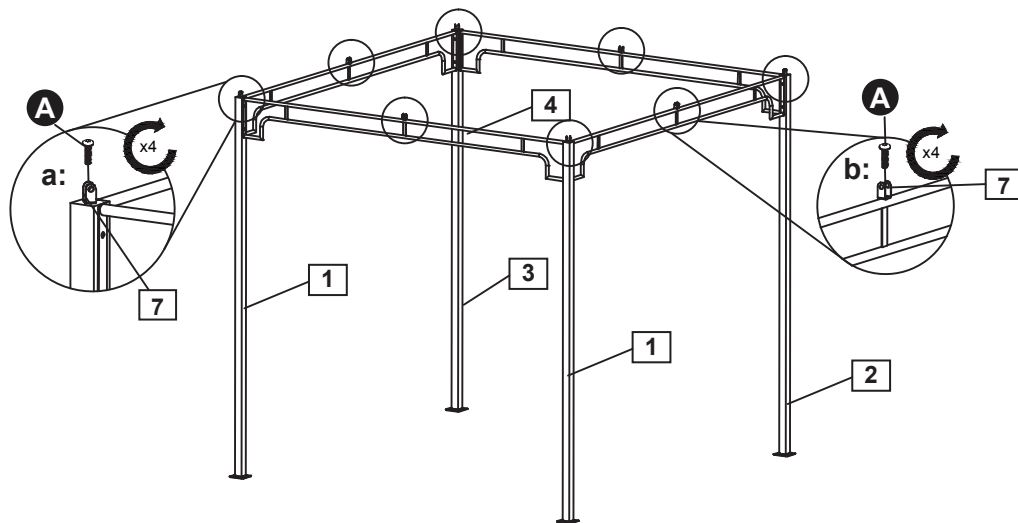
## Step 2

### Assembling Metal Connector onto the gazebo frame

**a:** After fixing leg poles assemble metal connector **7** onto leg poles **1** **2** **3** with screws **A**.

At this step please keep metal connector **7** 45 degrees with the line of support poles **4**

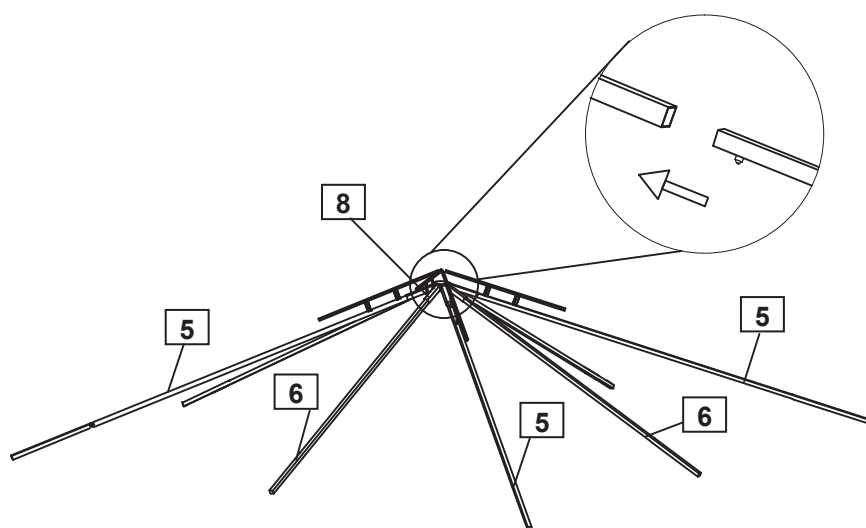
**b:** Fix metal connectors **7** onto the support poles **4** with screws **A**



## Step 3

### Assembling top poles

insert top poles **5** & **6** into center connector **8**



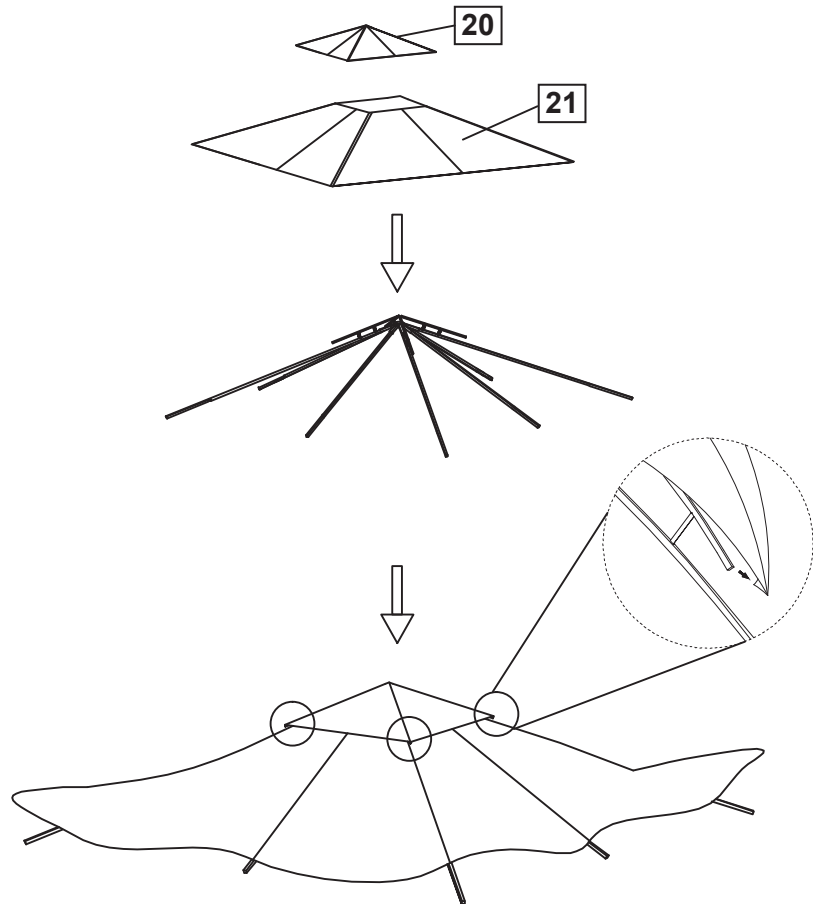

## Step 4

### Assembling gazebo covers

Carefully place the upper gazebo cover **20** and the main cover **21** over the assembled top poles. Then fix the upper gazebo gazebo cover tightly over the assembled roof frame. But at this step please do not fix the main gazebo cover tightly.

**Note:** It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this step.



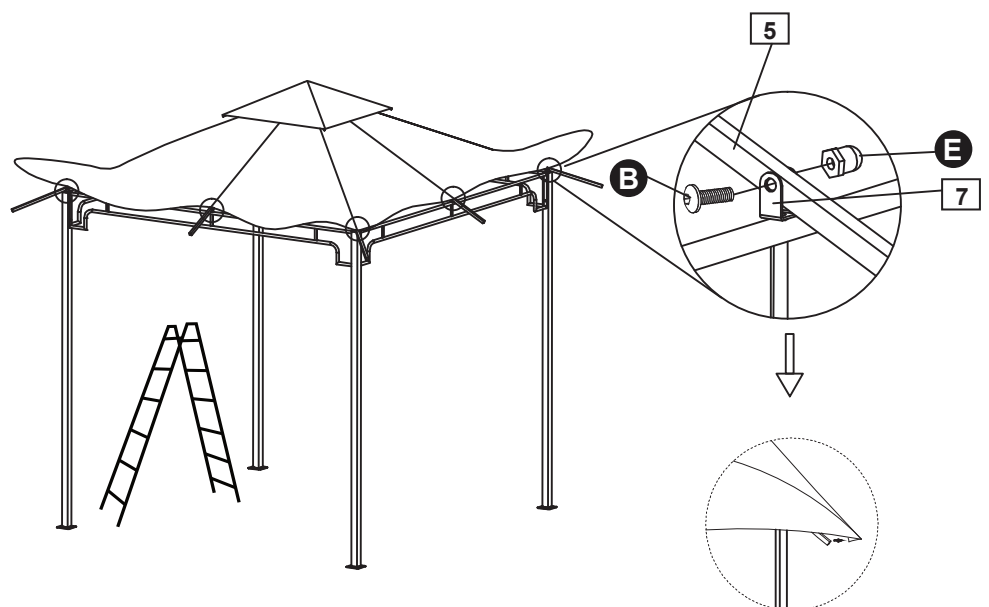
## Step 5

### Assembling top poles onto the leg

Assemble the connected top poles **5** and **6** onto the frame by connecting them and metal connector **7** with screws **B** and screw caps **E**.

Then fix the main gazebo gazebo cover tightly over the assembled roof frame.

**Note:** a ladder is suggested to be used in this step

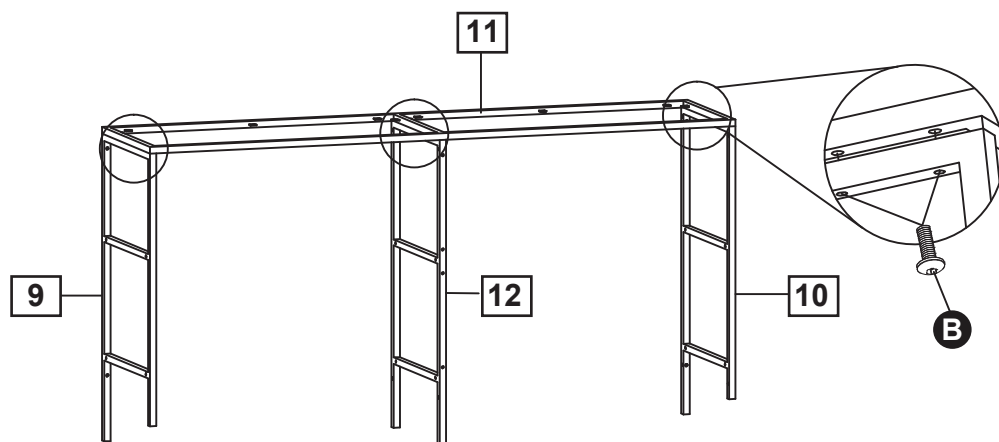
## Step 6

### Assembling bar table Fix table legs

Fix table legs **9** **12** and **10** onto table top frame **11** with screws **B**.



**Important:**  
Do not fully tighten all screws until assembly is complete.

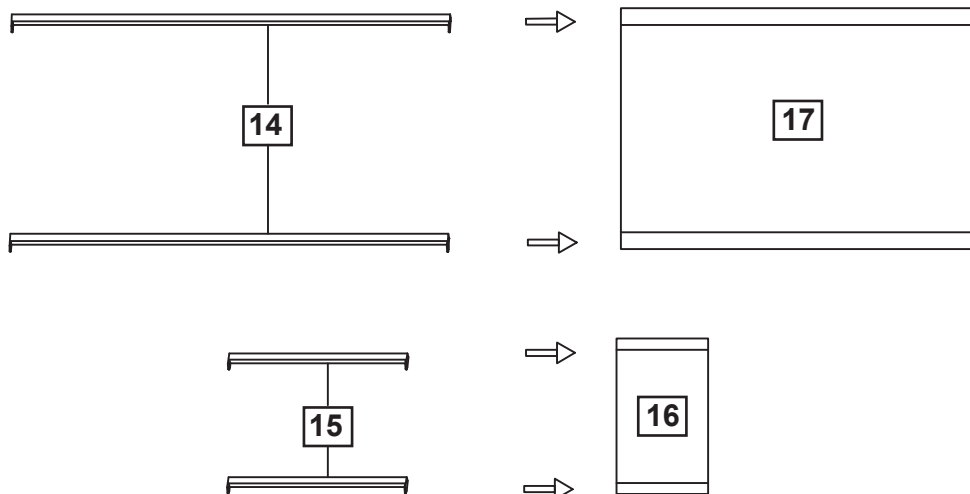


## Step 7

### Assembling panels

Insert sling tube **14** into panels **17**.

Insert sling tube **15** into panels **16**.



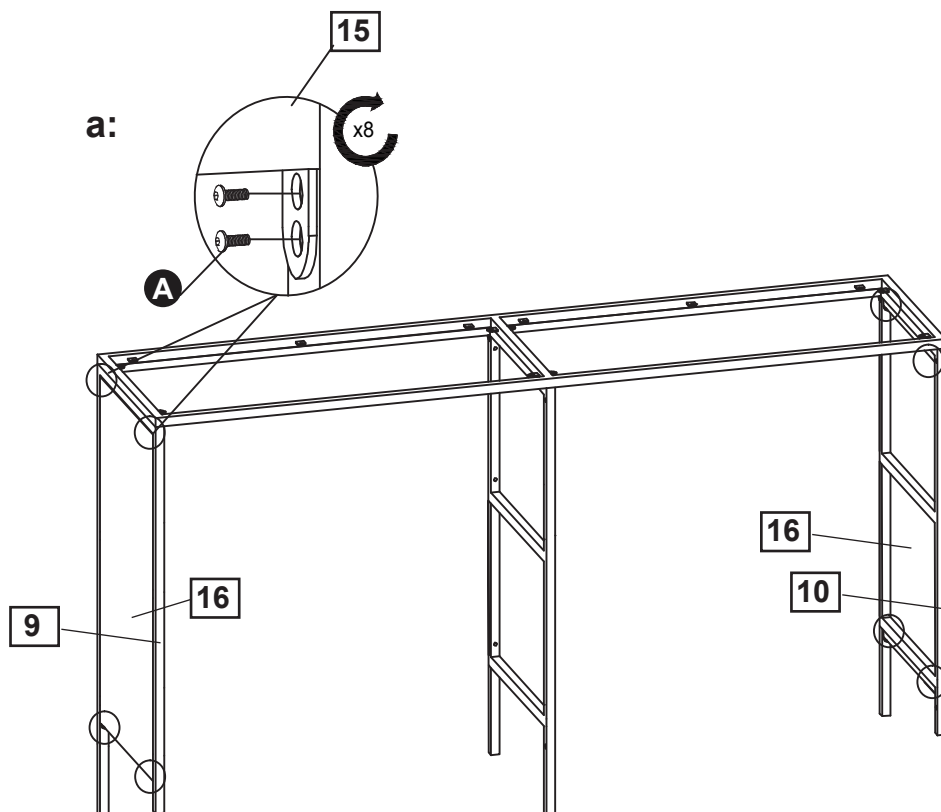

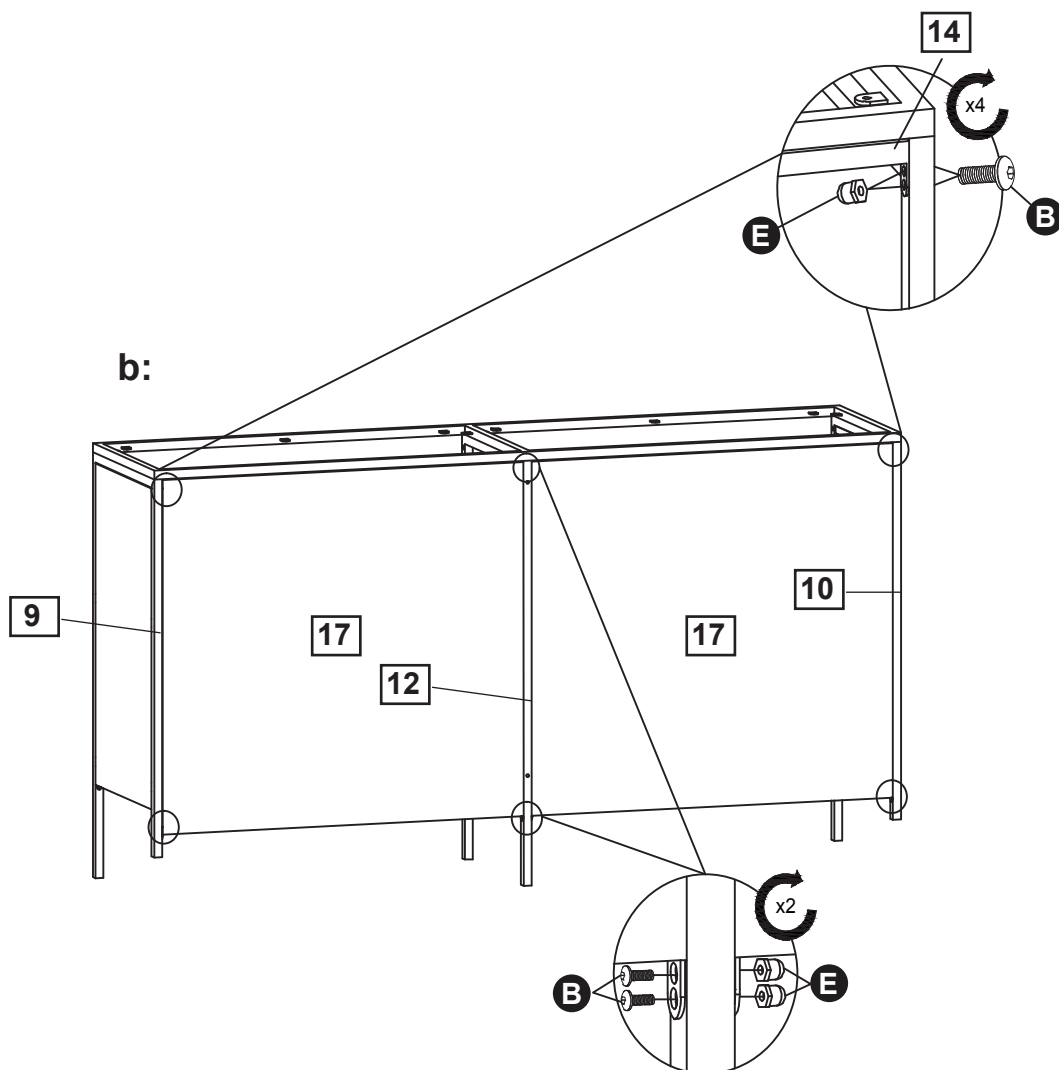
## Step 8

### Assembling table sling tubes into the table frame

**a:** connect the panels **16** to table legs **9** and **10** with screws **A**.



**b:** connect the panels **17** to table legs **9**, **10** and **12** with screws **B**.



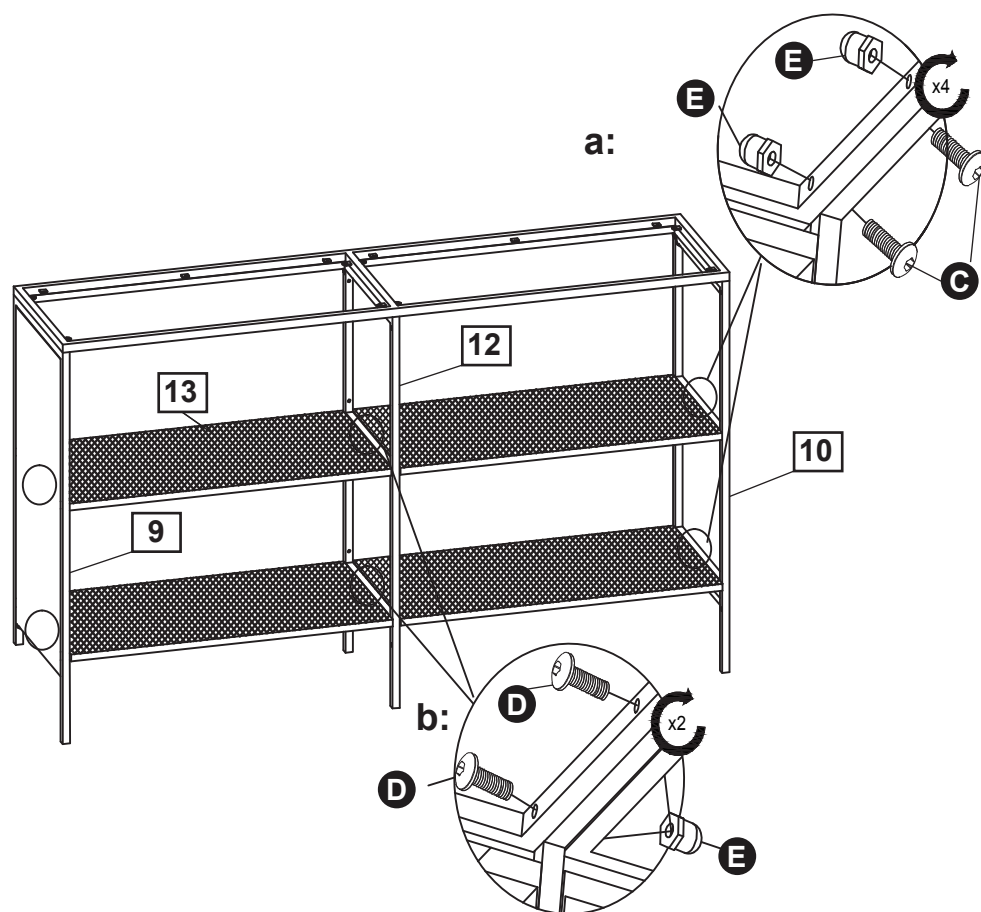

## Step 9

### Assembling shelves onto the table legs

**a:** connect the shelves **13** onto the table legs **9** and **10** with screws **C** and screw caps **E**

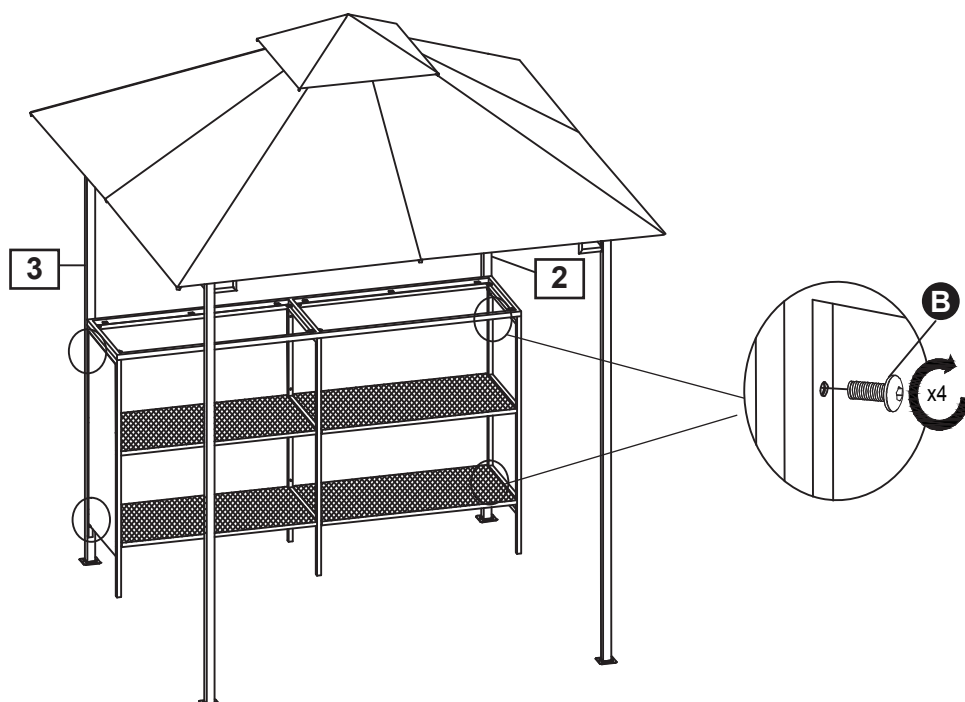
**b:** connect the shelves **13** onto the table legs **12** with screws **D** and screw caps **E**



## Step 10

### Connect the table and the gazebo leg poles

Fix the table legs **9** and **10** onto the gazebo poles **2** and **3** with screws **B**



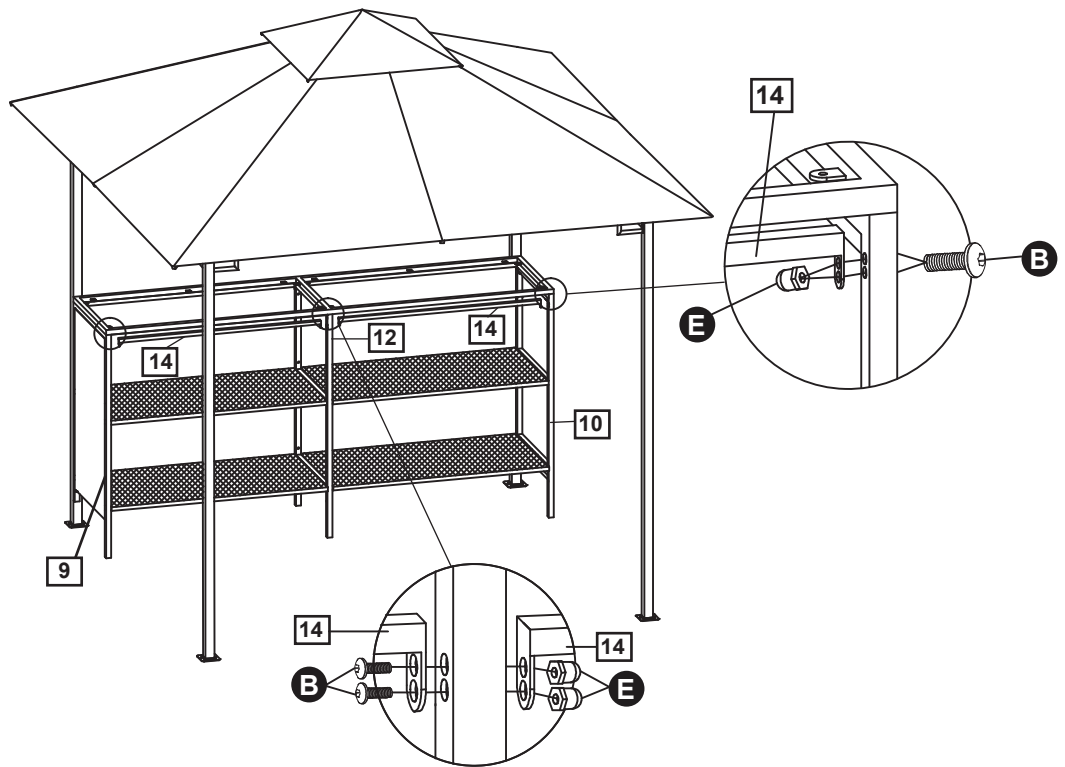

## Step 11

### Fixing the sling tubes to the table legs (the side w/o panels)

Fix the sling tube **14** to the table legs **9** and **12** with screws **B** and screw caps **E**.

Fix the sling tube **14** to the table legs **12** and **10** with screws **B** and screw caps **E**.



## Step 12

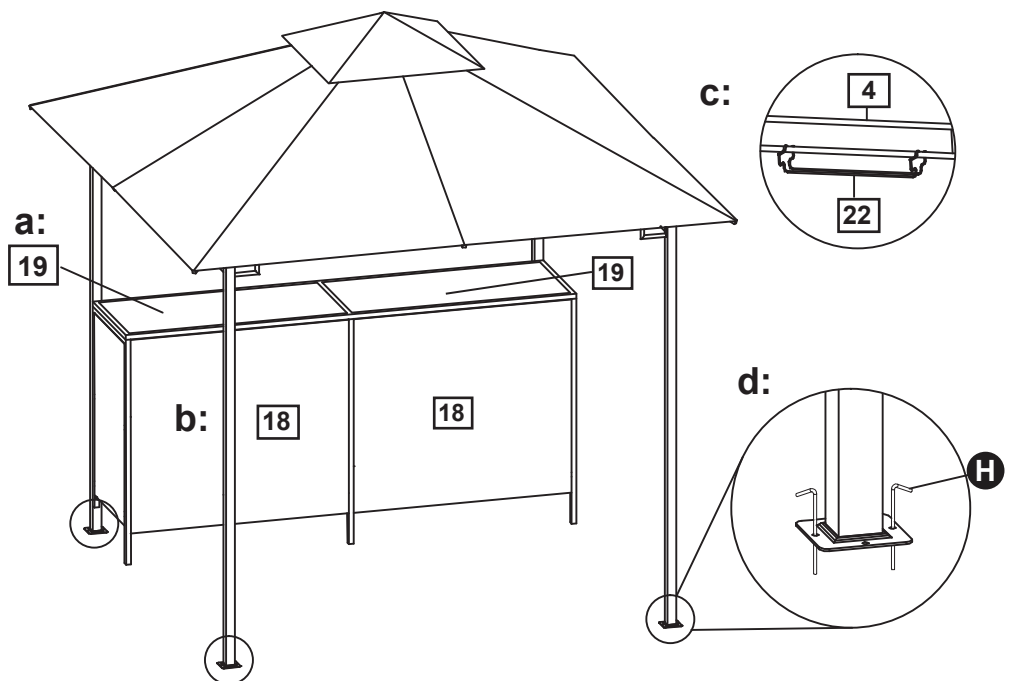
**a:** put the table glass **19** on the table top frame **11**

**b:** hang the panels **18** on the table frame

**c:** hang the wine glass rack **22** on the support pole **4**

**d:** if the product is positioned on grass, please fix it using pegs **H**

**Assembly is complete.**
