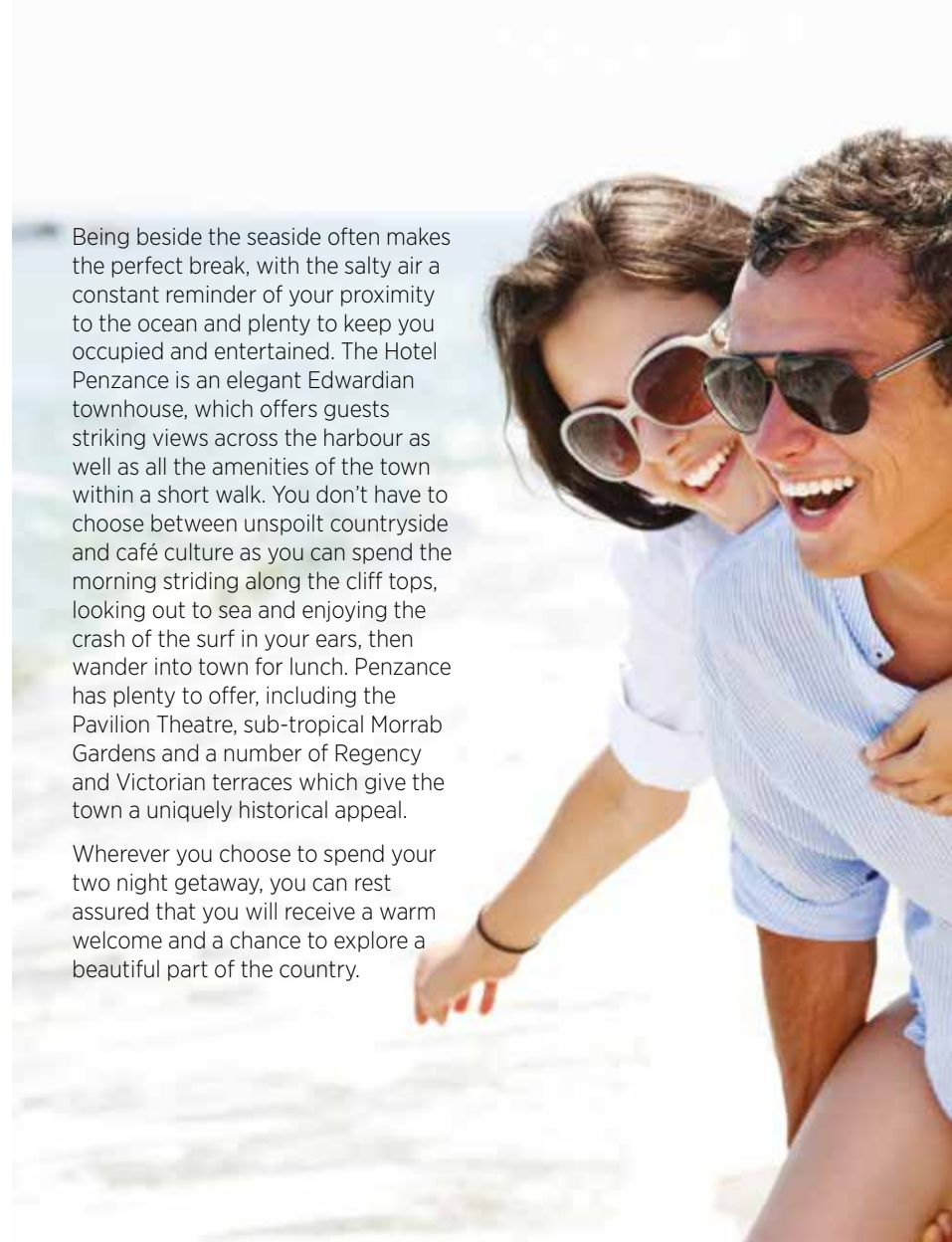

Voucher validity

You must validate, book and complete your Experience prior to the expiry date, please note booking lead times apply. The original retailer's gift or till receipt is required to validate your Voucher. If you are unable to use your Voucher within the validity period, the Voucher can be extended for a period of six months. A £20 administration fee is payable if you choose to extend your voucher. Choosing your Experience

We reserve the right to discontinue an Experience, venue, or individual supplier at our own discretion. We will endeavour to offer a suitable alternative Experience of the same value, however, if not we will refund your Voucher in full.
