Which track will you choose?

Since the early days of motoring, there has been sheer ambition spurring designers and manufacturers on to make their cars faster, smoother and sleeker than their competitors. 1886 saw the birth of the car, shortly followed by the first organised race in 1887, so it's hardly surprising that modern car design is focused on a vehicle's speed and handling. To really feel the power of the modern motor, driving on a dedicated track is the best way to put an engine through its paces. Have a browse of some of the tracks this experience offers and choose the best one for you.

Today, airfields are still popular places to explore the limits of a vehicle's engine, often with long straights and open spaces which allow the driver to really feel how much power they have under their control. Blyton Park in Lincolnshire is a prime example of how Second World War stations can continue their working lives as race tracks for some of the most thrilling drives in the country. With a versatile and exciting circuit which has plenty of room to allow you to push any car to its limits, Blyton Park has arching curves and long straights which mean that you can really put the car through its paces and test your nerve.

Meanwhile, the circuit in Cranleigh offers a track layout which has been designed to put the car through various conditions, having a fantastic range of low and high speed corners combined with a series of straights that will allow you to enjoy a modern day supercar.

Elvington is another track which was once an airfield, but in its current incarnation it was the scene for an attempt at the land speed record in 2000 which saw the Vampire Dragster reach 300.3mph. The track is also used for land sailing, where participants regularly reach speeds of 50-60mph.

As the fastest banked oval circuit in Europe, Rockingham has seen some truly tremendous speeds achieved on its track, including an average 215mph achieved by Tony Kanaan in 2001. Many British Formula 3 championships have been settled on the track as well as British Touring Car Championships and British Superbike Championships. The track has also been used for filming a variety of different television shows and is the regular home to a host of different car shows too.

Another one of motor racing circuits appealing factors is that they are often situated in relatively rural locations, meaning you are often treated to the sight of beautiful countryside flashing past as you pick up speed. Whichever car or location you choose, you're sure to be left with a real taste of life in the fast lane and an adrenaline rush only known to track superstars.

Terms & Conditions

Activity Superstore issues face value vouchers ("Vouchers") entitling the holder to choose, up to the value stated on or in the Voucher, one of a range of activities, overnight breaks ("Experiences") or other products supplied by Activity Superstore and provided by selected experience providers. Voucher validity

Choosing your Experience

This pack is for a Voucher that entitles the holder to any¹ of the Experiences supplied by Activity Superstore, up to the value stated, including the Experience/Experiences featured either on the outside of the pack, or in the literature accompanying your pack. Please note once a date has been booked with an Experience provider your Voucher is no longer available for an exchange, extension or refund and will be deemed to be used at that point.

Exchanging your Voucher

A Voucher can be exchanged only once for another Voucher(s), up to the face value stated on or in it and subject to certain restrictions¹, without incurring a fee. A difference will be payable if the chosen Experience costs more than the face value of your original Voucher and the value of your Voucher will be increased. If your chosen Experience is cheaper, we will hold the difference as a credit against another Experience. The credit cannot be used to pay for the cost of an extension or an exchange. All credits held will have the same expiry date as the original purchased Voucher. The exchanged Voucher will carry the same expiry date as the original purchased Voucher. Bookings

In order to enjoy your chosen Experience, you are asked to choose your preferred location then follow the booking instructions. Cancelling or changing your Experience

If we cancel your Experience, we will tell you as soon as possible, and do our very best to offer an alternative date or location. If specific celebrities, vehicles or venues are featured but are not available on the day for reasons beyond our control, we will try to find the best possible replacement. If this is not possible, we reserve the right to cancel your Experience at short notice and re-book you. We reserve the right to reschedule the timings or location of any Experience owing to unavailability of the Experience, insufficient numbers making the Experience unavailable, and other factors beyond our control. We reserve the right to discontinue an Experience, venue, or individual supplier at our own discretion. We will endeavour to offer a suitable alternative Experience of the same value, however, if not we will refund your Voucher in full. If you decide to book a different Experience and the price of that Experience exceeds the face value of your Voucher, you will need to pay the difference. We also reserve the right to make minor changes to your Experience. Examples of minor changes include car specification or order of Experiences on a particular day. If you need to cancel or change your Experience booking you should contact us immediately. We will do our best to fill the allocated space, but if we are unable to do so, you may lose your booking. You will be advised by Activity Superstore if you can rebook through the cancellation cover. If you need to cancel your Experience because of accidental injury/illness to yourself, or a death in your immediate family you should contact Activity Superstore as it may be possible to re-arrange your Experience on presentation of a medical certificate.

Returns

Standard retailer refund policies apply. Nevertheless returns and exchanges are not available if you have validated your Voucher; the Voucher is not contained within the gift pack; you have extended your Voucher; used or booked your Voucher; if the date of the request is after the Voucher expiry date; or if the pack is not in a re-saleable condition. No interest will be paid on the amount to be refunded.

Insurance

Description and photography

Weather
