## Important - Please read these instructions fully before installing or operating

#### INSTALLATION WARNINGS

**IMPORTANT:** This product MUST be installed by a qualified installer in accordance with local regulations.

**IMPORTANT:** Prior to Installation ensure that the local supply conditions (electricity voltage and frequency) are compatible with the requirements of your cooker hood.

**IMPORTANT:** Carefully unpack and examine the appliance for any damage. If you think there is a defect, do not use the appliance and contact Bush Product Support on 01759 487838. Packaging materials should be collected together and disposed of immediately as they may be harmful to children.

**IMPORTANT:** Ensure that the electric supply cable is not trapped or damaged during installation.

**IMPORTANT:** Protect your cooker hood against atmospheric effects. Do not expose your cooker hood to effects such as sun, rain, snow etc.

**WARNING:** The cooker hood must be mounted on the wall in accordance with the dimensions specified in the mounting diagrams.

#### **DURING USAGE**

**IMPORTANT:** Always replace the aluminium filter of the cooker hood with an original spare part otherwise the suction power may be reduced in addition to the reduction of service life.

**WARNING:** The LED lamps become hot during use, do not touch the surface.

**WARNING:** Disconnect the mains power before changing bulbs.

**CAUTION:** This cooker hood must be kept clean. Oil or residue build up could be a fire hazard.

### **Mounting Instructions**


#### Preparing the installation Caution!

Ensure that there are no electric wires, gas or water pipes in the area where holes are to be made.


Mark a vertical centre line on the wall from the ceiling to the lower edge of the cooker hood.

Mark positions for the screws based on the illustration below.


• Drill five 8 mm diameter holes to a depth of 50 mm for the attachments, and press in the wall plugs (refer to accessories on page 9, part 2) flush with the wall.



• Using 2 screws and 2 washers, mount the fixing bracket for the flue duct where the top of the wall meets the ceiling. (refer to accessories on page 9, parts 3, 4 and parts 6).



• Using 2 screws mount the fixing knobs for the cooker hood loosely. Do not firmly tighten the screws. (refer to accessories on page 9, part 3).







## Bringing it all together

#### Attaching and aligning the appliance.

• Using 4 screws, install the fixing mount to the cooker hood. nsure the screws are firmly tightened. (refer to accessories on page 9, parts 5 and part 7).




• Place the appliance onto the mounting knobs as illustrated below. You can slightly adjust the appliance location horizontally by moving it right or left until it is centered into the desired location.



• Now that the appliance is in position, firmly tighten the screws on the fixing knobs.

• Use a screw and washer (refer to accessories on page 9, parts 3 and 4) to install the centre screw through the fixing mount as illustrated below.

For the various installations use screws and screw anchors suited to the type of wall (e.g. reinforced concrete, plasterboard, etc.). If the screws and screw anchors are provided with the product, kindly check the screws are suitable for the type of wall in which the hood is to be fixed.

#### Fixing the Flue

Arrange the electrical power supply within the dimensions of the flue. If your cooker hood is to be ducted, you will need to engage with a qualified installer. Flexible ducting is not supplied.

This cooker hood can be used without access to outside filtration. Charcoal filters (not supplied) can be fitted to the side of the fan motor. Charcoal filters can be purchased through BUSH product support. (Further instructions provided on page 19). These filters are designed to purify the air and stop the odours and cooking vapors from being expelled into the kitchen.

Place the flue on top of the cooker hood and then slide the inner piece of the flue upwards until it is over the mounting bracket. Use 2 small screws to fix the flue to the mounting bracket. (refer to accessories on page 9, part 5).

## Using your Cooker Hood

Getting the most from your appliance

#### USE AND MAINTENANCE

It is recommended to operate the appliance prior to cooking.

It is recommended to leave the appliance in operation for 15 minutes after cooking is terminated in order to completely eliminate cooking vapors and odours.

The proper function of the cooker hood is conditioned by the regularity of the maintenance operations, in particular, the charcoal filters (not included). The anti-grease filter captures the grease particles suspended in the air, and are therefore subject to build up of oil and grease depending on how frequently the appliance is used.

In order to prevent fire hazard, it is recommendable to clean the filter every 2 months by carrying out the following instructions:

Remove the filter from the cooker hood and wash it in a solution of water and neutral liquid detergent, leaving to soak.

Rinse thoroughly with warm water and leave to dry.

The filter may also be washed in the dishwasher.

Please take note that the aluminum panels may alter in color after several washes.

If the cooker hood is operating in recirculation mode, (without ducting to the outside air) then charcoal filters must be purchased and regularly replaced.

They are not washable or reusable and it is recommended that they are replaced every 4 months.

The saturation of the active charcoal filters depends on the frequency of use of the appliance, and also by the type of cooking and the regularity of cleaning of the anti-grease filters.

To remove the charcoal filters place your hand on one filter at a time and turn it clockwise. The charcoal filter can now be removed. Always ensure that both filters are changed at the same time. (see page 19 for further instructions). Clean the fan and other surfaces of the cooker hood regularly using a cloth moistened with non abrasive liquid detergent. The cooker hood lighting is designed for use during cooking and not for prolonged general lighting of the kitchen. Prolonged use of the lighting notably reduces the lifetime of the bulb.

Use a flat head screwdriver to lift and remove the overhead light fixture. When replacing a damaged lamp, use only LED lamps, avoiding contact with hands. Return the light fixture to its position using snap fastening. (See page 22 for instructions).

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

## How to replace the charcoal filters

The charcoal filters are not supplied with appliance. These can be sourced via the BUSH support helpline.


As indicated in the diagram below, push charchoal filter as shown as solid arrow B and twist in an anti-clockwise motion to lock in. Twist in a clockwise motion and pull outwards in the solid A arrow direction to remove filters.




## Cooker Hood Control Panel

The cooker hood has a control panel as shown in the image below.

- a. Power on/off
- b. Low speed button (decrease fan speed)
- c. High speed button (increase fan speed)
- d. Delay off button (will turn cooker hood off after 15 minutes)
- e. Light button (light on/off)

## Cleaning

WARNING! Isolate the power supply to the cooker hood before cleaning the appliance.

Do not clean using caustic creams, abrasive cleaning powders, thick wire wool or hard tools.

Clean the glass surfaces with special glass cleaning agents.

Never use flammable agents like acid, thinner or petrol when cleaning your cooker hood.

Do not clean your cooker hood with a steam cleaner.

#### **Replacing Lamps**

To replace the lamps, use a flat head screwdriver to pop the lamp out carefully. See movable parts in image.

For this cooker hood, use LED lamps, the specification is LED 9P, DC12V, 2W MAX. If it cannot be found in the local market, please call 01759 487838.



#### **Stainless Steel:**

Stainless steel parts must be cleaned frequently with mildly warm soapy water and a soft sponge and then dried with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive powders or abrasive cleaning materials. Do not leave anything spilled onto stainless steel parts for long periods of time.
