

NOVELLO THEATRE

Paired with the Aldwych Theatre, the Novello Theatre flanks The Waldorf Hilton in London's West End. PICCADILLY THEATRE

The Piccadilly Theatre is set in the heart of London's glamourous West End. Built in 1928, this magnificent building was a cinema in its early years and made history by premiering Britain's first talking picture. Its simple façade transforms into a magnificent Art Deco interior, providing the perfect surprise welcome for a spectacular night at the theatre. Piccadilly Theatre has hosted most forms of dazzling entertainment, from Royal Shakespeare Company productions, including a play starring lan McKellen, to ballets, dance and musicals. It is currently home to one of the best loved romantic stories in Hollywood, Pretty Woman: The Musical.

PRINCE EDWARD THEATRE

Designed by Edward Stone, Prince Edward Theatre opened in 1930. It features a stunning Art Deco interior with inviting themes of gold and fuchsia by Gaston Laverdet and Marc Henri. In 1935 it was transformed into a cabaret hall before being converted into the Queensberry All Services Club in 1942. The theatre was then in use as a cinema for several years. It wasn't until 1978 that it opened with its original name as the Prince Edward. At this time, Andrew Lloyd Webber and Tim Rice's show-stopping musical Evita came to the stage with dazzling success. Today, the theatre is home to the multi award-winning musical, Mary Poppins.






SONDHEIM THEATRE

Built in 1907, Sondheim Theatre is situated in Shaftesbury Avenue in the heart of London's glamorous West End. In 1913, it played host to the popular pastime known as Tango Teas, where audiences would go to sip on tea and be dazzled by talented tango dancers on stage. Formerly the Queen's Theatre, it was sadly the first theatre in the West End to be closed as a result of bombing in 1940. However, it successfully reopened in 1959 with John Gielgud's Ages of Man. In 1999, Dame Maggie Smith performed in The Lady in the Van. Today, it is home to Les Misérables and boasts some of the most renowned performances the West End stage has to offer.
