





# Requirements on the user

- ▶ Read the instruction manual in full to familiarise yourself with the product before the first use.
- ▶ This appliance shall not be used by children. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children. This appliance can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction

▶ Do not operate the appliance with a broken cord or plug, or if the appliance malfunctions, or is dropped or damaged in anyway.

► Any servicing or repair must be performed by Wahl (UK) Ltd or a suitably qualified professional.

▶ Do not use outdoors or in damp areas.

► To protect against risk of electrical shock, never immerse the unit or let it come into contact with water or any other liquids. Do not use the unit with wet hands. If the appliance should become wet, damp or fall in water, remove plug from mains socket immediately. Do not put your hands in the water.

- ▶ Never touch or allow contact with moving parts while in motion. Keep hands, hair, clothing and other utensils away from the moving parts during operation to prevent accident, injury or damage to the appliance.
- ► Switch off the appliance and unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off attachments and also before cleaning the appliance.
- ▶ Never use your appliance without paying attention! Always unplug the unit when not in use, even for a moment.
- ▶ Do not let the cord hang over the edge of the work surface or let it touch any hot surfaces.

## **BEFORE USE**

Remove all packaging and familiarise yourself with your spice grinder components as listed in the description of parts on page 4. Remove the small quantity fine grinding attachment from the grinding bowl, this as the name suggests is only required when you are fine grinding small quantities. Please read the section FINE GRINDING ATTACHMENT on page 11 before using.

**<u>MARNING</u>**: THE BLADES OF THIS GRINDER ARE EXTREMELY SHARP! DO NOT TOUCH THE BLADES.

### **USING YOUR SPICE GRINDER**

- Before plugging in check that the voltage matches that shown on the rating label.
- To unwind the power cord, pull the cord cover downwards. (Fia 2) unwind the amount of cord required, (Fig 3) and secure the cord in the notch before pushing the cover back into place (Fig 4).



- 3. Place the appliance on a level work surface.
- Remove the lid of the grinder and remove the fine grinding spice attachment. The attachment is only to be used when fine grinding small quantities, otherwise remove.



5 Add coffee beans, peppercorns, spices etc. to the grinding bowl. Do not overload and do not exceed the max marking on the bowl.




riangle **IMPORTANT**: OVERLOADING COULD CAUSE SERIOUS DAMAGE TO YOUR GRINDER.

**1** NOTE: Ensure the lid is properly fitted otherwise the appliance will not function due to safety features. (Fig 6)

Press the pulse button on the front of the grinder to operate (Fig 7). For best results, press the pulse button intermittently to chop down the chosen dried food into small pieces. This will also avoid damage to the motor and blade due to clogging. For fine grinding of smaller quantities (under 5 grams) use the fine grinding spice attachment. See fine grinding spice attachment section on page 11.







The grinding bowl is removable and can be easily removed by twisting anti clockwise and lifting out. (Fig 8) You can then easily dispense your ground dried food, clean the grinding bowl and replace.



To replace, lower the grinding bowl back into the base unit and twist clockwise until locked into place and

10. Always unplug the unit immediately after each use.



This unique spice attachment allows you to fine grind small amount of dry herbs and spices effectively. It simply reduces the capacity of the bowl so that even the smallest quantities of spices are kept in contact with the blades and therefore effectively ground.

⚠ IMPORTANT: Only use the attachment when fine grinding very small amounts of spices e.g. a teaspoon of spices. Do not fill above the level of the blades when using the attachment. Larger quantities can be done without the attachment or in two or more batches. Always roughly grind without the attachment first.

1. Place the spices into the grinding bowl, do not fill above the level of the blades. (Fig 9)



MIMPORTANT: Do not overfill. Overfilling could cause serious damage to your grinder.

Place the attachment into the bowl. (Fig 10)



Place the lid over the attachment and ensure that the lid is properly fitted otherwise the appliance will not function due to its safety feature.

Press the pulse button on the front of your grinder to grind the chosen ingredient.

**NOTE**: Spices should be in small manageable pieces and ground roughly by pulsing a few times before adding the attachment and grinding to a powder.

Always remove and clean the bowl, lid and spice attachment immediately after use to help avoid staining and lingering flavours and smells.

### **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**

- Unplug the appliance before cleaning.
- 2. Wipe over the outside of the base unit with a dampened cloth and polish with a soft dry cloth.

⚠ WARNING: DO NOT IMMERSE THE BASE UNIT IN WATER OR ANY OTHER LIQUID.

- The lid and removable bowl can be washed in warm soapy water or in a dishwasher.
  - Always take care when cleaning the blades.
- Do not use scouring agents or abrasive cleaners as they may damage the surfaces.

 $\underline{\mathbb{A}}$  WARNING: DO NOT PLACE THE BASE UNIT IN THE DISH WASHER.

**1** NOTE: If water becomes trapped in the grinding chamber, stand the grinding bowl upright and allow to drip dry.

Blue Neutral (N)

Brown live (L)

This appliance is fitted with a 3 pin plug which has a 3amp fuse fitted.

If the plug supplied is not suitable for your socket or becomes damaged, it should be cut off and disposed of, and a suitable plug fitted as detailed below.

As the colours of the wires in the mains lead of this Spice Grinder may not correspond with the colour markings identifying the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows.
