- The product has been treated with a wax and oil finish to prevent dirt ingress and preserve moisture.
- On unpacking the furniture you may notice an odour due to this treatment; this will disappear once the furniture is unpacked and assembled after a period of time.
- This process may leave some staining on the packaging material; please take care to ensure this does not transfer to clothing or carpeted surfaces during assembly.



 We do not recommend the use of power drill/driversfor inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.


Care and maintenance


Step1

Insert dowels **A** into the side rails **3**.



Step2

Insert wooden dowels (A) into headboard (1) and footboard (2) as shown.



Step3


Fixing top rail



Caution:

Fix headboard top rail 7 to the headboard 1 using bolts **①** and allen key **M**.

Fixing top rails




Caution:

Screw metal dowels P into footboard top rail 8.

Do not overtighten.




Step5

Fit footboard top rail 8 to the footboard 2.


Insert locking nuts **Q** where shown.

Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts **Q** clockwise to lock.



Step6


Screw headless bols **(5)** into footboard **(2)**.



Step7

Fixing metal brackets.


Fix metal brackets **1** into the pre drilled holes in the headboard **1** and footboard **2** using screws **B**.



Step8

Assembling central rail and inserting dowels.

Attach central rail 4 into the pre drilled holes in the middle supports 6 using screw ©.



Step9

Assembling side rails.




Important:

Two people are required for an easier assembly.

With help, fit one side 3 to the headboard 1. Insert half moon nuts **G** as shown, then fix parts using bolts **F** and allen key **M**.

Repeat step 9 for the other side rail.




Step10

a: Insert washer **(K)** into the side rails. Fit the headless bolts in the footboard thought the washers.


b: Fix headless bolts **(E)** using nuts **(H)** and spanner **(L)**.

Assembling of Step 9 and Step 10 will be easier with 2 people. It can also avoid damages or brakes of any part or component.



Step11

Attach central rail 4 to the metal brackets in the headboard and footboard using screws **B**.



Step12


Assembling slats

Please fix the first slats 5 at the end of the rail and work towards the middle of the bed using the spacer (N) and (R) as shown to ensure correct spacing.

Note that for first slats, spacer **R** should be used in the middle and spacer **N** at the sides as shown in the drawing.

Fix slats in one side first, then fix them in the central rail by pushing the rail against the slats if necessary. Repeat in the other side rail.

Use screws **D** for fixing.
